



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AGREEMENT AS TO REVERSION INTEREST IN PROPERTY

The County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia approves the loan between WESBANCO Bank and the Family Crisis Intervention Center, as is set out more clearly upon the record in a hearing held before the Wood County Commission on August 9, 2012 at 11:30AM. The commission recognizes that a foreclosure completed upon the property would result in the reversionary interest being extinguished and the property belonging entirely to the foreclosing entity.

That approval comes with the following conditions which cannot be waived save by vote of the commission at a public hearing: in the event that the Family Crisis Intervention Center, its heirs or assigns, defaults on or in any way causes, by overt act or an act of omission, any loan made by and between the WESBANCO Bank, its heirs or assigns, and the Family Crisis Intervention Center, the County, as per the right of the reversion clause contained within the original deed conveying the encumbered property from the Wood County Commission to the Family Crisis Intervention Center, reserves the right unto itself to correct in anyway any failure to pay or any other act the Family Crisis Intervention Center has committed or failed to commit that could or would result in the property being foreclosed upon by WESBANCO Bank, its heirs or assigns; this includes an option to redeem or to pay off any promissory note, deed of trust, or any other instrument or encumbrance that could result in foreclosure upon the secured property and the subsequent extinguishment of the County's right of reversion.

Further, the County shall have as much time as is reasonable to take the necessary steps to facilitate the payment of the loan and to prevent the property from being sold at a foreclosure or to satisfy by sale any note, instrument or other encumbrance. In the event that the County does elect to pay off or redeem any note or other instrument that encumbers the property, any and all ownership interest in the property as is held by the Family Crisis Intervention Center, its heirs, assigns or any group, organization, or business doing business as the Family Crisis Intervention Center, reverts entirely to the Commission as per the right of reversion as contained in the original conveying deed in fee simple absolute. The Family Crisis Intervention Center waives any and all claims and/or interests that it may have or may have had in the property. Put simply, if the Commission has to pay any part of any loan, note, or any other instrument made between WESBANCO Bank and the Center to stave off foreclosure or a foreclosure sale, upon payment of that debt, any ownership interest of the Center ceases and the County resumes
