At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

**AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS**

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Fred Rader and Tim Meeks from the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council to hold a public hearing for the Lubeck Public Service District Belleville area Water Project. Several citizens were in attendance and given the opportunity to speak. A.J. Allen with the Lubeck Public Service District spoke in favor of the project. The project will serve approximately two hundred homes. Pam VanMeter stated there were health concerns in the area and this should rectify the problem. John Tennant with the Belleville Homecoming stated that their building is designated as a Red Cross Emergency Shelter and wanted to make sure the project is still on track. (Order M/1875)

At 11:10 A.M., the County Commission met with representatives from the PHS and PSHS Mid-Ohio Golf Classic to request funds for their 2012 tournament. The County Commission stated as much as they want to assist in the event, they are unable at this time, but will take it under advisement.

At 11:18 A.M., the County Commission authorized the 2012/2013 General Fund Budget for the County be sent to the County Clerk's Finance Office for preparation to be submitted to the West

Virginia State Auditor's Office. The official budget is scheduled for March 26, 2012 to be approved.





Dear Potential Sponsor:

We are contacting you with hope that you will want to be part of one of the most unique community events in Parkersburg! Last year we introduced the Mid-Ohio Valley Golf Classic Tournament that represented a combined effort of the Erickson All-Sports Facility (EASF) Board of Directors and the PHS Stadium Committee to raise funds for their respective athletic fields.

Over \$9,000 was raised in this inaugural event -- split 50/50 between PHS and the EASF. Part of those proceeds came from the "Purple Pride" banquet that featured Greenbrier Resort owner and CEO, Jim Justice, as the guest speaker. (Note: Purple = color combination of PHS Red and South Blue.) Mr. Justice was a fantastic speaker and literally brought the house down with his stories and experiences. He also showered our efforts with accolades about what we are trying to do for the kids in Wood County!

Based on that success, we have begun plans for the 2012 Mid-Ohio Valley Amateur Golf Classic and "Purple Pride" banquet! Details: The MOV Classic will be open to all golfers. The two day event will be conducted on May 19-20, 2012, at Woodridge Golf Club in Mineral Wells. It will be a stroke play, individual tournament, with Gross and Net divisions. We are also pleased to add an optional 2-man best ball division for those who do not want to participate in the individual division.

**And THEN** -- the weekend will be capped-off with the "Purple Pride" Banquet, which will feature our special guest and keynote speaker, **Pat White**, former WVU Mountaineer great and record-holding Quarterback. Pat will be at the event for golfing on both days AND, will speak at the banquet on Sunday evening, January 20<sup>th</sup>! The banquet will start at 5 p.m. Tickets to this event will be separate from the golf tournament and will be available to the public.

Obviously, we are quite excited and hope that the 2012 tournament will raise even more funds than the first, as the two committees already have projects in mind for the proceeds. Specifically, the PHS Committee plans to improve facilities to bring the stadium into further compliance with the "Americans with Disabilities Act". The EASF Directors are raising money to install artificial turf on their field that is heavily used for soccer and football by middle schools and Parkersburg South High School.

Our committees are working *together* as a united front to maintain and improve the facilities for children on both sides of the river. Our common cause is to invest in the future of Wood County. We sincerely hope that you will want to be part of the excitement by including this charitable event in your 2012 benevolence budget!

## Familiar Face to be Speaker

Former WVU QB Pat White will highlight Purple Banquet

PARKERSBURG - Former West Virginia University quarterback Pat White, the only quarterback in the history of college football to start and win four bowl games, will serve as the speaker for this year's Purple Banquet during the Mid-Ohio Valley Golf Classic, set for May 19 and 20 at Woodridge Golf Club.

The announcement was made by Steve Hussey, chairman of the MOV Golf Classic, along with Dale Richardson of the Erickson All-Sports Facility and Earl Johnson of the Stadium Field Improvement Committee.

Last year, the initial golf tournament and Purple Banquet raised \$9,000 with the stadium committees each receiving \$4,500. That event featured Jim Justice, owner of the Greenbrier Resort, as its guest speaker.

Organizers learned a lot from their initial effort a year ago and have made several changes they believe will increase participation and proceeds, the latter of which are split between the two stadium committees.

Instead of playing on Friday and Saturday as took place last year, this will be a weekend event, with golf on Saturday and Sunday. Also, the event will be conducted entirely at Woodridge Golf Club rather than taking place on two different courses. The entry fee has been lowered to \$100 and not only will include a singles competition but also a two-man best ball division.

"We are really excited to bring Pat White to town," said Hussey. After tournament organizers unsuccessfully made several attempts to contact White, Jim Hamric, one of the Woodridge owners, sent White a text message, to which he responded almost immediately.

White not only agreed to serve as the guest speaker for Sunday's Purple Banquet, but he also will participate in the golf event both days.

Organizers chose the name Purple Banquet for their dinner to emphasize this is a combined effort of Parkersburg High School, whose primary color is red, and Parkersburg South High School, whose is known for its blue.

PHS, which recently installed handrails at Stadium Field, will use its funds from the upcoming event to continue to make Stadium Field compliant with the Americans With Disabilities Act. The Erickson board will put its proceeds in its turf fund. It has been raising money with the hopes of installing an artificial playing surface at the stadium.

White is the only three-time winner of the West Virginia Amateur Athlete of the Year Award, presented by the West Virginia Sports Writers Association.

He was named Mr. Football in the state of Alabama following his senior season at Daphne High School, where he also was a two-time Class 6A all-state baseball player.

He passed up a Major League Baseball career and a six-figure salary with the Anaheim Angels to play college football, signing with WVU because it offered him a chance to play quarterback.


1. The **President** of the **Wood County Commission** or **his** designated staff shall provide all appropriate advice and council on home loan financing to minorities and lower income families and individuals.

2. Said **President** will provide further advice to lower-income and minority families and individuals with regard to federal programs that may be available for the rental or financing of housing. The **President** or **his** designated staff shall be available for such counseling from 8:00A.M. to 4:00P.M., Monday through Friday at the **Wood County Courthouse, Parkersburg, WV** or **(304) 424-1984**.

3. The **President** shall advise the public that any complaints of discrimination in the sale, rental, or financing of housing should be reported directly to **him** and **he** in turn will forward this information to the proper West Virginia Human Rights Commission authorities. Furthermore, **he** shall notify the local realtors that **he** has been given this responsibility.





WHEREAS, the **Wood County Commission** is an eligible applicant; and,


