At 9:05 A.M., the County Commission met with the West Virginia Secretary of State, Natalie

Tennant, to receive a grant for a "Help America Vote Act" grant. The grant is for Precincts 62 and

62A at the Washington Community Building to assist in making the building handicapped accessible.

At 9:20 A.M., the County Commission reviewed the newly passed County Purchasing Policy

with department heads and elected officials. Jason Wharton, Prosecuting Attorney and Jamie Six,

County Clerk, went over the policy for the Commission.

At 9:33 A.M., the Commission discussed the new County Payment Disbursement Policy with

Mr. Wharton and Mr. Six. The County Commission authorized the policy. (Order M/2402)

At 9:53 A.M., the County Commission met with the Commission to bring a concern regarding

a problem he is having at the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Airport. He stated his mother owned the

restaurant at the Airport and has been denied reestablishment of the business since his Mom

At 10:05 A.M., the County Commission met with Mark Schwendeman and Angie Lawrence from Schwendeman Agency, Inc. to review the employee health insurance for the coming fiscal year.

At 10:39 A.M., Steve Parker addressed the County Commission regarding the festival he holds in the fall called "Sweet Creek Gathering". He asked the Commission for an advance of \$10,000.00 against two Governor's Community Participation grants they are working on.

At 10:55 A.M., the County Commission discussed the possibility of hiring a special counsel to collect delinquent taxes. The Commission, upon a request of Jamie Six, County Clerk, to continue this discussion until after the Humane Society discussion.

At 10:59 A.M., the County Commission met with members of the Parkersburg Humane Society to discuss animal control in the County. 



Health Insurance

- The Schwendeman Agency, Inc. conducted a market search with 5 other insurance carriers. Aetna, Coventry, CIGNA, Health Plan, and United Healthcare were sent requests for proposal. The only carrier that was competitive with Highmark BCBS was the Health Plan. The Health Plan rates were approximately 8% over the current rates with Highmark, however the prescription drug plan could not be matched and the participants would have been exposed to higher out-of pocket costs with Health Plan, especially on Specialty drugs.
- According to Highmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield's renewal formula, the renewal rates for the plan year July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, were originally proposed to increase 14.27%, with an additional 1.58% due to PPACA taxes, for a total increase of 16.08%.
- The rate cap agreed to last year after negotiations with Highmark was 9%. Therefore, the total rate increase offered at renewal is 10.73%, comprised of 9% due to the rate cap and the PPACA taxes of 1.58%. Due to competition from the Health Plan and to accommodate the fees that are to be paid with the new HRA plan administrator, addressed below, Highmark further reduced the rates to 9.98% over the current rates, including the PPACA taxes. The PPACA taxes alone attributed to \$33,616 in premium increase.
- The total paid medical and prescription drug claims during the experience period (01/1/12 through 12/31/12) amounted to \$1,666,838, compared to paid premium of \$1,980,080, for a loss ratio of 84.18%.
- The County's health insurance plan is comprised of two parts, a High Deductible Health Insurance Plan (HDHP) and a Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA). The combined program provides a very competitive benefit plan for the employees and their dependents and a very cost effective program for the County.

The HDHP is the insurance policy that the County purchases, with an annual network deductible of \$3,000 per individual (maximum of two deductibles per family) for major medical expenses. The HRA coordinates with the HDHP in the following manner. The participant has s \$250 annual deductible, then the HRA picks up the next \$2,250

of eligible expenses and then the individual has an additional \$500 of out of pocket expense. The HRA expenses go toward satisfying the deductible. The County funds the HRA as expenses are incurred. Once the \$3,000 deductible is satisfied the HDHP covers 100% of the remainder of the in network major medical expenses for the year. The accompanying spreadsheet details the plan of benefits as well as the annual costs of the plan.

