All rifle and pistol actions are to be kept open unless being fired or the gun cased. 3.

Fire only at paper targets attached to the target holders on the left side of the range at 4 25, 50, 100, and 200 yards. No targets, cans, jugs, or boxes to be placed in the middle of the range where a bullet might ricochet up over the hill and possibly hit a house or

Always be sure your bullets are impacting into a safe backstop. 5.

Place targets on holders so as not to be firing through the target frame and supporting 6. posts.

7. All firing is to be done from the established firing line.

Before going forward to the targets, be sure the firing line is clear and all guns are 8. unloaded and actions open.

After returning from the targets be sure the range is clear of all people before 9. commencing firing again.

Clean up all paper and other waste materials and place in the barrels provided. Keep 10. the range clean and nice.

No vehicles allowed beyond the parking area. 11.

- Shooting from 8:00 AM until dark Monday thru Saturday, and from 12:00 noon until dark 12. on Sunday.
- All members are required to display their up to date membership card while using the 13. range. Cardholders may be picked up from the filing cabinet in the range garage.
- Membership applications will be kept in the file cabinet. Members may not loan their 14. cards to non-members. Guests must accompany member, display guest card, and follow all range rules.

Members shooting the 25 and 50 yard targets will use the first four benches starting on 15.

the extreme left looking downrange.

Members using semi-automatic firearms are required to have a stop of some kind to 16. prevent their spent cartridge cases from being ejected onto other members. (If other members are present.)

Dear Sirs,

I am the current home owner of 1684 Meadville Road in Davisville. I have been reading for the past two days the problems concerning safety issue with the Sundowner Range on Gihon Road. I too have a problem and concern with the range immediately next door to me on Meadville Road called Fort Boreman Range.

As a former NJ State Law Enforcement Officer with 27 years experience now retired, as well as 18 years of Military duty active and reserve, I have spent my entire adult life in one form or another on various ranges both military and police.

Upon moving here I was told by some of the neighbors that nothing could be done about the range as it was "grandfathered in" and had been in operation for almost thirty years. I emphatically disagree with that contention. The range was put in when this area was mostly farm land, in fact the property I now live on was part of the Pratt family farm. Mr Pratt subdivided this property between three of his children. The parcel I am on was first given to Susan and Will Merlott who placed a mobile home on this property but could not live in it as they worked shift work at Dupont and could not get proper sleep or rest due to the gun fire at the range. The Merlott's traded property with Susan's sister Sandra who lived further up the block and moved there and reside to this day.

Sandra sold us this home we live in now, because of the location and its proximity to the range, the house set on the market for over two years causing Sandra to lower her price quite a bit to find a buyer. Since moving here on many occasions gun fire has been heard quite early in the morning prior to the stated starting time and into the dark of the night, holidays and Sundays. Funny hunting isn't allowed on Sundays, why is the range allowed to be open?

My sleeping areas of my home are approximately 115 yards to the shooting points of the range, way below the required 500 feet. Another point of interest is the impact area is in extremely sad and deteriorating condition. There is no range master or safety officer present as the currant grounds keeper works a full time job as a exterminator and his wife cares for their three young children. There are no control points to allow people in or out of the facility, thus anyone, member or non can show up and shoot even though this is suppose to be a "members only" range. I know of a handful of people who have fired on that range and are not members.

The elderly gentleman who lives across the street is even closer to the impact areas than me. He keeps stating that there is nothing that can be done as petitions were circulated years ago to no avail.

I as an individual that has spent most of his life around weapons is not looking to have the gun range closed down permanently, I am looking for safety issues to be implemented, so that it meets all State, Federal, County and Municipal safety procedures for ranges. Either having the correct amount of footage from dwellings or have them place ballistic curtains or walls between us and the range so that our safety can be assured, after all an accidental misfire could occur and it is impossible to "call back" that round from any weapon.

I have a family which includes a new born, farm animals as well as family pets that I wish to protect. Your indulgence and immediate attention to this matter would be greatly appreciated.


