At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by Wayne Dunn, seconded by Rick Modesitt and made unanimous by David Blair Couch, approved minutes of October 6, 2010.

Agenda and Discussion Items:

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Jerry E. Snodgrass Estate. Charlene Deem and Pamela Rubenstraw objected to the appointment of the Administrator D.B.N. Timothy Snodgrass. The Commission continued this hearing to 11:10 A.M. Timothy Snodgrass was present.

At 10:45 A.M., Dennie Huggins, Chief Tax Deputy, met with the County Commission to discuss equipment needed in his office for upcoming computer program changes. He will need eight barcode scanners and fourteen printers which would be \$4,570.00 worth of equipment. The County Commission approved the \$4,570.00. (Order M/1197)

At 10:53 A.M., Dave Ashley from the Parkersburg/Wood County Visitors and Convention Bureau, met with the County Commission to discuss an application for an Innovative Programming Grant request from Blennerhassett Middle School. The County Commission approved the grant application in the amount of \$1,500.00. (Order M/1196)

The 11:10 A.M. appointment with Jeff Sandy, Sheriff, to discuss new deputy hires was cancelled.

At 11:11 A.M., the County Commission continued the 10:30 A.M. hearing. After discussion, the County Commission continued this hearing to November 22, 2010 due to the fact that Timothy Snodgrass's attorney, William Merriman, could not attend today. Information in regard to this matter is on file in the Probate Office.

At 11:25 A.M., Melvin Swiger, Maintenance Superintendent, met with the County Commission to discuss repairs to roofs on the Courthouse. The Commission advised him to repair the third story roofs on the front of the building and obtain the services of Tri-State Roofing to repair the roof on top of the bell tower.

At 11:30 A.M., Kim Coram met with the County Commission to discuss the trail systems in Wood County.

At 11:45 A.M., the County Commission awarded the bid for the financing of vehicles to be utilized by the Wood County Sheriff's Department to United Bank. (Order M/1195)


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned.
