This letter is to confirm our understanding of the terms and objectives of our engagement and the nature and the limitations of the services we will provide.

Engagement Objectives

Internal control analysis may be performed to assess the effectiveness of certain controls that we consider relevant to preventing and detecting errors and fraud related to the Local Government Purchasing Card Program and to prevent and detect misstatements resulting from illegal acts and other noncompliance matters that have a direct and material effect on the Local Government Purchasing Card Program.
- 3. The procedures performed on this engagement will be designed in a manner so that they may be relied upon as a part of the audit of the Wood County Commission, West Virginia. These procedures will only be relied upon in the event the Chief Inspector Division performs the audit of the Wood County Commission, West Virginia as of June 30, 2011, in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards for financial audits issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.
- 4. Upon completion of our procedures, we will provide a management letter for your consideration which will outline recommendations for strengthening internal controls, improving operating efficiency and reducing expenses. These comments reflect matters that, while in our opinion may not represent material instances of noncompliance or reportable internal control conditions, we believe represent matters for which improvements in compliance or internal controls or operational efficiencies might be achieved.

Management Responsibilities

Management is responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and for ensuring compliance with the provisions of applicable laws, regulations, contracts, agreements, and grants related to the Local Government Purchasing Card Program.

Management is responsible for making all financial records and related information available to us. We understand that you will provide us with such information required for our review and that you are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of that information.

You are responsible for the design and implementation of programs and controls to prevent and detect fraud, and for informing us about all known or suspected fraud affecting the government involving: (a) management, (b) employees who have significant roles in internal control over the Local Purchasing Card Program. You are also responsible for informing us of your knowledge of any allegations of fraud or suspected fraud affecting the government received in communications from employees, former employees, grantors, regulators, or others. In addition, you are responsible for identifying and ensuring that the entity complies with applicable laws and regulations associated with the Local Purchasing Card Program.

Engagement Administration

Our staff, Mary Ann Claytor and Dan Minney, have been assigned to conduct the review and expect to begin the engagement on approximately May 3, 2011. There will be no fee for these services. To expedite this process, we may provide you with a detailed listing of purchasing card transactions in which we will examine the supporting documentation and an internal control questionnaire prior to arriving on site.
