At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed

purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence during today's meeting.

Greg Smith was sworn in as a member of the Mid-Ohio Valley Board of Health. (1/9/13)

James Miracle was sworn in as a member of the Wood County Historic Landmarks

Commission and the Fort Boreman Historical Park Commission. (1/8/13)

The County Commissioners were sworn in to their various boards and commissions.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed approved minutes

of December 27, 28, 2012, the addendum to December 13, 2012 and January 3, 2013.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission discussed a request from the New Era School for a

donation to assist them in the installation of a new furnace. Commissioner Gainer stated he was in

favor of donating \$2,500.00 which Commissioner Dunn stated he was also in favor of. The County

Commission initialed their letter of request and asked that the funds come out of the lottery line

item. Commissioner Dunn stated further that they have agreed to perform an energy audit under

the energy program the County is sponsoring.

At 9:10 A.M., Jim Miracle from Carlin's Battery Civil War re-enactors, met with the Commission to request a donation from the Commission in the amount of \$1,300.00. The Commission requested that he provide them a letter of request. A letter was provided later in the meeting and initialed by the Commission. (Handout attached to these minutes.)

At 9:14 A.M., the County Commission met with Ed Hupp, Wood County Emergency Services Director, who requested the approval of the Emergency Operation Plan for the County. Mr. Hupp further informed the County they are looking at four sites throughout the County to place generators for emergency communication during an event. He stated it would cost 4-6 thousand dollars per site. (Order M/2231-E) Mr. Hupp then asked if the Commissions would consider a County ID for all County employees.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Wood County Telecommunications/E-911 Director, Randy Lowe. Mr. Lowe requested the purchase of new equipment for the center. Mr. Lowe advised that they upgrade or purchase equipment from Tiburon at the cost of \$381,362.00. He stated he had looked at three vendors and they were the best and cheapest. He further stated the money is in his capital equipment reserve fund. (Order M/2231-B)

At 10:00 A.M., Wood County Clerk, Jamie Six and his employee, Melody Ross, met with the Commission to discuss the 2012 election cycle community voting sites and the associated costs. Several representatives from the league of Women's Voters were in attendance for the discussion. Mr. Six provided the Commission with a financial page from the past election. He stated they will need to decide when and if they wish to continue the satellite voting sites. No decision was made. (Handout is attached to these minutes.)

At 10:40 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Estate of George P. Lewis, Deceased. Marguerite Lewis, Administratrix was present to petition the county Commission to

waive her surety bond in said estate. Upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, the County Commission adjourned said hearing to be continued to an unknown date to allow her attorney to get more information needed for the County Commission to make a decision on said motion. Information in regard to this hearing is on file in the Probate Office.

At 11:00 A.M, the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Estate of Ronald Ray White, Deceased. Belinda S. Kesterson, Administratrix, asked that claims be disallowed. The County Commission, after reviewing said appraisement and inventory, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, ruled that claims be disallowed because of insufficient funds in said Estate. The County Commission Ordered that if any additional funds come into the estate, the Estate will be required to be re-opened. Information in regard to this hearing is on file in the Probate Office.

At 11:15 A.M., the County Commission met with Wood County Day Report Center Director, Dennie Huggins. Mr. Huggins gave an update on the Center. He requested a replacement for a vehicle that was wrecked. He stated he has an employee who will be leaving on maternity and may not be returning. He stated he will need coverage while that employee is on leave.

The Battery set up the Cabin as it might have been during the war. We invited the public to come and share the campfire and sing carols. The Battery provided Cider, Coffee, hot chocolate and cookies. There were over 75 in attendance.

I am pleased to report the members of the Battery have represented the County with distinction during the abovementioned events. It has been my pleasure to have commanded them. Members of the Battery have provided numerous volunteer man-hours to accomplish our goals. We take pride in what we have accomplished to date.

The men of the Battery have been featured in video's produced by the WV Dept of Tourism, the Wood County Visitors and Convention Bureau that was released this fall. Having our Limber completed last year has been an excellent addition to our portrayal of a Civil War unit. Battery D have maintained our website, as requested, to keep everyone in touch with where they can attend our events. We thank the Commissioner's for your support is much appreciated by every member of the unit. There are several reenactment and living history events on the schedule for this year.

The Battery fired a total of **217** rounds with no load misfires during this report period, making a grand total of **801** rounds fired by Battery D, since our inception. We have a strict safety first policy and this has resulted in zero injuries during this reporting period.
