At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of January 5 and 9, 2012.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved an Erroneous Assessment Application in regard to personal property for Kimberly J. Thompson.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

The County Commission placed John Swarr, Henry Elson, Bob Buchanan and Andrew Borkowski in nomination to fill vacancies that exist on the Wood County Parks and Recreation Commission (Mountwood Park). (Order A/903).

The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Wayne Dunn and made unanimous by Stephen Gainer, reappointed George Lantz to the Wood County Building Commission. (A/902)

At 10:10 A.M., several residents from the Lubeck area met with the Commission (not on agenda) to present them with a petition regarding noise problems and chemical odors they have been having with a business named Central Environmental Services, LLC. A discussion was held regarding the problem. The Commission agreed to forward the petition to the Prosecuting Attorney

for his advice. They also stated they will ask CES to appear before the Commission to advise them of the concerns. The petition is attached to these minutes and shall be made a part thereof.

At 10:50 A.M., the County Commission met with Ed Hupp, Emergency Management Director, to discuss an EMPG Grant Request for Reimbursement in the amount of \$92,168.00. The County Commission authorized David Blair Couch, as President to sign said Request. (Order M/1791)

At 10:52 A.M., the County Commission met with Kelly Shook, SOBER Program, Larry Johnson, Juvenile Probation Office and Toni Tiano, Grant Consultant. They requested funding of the Enforcing the Underage Drinking Laws grant since the grant funds have been reduced to \$5,000.00. Ms. Shook stated the Commission would need approximately \$35,000.00 to fund the program. The County Commission authorized Ms. Tiano to submit an Application for grant funding. (Order M/1803)

At 11:07 A.M., the County Commission met with Steve Rawlings from West Virginia Counties Risk Pool. Mr. Rawlings reviewed the County's liability insurance program.





Background:

Against Central Environmental Services, LLC 2130 Harris Highway, Wash. W.V 26181

Central Environmental Services (Central Garage) has started up a trucking/chemical cleaning operation right in the midst of a residential neighborhood in Lubeck that has existed peacefully for more than half a century. The around-the-clock operations at said company has had a negative effect on our neighborhood; it disrupts our peace, reduces our quality of life, and affects our health.

Petition:

We the under-signed call upon the Wood County Commission to cause the relocation of Central Environmental Services from its present location in Lubeck or to bring about changes in operating hours and procedures that (at the present time) keep residents awake at night and expose residents to noise, strong smell, and bright lights. In addition we ask that the Wood County Commission oversee the enforcement of all county/state/federal laws that apply to the business. The business operations of Central Environmental Services is not good for our neighborhood as a whole. Those of us who already had health conditions and respiratory problems have suffered further complications due to lack of sleep over the past two years.

Central Environmental Services has negatively affected our lives in the following ways and we would like our concerns addressed within 30 days of this petition date:

- I. What kind of chemicals are being used or stored there? How do they affect our health? And what precautions have been used in handling and storing them?
- II. What is the awful smell coming from CES that burns the eyes, nose, throat, and makes it difficult to breathe?
- III. Why are loud noises necessary at all hours of the night? (i.e.) Trucks jake-breaking down the long hill on 68 South, trucks revving their engines after entering the business, back up alarms, pumping sounds, etc. Shouldn't a business in a residential neighborhood have limited hours of operation?
- IV. Blinding, stadium-type lights shine into neighbor's houses all night long making it difficult to enjoy the evenings or sleep.
