At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

At this time, Gary Parsons was sworn in as a Reserve Deputy for the Wood County Sheriff's Department.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of August 12 and 15, 2013.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:02 A.M., the County Commission met with Dave Ashley, Cindy Sheppard and Mark Lewis from the Convention and Visitors Bureau. They presented several Innovative Programming Grants. (Orders M/2488 and M/2489)

At 9:10 A.M., the Commission met with Randy Lowe, E-911 Telecommunications Director. Mr. Lowe presented a request to add Captain Hook Towing to the wrecker rotation list. The E-911 Advisory Board recommended this be presented to the Commission department. Several area towing companies were in attendance. The County Commission denied the addition. (Order A/1168)

At 9:28 A.M., the County Commission met with John Reed, Wood County Compliance Officer for a hearing in regard to property located on Core Road. Wood County Engineer, Bill Brown, recommended the structure be taken down. No representative from the bank that owns the

property was in attendance, despite being properly noticed. The meeting was not properly noticed due to an improper address listing. The Commission tabled the decision until the next regular meeting of the Commission. (Order A/1169)

At 9:46 A.M., the County Commission met with Larry Allen who spoke regarding the Wood County Recreation Commission. After discussion, the County Commission announced a vacancy on the Recreation Commission due to the resignation of Delmas Barker. (Order A/1166) The County Commission placed Randy Edge in nomination to fill said vacancy. (Order A/1167)

At 9:54 A.M., the County Commission met with Greg Smith and Shad Martin regarding the Latrobe Street Mission. They asked the Commission to sign two letters of support for grants they are applying for. The Commission signed said letters.

At 10:12 A.M., the County Commission met with Shawn Graham, Chief Deputy with the Wood County Sheriff's Department. Chief Graham addressed the attorney fees incurred by the Sheriff with an outside attorney. Commissioner Couch contacted the insurance company and asked them to forward all information to them.

At 10:23 A.M., the County Commission met with West Virginia University Extension Agent, J.J. Barrett. Mr. Barrett discussed his Sustainable Farming Workshop he will be holding on October 5, 2013. He requested \$300.00. The County Commission authorized the donation of \$300.00. (Order A/1170)

At 10:45 A.M., the County Commission reviewed the County vision insurance plan and recommended this be presented to the Employee Benefits Committee for recommendation.

Dear Colonel Hill:

First, let me say I am pleased to hear that the State Police are using a rotation list for selecting towing companies. However, I have received a complaint that the rotation lists for each county may include companies outside of the county. This can cause a major problem for the citizens of that county: 1) the towing bill may be bigger due to the further distance being towed; 2) its an inconvenience for the owner since they have to travel further to get their car; 3) the repair may be done outside the county and this is another inconvenience; 4) it deprives the in county towing company and repair shop the business; 5) it may cause a longer traffic tie up, tying up the officers and the fire departments. For example, last week in Taylor a wreck occurred within one mile of a towing company and the officer called a Marion Company 25 to 30 miles away. It was their turn but I question whether they should be on the list unless they are closer to the wreck or have special equipment needed for the tow. Neither was the case in the above example.

I would appreciate it if you would look into this matter and maybe clarify your policy concerning these situations.

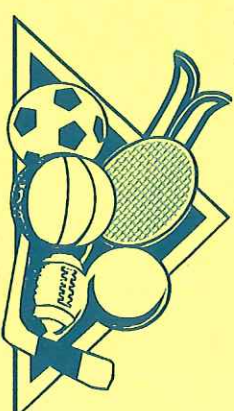

Vacant Latrobe Street building to be renovated

PARKERSBURG —

The vacant building that once housed the Gustke Youth Shelter will be turned over to a local non-profit for social programs.

The former Children's Home Society shelter, at 611 Latrobe St., has been sitting vacant for more than seven years, since the shelter expanded and relocated to its current St. Marys Avenue location.

The Latrobe Street building is owned by the city and was leased to Children's Home

Society for use as a shelter. After being contacted

all of them withdrew except for this group," said commission President Blair Couch.

