On this date, the County Commission of Wood County, upon a motion made by Steve Gainer, seconded by Wayne Dunn and made unanimous by David Blair Couch,, having ascertained that the net amount to be raised by the Levy of Taxes for the Current Year for County current purposes will be ten million eight hundred thirty-seven thousand three hundred fifty-six dollars and 00/100ths cents (\$10,837,356.00) according to the estimate and entered of record on the 28th day of March, 2011. Said estimate having been published as required by law, and no one appearing to oppose this commission or to take exception thereto, and the Office of the State Auditor, Chief Inspection Division, having heretofore by a letter received by this Commission dated April 19, 2011, giving Notice of a Conditional Approval of the Levy Estimate as submitted, it is therefore ORDERED that said Estimate and the Rate of Levy proposed therein, be approved and the following levies be laid on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of each class of Property:

13.14 of Class I Property
26.28 of Class II Property
52.56 of Class III Property
52.56 of Class IV Property

For the purpose of the aforesaid, being based upon the raised assessment thereon, the Levy Order and the Levy Rate Sheet are attached to this Order and should be made a part thereof.



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

NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF THE LEVY ESTIMATE (BUDGET)

TO: Wood County Commission

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Article 8, of the West Virginia Code, as amended, the State Auditor of West Virginia hereby approves your Levy Estimate (Budget) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011.

With this written approval, the levying body shall meet on the third Tuesday in April (April 19) to hear and consider any objections and to officially adopt the levy rates for property taxation. The clerk/recording officer, within three days of such meeting, shall prepare and forward to the State Auditor the officially adopted levy rates and levy order.
