### Grantee Grant Report: SUSTAINABLE WEST VIRGINIA/HOME ENERGY PROGRAM

West Virginia Sustainable Communities Technical Assistance Mini-Grant Date of Final Report: December 3, 2013

## 1. Description of Actual Grant Activities

Please describe how the funds were expended and the impact of the project on the community.

Please also include a timeline of the events throughout the course of your project.

The purpose of this grant was to enhance efforts to increase public knowledge and interest in home energy efficiency and to encourage home energy audits to be performed. As a result of these grant funds, 12 home energy audits were performed. This Program was also able to receive grant funds from other sources which were used for marketing and advertising the audit program. Some of the advertising which was done included a 30 minute program on WTAP, brochures, website, and public service announcements. The audits took place throughout the months of March – August 2013. The amount of grant funds expended on the 12 audits was \$3,000 (\$200 for student labor and \$50 for supervision per audit). The remaining \$2,000 of grant funds was spent to pay Christy Gillespie who worked as an independent contractor for SMART Energy Solutions. In this position, Ms. Gillespie performed the following tasks: attended planning meetings, checked emails, answered telephone calls, explained the program to interested homeowners and answered their questions, scheduled assessments for homeowners, coordinated scheduled assessments with assessors, submitted jobs to WVU-P for assessors' payroll, created job profiles in moodle system, accepted payments made by the homeowners, and handled daily operations of the program.

#### 2. Challenges Encountered, Lessons Learned

Please describe the challenges faced and lesson you learned throughout your project.

What advice would you give to another community about to undertake a similar project?

There were several challenges to this program and several lessons learned. As the program began, it became obvious that either people did not understand the benefits of an energy audit or did not care. It was very apparent that education is needed to explain this type of program to people and that it will take much time to change people's habits. Very few people were willing to pay the fee to have an audit done which would show them how they could save thousands of dollars.

Another challenge that the Program faced, and that other programs may face, is finding an energy auditor to perform these assessments at a reasonable price. These auditors need to be well versed in energy savings in order to know what to look for and to teach people how to improve their homes.

Any community beginning this type of program needs to make sure there are qualified auditors and that there are funds to educate and market the program so the general public can determine the benefits of having an energy audit performed.

### 3. How Sustainability Initiatives will be Continued Moving Forward

Please describe how your initiative will be continued beyond the mini-grant funding.

Sustainable West Virginia will continue its initiative beyond this grant. An Energy Expo has been scheduled for December 7, 2013. At this time it is the hope to educate those on the need for home energy audits. A focus will also be made to local businesses to explain to them the benefits of energy audits. It is the belief that businesses may be more receptive than homeowners as they will understand the long-term benefits associated with saving money. Efforts will also be made to seek other grants to help with this program. In addition, there are also funds – approximately \$48,000 – obligated to this program from the Wood County Commission. It is hoped that these funds will be used to help move this program forward.


