
Gentlemen:

As you are aware, over the past few months we have been taking steps to make our drug testing laboratory a separate non-profit organization in order to be allowed to bill Medicaid and Medicare as well as other private insurance carriers for our drug testing services. To that end, we have filed the appropriate incorporation papers with the State of West Virginia and have been granted a separate FEIN number for our lab. Additionally, we have filed the paperwork and have received our West Virginia business license in the name of The West Virginia Drug Testing Laboratories, Inc.

As the last step in this process, I have finished the paperwork for IRS form 1023, which is our application to them to be granted non-profit status, and the form is ready to be mailed out. I must attach a check payable to the Internal Revenue Service in the amount of \$850.00. I am asking The Commission at this time to authorize this payment, and direct Finance to issue the check in the above amount and payable to the IRS so that I can attach the check to the paperwork and get it sent out as soon as possible.

I have already spoken to the Directors of the other four Day Report Centers who also have drug labs in their facilities, and they have agreed that as they become certified to bill under this non-profit status as part of the West Virginia Drug Testing Laboratories, Inc, they will be required to reimburse Wood County for their percentage of the cost of setting up the medical billing and applying for our non-profit status. I respectfully urge you to authorize this payment. Thanks you for your attention in this matter.
