Parkersburg and Vienna will be celebrating this event. Mayor Rapp stated they did not want to

conflict with any event the County may do.

Mr. Newman was asking for compensation for his trouble and asked the Commission to waive taxes for the next year to compensate him for his loss of \$1,600.00 to \$1,700.00. It was agreed the County Engineer, Bill Brown, will contract Mr. Newman to get inside his house and issue a report on behalf of the County.