"A group called the Not For Sale Ministries and the Church of Christ have agreed they will be working together on the project, and will be renovating the Latrobe Street house for use with a variety of social programs, including help for substance abusers, individuals who are homeless and providing other assistance," said Commissioner Wayne Dunn. "They will be forming a coalition to work together."

Representatives of the Not for Sale Ministries could not be reached for

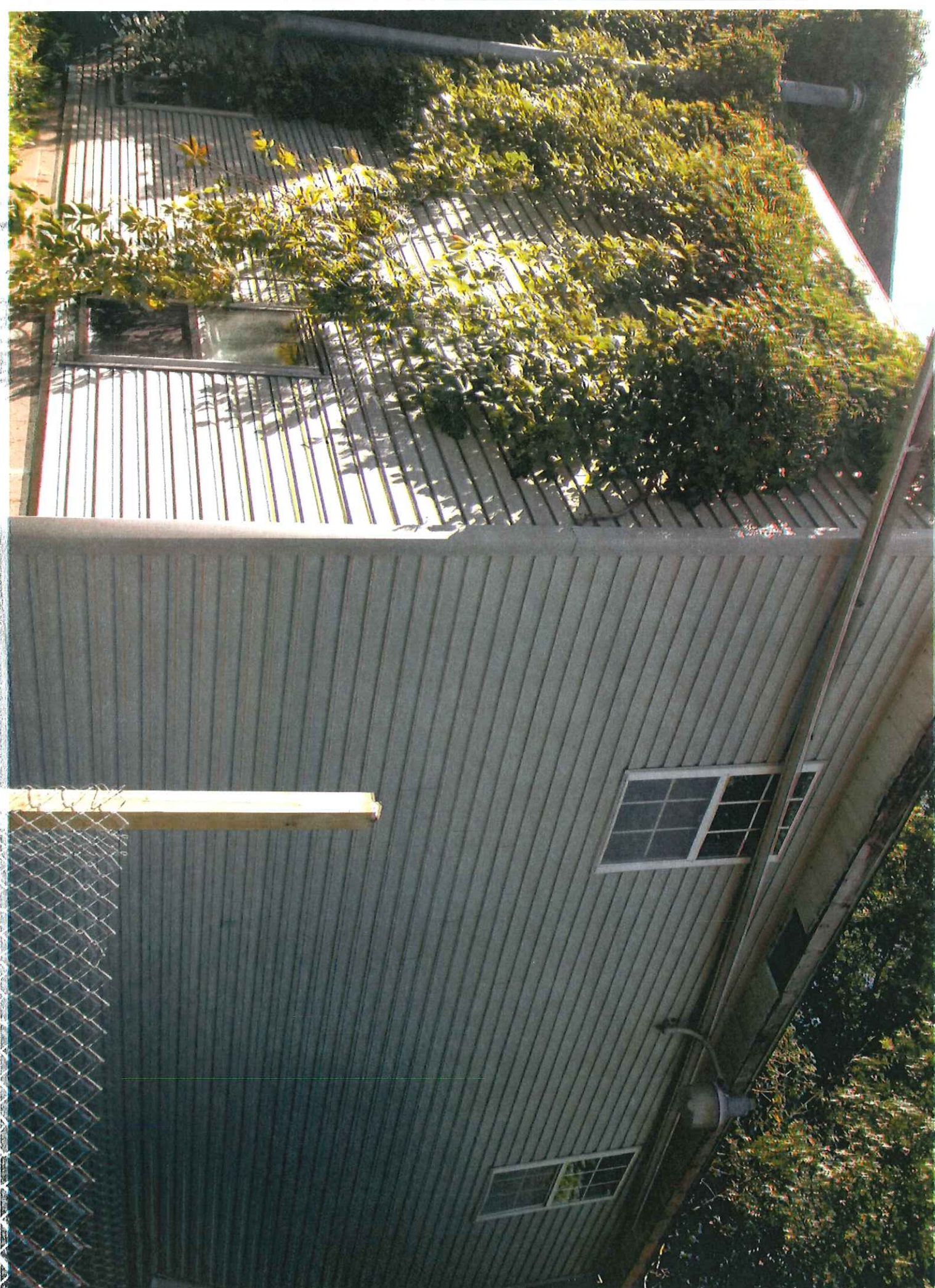

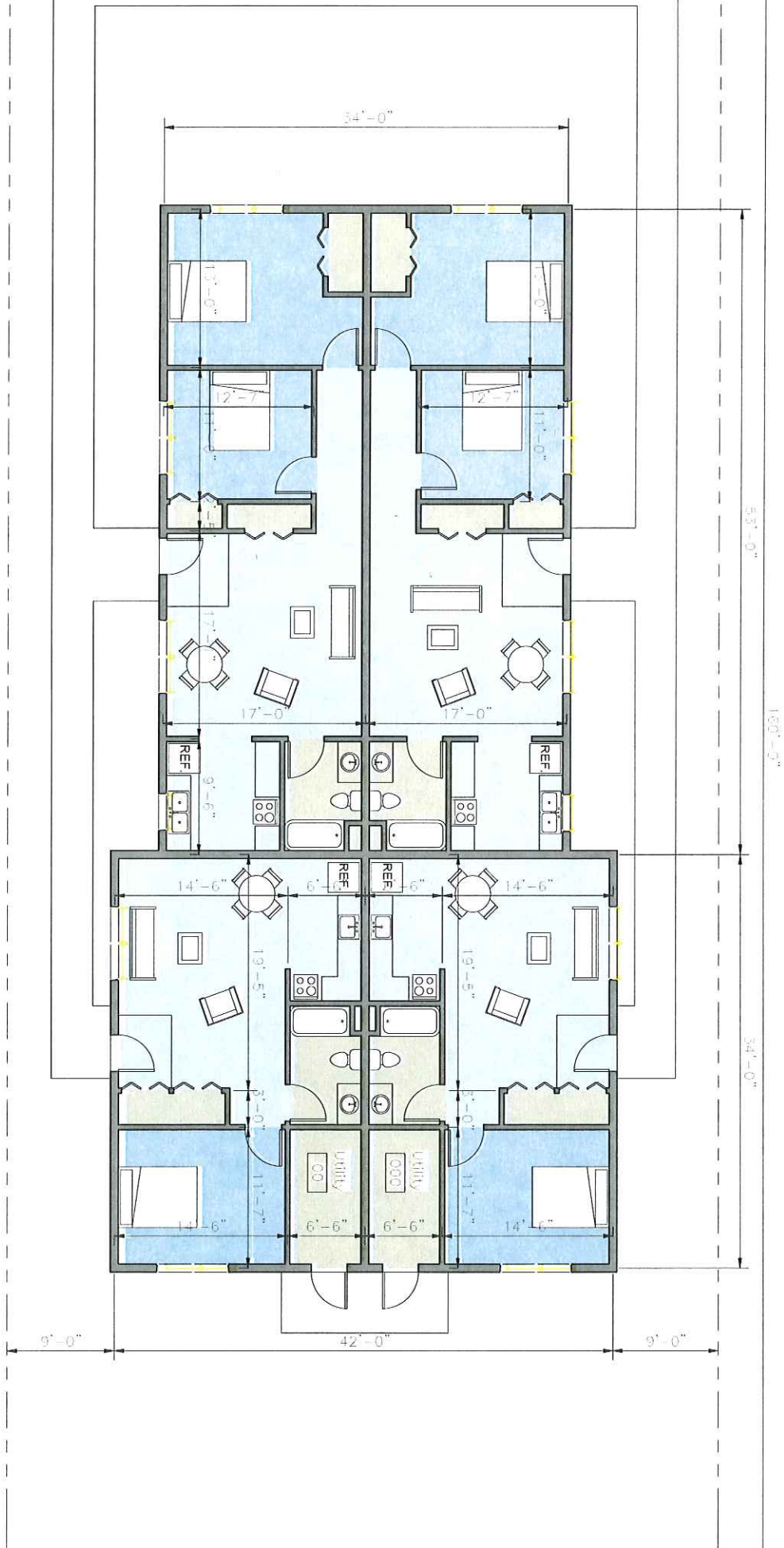
