At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal property for Imogene C. Bush - Lubeck District (2010); Dale Johnston - Lubeck District (2010) and for Brad E. Whited - Clay District (2009).

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real property for Robert W. Johnston - Williams District (2010); Stephen C. Miracle - Tygart District (two for 2010); James F. Gilmore - Parkersburg City District (two for 2007, two for 2008 and two for 2009); Harold E. Way - Williams District (2010) and for the City of Parkersburg - Parkersburg City District (2010).

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Jerry E. Snodgrass estate. After testimony, the County Commission removed Hazel Snodgrass as Administratrix and appointed Timothy Snodgrass as Administrator D.B.N. with a \$225,000.00 surety bond. Information in regard to this estate is on file in the Probate Office.

At 10:45 A.M., the County Commission met with Gwen Crum from the West Virginia University Extension Office to discuss a family nutrition program.

At 11:00 A.M., Chip Pickering and Jeff Hosek from Pickering Associates met with the Commission to interview for the LEED commissioning for the Wood County Justice Center.

At 11:22 A.M., Sean Saunders from Engineering Economics met with the Commission to interview for the LEED commissioning for the Wood County Justice Center.


At 11:41 A.M., Ben Fink and James Sledd from AECOM met with the Commission to interview for the LEED commissioning for the Wood County Justice Center.