The administrator for the HRA plan will be Wesbanco TPA effective July 1, 2013. Highmark will electronically transfer claims to Wesbanco to be processed under the HRA plan. The reason for the change had to do with administrative problems with HRA administration from Highmark in Pittsburgh. Highmark is currently conducting an audit to determine if any of the reimbursements were incorrectly processed and Amber Jadgmann from the Parkersburg Highmark office will be available to answer specific participant questions regarding the reimbursements. The primary issues with the administration was that the HRA department in Pittsburgh set up the incorrect deductible and in addition was unable to administer the 4th quarter deductible carry over. To help offset the inability to administer the carry over deductible Highmark has credited Wood County with a 1% premium reduction for the 7-12 through the 6-13 premium year.

Wesbanco charges an administrative fee of \$5.75 per employee that is enrolled in the HRA. These fees are offset by the additional premium reduction granted by Highmark.

• The table below illustrates how well the combination of the high deductible plan and the HRA have worked for Wood County's plan as compared to keeping the \$250 deductible plan originally in place. To illustrate this we asked Highmark to provide the rates over the last three years for the \$250 deductible plan, as if it would have remained in place.

Dental Insurance

 Admin Fees- The dental plan is self funded through Renaissance Dental

Fees are beginning the second year of a 2 year rate guarantee at \$4.98 per employee per month.

- Claims & Funding- The experience period claims experience for dental along with the administrative fees totaled \$89,026 for the year. The current monthly funding rates of \$19.56 for single and \$53.75 for family coverage created funding for the year of \$94,378. Based upon the surplus created the rates for the upcoming year can remain the same, with no increase.
- The move to self funding the dental 4 years ago has worked well as the rates remain below the rates charged when the plan was fully insured at that time.

Vision Benefits

The total annual cost for all participants and dependents for the vision insurance is approximately \$37,000. The renewal is in September 2013 and we expect receiving the rates in July 2013. Rate increases have been coming in at higher than past years with Vision Service Plan, in the neighborhood of 20%. We are looking at alternatives for the vision benefit.

Life Insurance Benefits

The life insurance benefits are in the second year of a 2 year rate guarantee with Ft. Dearborn Life. The rate is \$0.17/\$0.03 per \$1,000 for the \$10,000 life and A.D.&D. benefits. Total annual premium for all employees is slightly less than \$5,000 year. The supplemental employee life and dependent life age bracket table will remain the same as current.

Section 125 Flexible Spending Accounts

The Section 125 Plan will continue to be administered through TASC

Health Care Reform

PPACA, or Health Care Reform, continues to provide challenges for employers on understanding the regulations, implementation, and effects of the cost. The Schwendeman Agency, Inc. has conducted 24 seminars on Health Care Reform in the past 7 months and will be offering more in the near future. (June 5th in St.Clairsville, OH and June 6th in Marietta, OH).

We encourage the commissioners to attend one of the upcoming seminars or perhaps even hold one and invite other employers.

The County Commission of Wood County, in an effort to better manage timely payments to vendors and employees, adopts the following policy:

The County Commission authorizes the County Clerk to include in payroll disbursements overtime payments and part-time employees' compensation upon the signature of the elected official or his/her designee, or the employee's department head, or the County Administrator for an employee who works directly for the County Commission. The County Commission will then review the payroll submissions at the first commission meeting for which the payments may be submitted for inclusion on an agenda under the Open Meetings Act.

The Clerk's Office is not permitted to make payments to an individual until the hiring has been approved by the Wood County Commission. The Clerk's Office is not permitted to make payments to county employees at a new rate of pay until the County Commission has reviewed the new rate of pay and determined that sufficient funds exist in the elected official's payroll line item, which must be properly included on an agenda under the Open Meetings Act.

The County Commission further authorizes the County Clerk to make payment on regular monthly bills which are on the vendor list approved by the Wood County Commission for payment under this policy. Payments may be made for such invoices by the County Clerk prior to County Commission approval if they have been approved by the respective elected official or County Administrator. In the

event that the County Clerk's office determines that a bill appears unusual it will be referred back to the County Commission for approval prior to payment.

All payments authorized under this policy may only be disbursed by the County Clerk if sufficient funds exist in the respective budget line item.
