At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of September 5, 2013.

Dave McClure was sworn in to the Mid-Ohio Valley Board of Health.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission discussed a letter they received from Westbrook regarding a modification of the lease for their property. Jason Wharton, Prosecuting Attorney, was in attendance and stated the service they provide for a public intoxication shelter is greatly needed in the County. The Commission asked that Westbrook be contacted to meet with the Commission and the Prosecutor next Monday.

At 9:11 A.M., the Commission opened bids for the demolition of the Holding Center and also the Asbestos Abatement of the Holding Center. Bids were taken under advisement. (Orders 2498 and M/2497)

At 9:20 A.M., the County Commission met with Steve Mahaffey, President of the Wildwood Subdivision, along with several area residents to discuss concerns with the shooting range in their

neighborhood. They requested the Sheriff's Office measure the earthen backstop and report back to them. They presented several bullets they have found on their property from the range. Commissioner Couch stated he saw no problem with the Commission sending a letter to the Sheriff requesting copies of all incidents they have investigated and also to check on the safety of the range and to report back to the Commission.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission attended a LEED presentation for the Wood County Justice Center.

FIRST AND FOREMOST, LET ME BE PERFECTLY CLEAR THAT WILDWOOD RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION HAS NO INTENTION OR AGENDA TO IMPOSE OR INFRINGE UPON ANYONE'S 2ND AMENDMENT RIGHTS.

THE INFORMATION I WANT TO SHARE WITH YOU TODAY COMES FROM TWO SEPARATE ARTICLES PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL SHOOTING SPORTS FOUNDATION TITLED DESIGN CRITERIA FOR SHOOTING RANGES AND BAFFLES BERMS AND BACKSTOPS.

THERE IS ONLY ONE DESIGN CRITERION PARAMOUNT TO THE DESIGN OF A SHOOTING RANGE, AND THAT IS SAFETY. THERE IS AN ADAGE KNOWN BY EXPERIENCED RANGE DESIGNERS AND RANGE OPERATORS: A COMPLETELY SAFE RANGE CANNOT BE DESIGNED. A SAFE RANGE RESULTS IF, AND ONLY IF, IT IS SAFELY OPERATED AND IF THE PARTICIPATING SHOOTERS ARE CONTROLLED BY THE RULES AND SAFETY POLICIES. IT'S IMPORTANT TO INGRAIN THE IDEA INTO SHOOTER'S MINDS THAT UNINTENTIONAL DISCHARGES CAN OCCUR TO EVERYONE.

FROM THE FIRING LINE OF THE RIFLE RANGE AT THE GUN RANGE ON GIHON ROAD TO THE FIRST HOUSE SITTING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF WILDWOOD, IT IS APPROXIMATELY 2000 FEET. A .22 LONG RIFLE BULLET TRAVELS AT 1255 FEET PER SECOND AND CAN TRAVEL UNIMPEDED 4590 FEET. THAT'S JUST UNDER A MILE. THE .223 CALIBER TRAVELS ABOUT 2 MILES UNIMPEDED. THESE ARE BOTH POPULAR CALIBER OF GUNS THAT ARE MOST LIKELY USED AT THE GUN RANGE, AMONG OTHERS.

IT IS THE BELIEF OF THE HOMEOWNERS OF WILDWOOD THAT THE EARTHEN BACKSTOP AT THE GUN RANGE ON GIHON ROAD IS NOT OF AN ADEQUATE HEIGHT TO CONTAIN BULLETS FIRED FROM THE RIFLE RANGE. THE PRIMARY PURPOSE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BACKSTOP IS TO PROTECT AGAINST THE INJURY OF PEOPLE, THE DAMAGE OF PROPERTY OR BOTH.

WITHIN WILDWOOD PROPER, I PERSONALLY KNOW OF 3 SEPARATE PROPERTIES THAT HAVE BEEN DAMAGED BY BULLETS ALLEGEDLY FIRED FROM THE RIFLE RANGE.

THE BACKSTOP PROVIDES THE PRIMARY IMPACT AREA FOR THE BULLETS BEING FIRED ON A PARTICULAR RANGE AND UNDER NORMAL CONDITIONS PREVENTS THE BULLET FROM LEAVING THE RANGE PROPER. REFERRING TO THE "NRA SOURCE MANUAL", PAGE I-1-24, THE RECOMMENDED HEIGHT FOR A BACKSTOP IS 20 FEET HIGH. IT ALSO CAUTIONS AGAINST USING AUTOMOBILE OR TRUCK TIRES IN BACKSTOP CONSTRUCTION. AGAIN, WE FEEL THE HEIGHT OF THE BACKSTOP IS INADEQUATE TO CONTAIN BULLETS BEING FIRED FROM THE RIFLE RANGE.

THE BOTTOM LINE IS TO DEVELOP A SHOOTING RANGE IN HARMONY WITH ADJACENT PROPERTIES AND WHERE SAFETY IS PROVIDED TO SAID ADJACENT PROPERTIES FROM EXPERIENCING ANY ENCROACHMENT. ALL NEIGHBORS MUST BE SAFE FROM INJURY. THE OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RANGE OWNER IS TO STOP FIRED BULLETS BEFORE THEY EXIT THE PROPERTY LINE. ACCORDING TO THE WOOD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, THERE HAVE BEEN 35 REPORTED INCIDENTS RELATED TO THE GUN RANGE.

COMMISSIONERS, WE REQUEST THAT THE WOOD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT EXAMINE THE RIFLE RANGE EARTHEN BACKSTOP TO DETERMINE ITS ACTUAL HEIGHT AND REPORT BACK TO THIS COMMISSION WITH THAT INFORMATION TO DETERMINE WHAT IF ANY ACTION SHOULD BE TAKEN TO INSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL AFFECTED PARTIES.

AGAIN, LET ME RE-EMPHASIZE, COMPLETELY SAFE RANGES CANNOT BE DESIGNED.

Congratulations on your election as our sheriff for a fourth term. We look forward to having you and your staff serve Wood County with the same service and dedication as the previous administration.

As a citizen of Wood County I'm asking for your help in addressing an ongoing issue that the fine residents of Wildwood have been dealing with for the past 8-10 months. We are located in the line of fire from a pistol and rifle range located on Gihon Road. We have experienced numerous incidents of stray bullets that have passed through trees, bullet holes in the side of more than one house within our development and spent bullets lying in the streets. It is our belief that the stray bullets are coming from the above mentioned gun range and we have no way of defending ourselves short of asking the Wood County Commissioner's and now you to help find a resolution to this dangerous situation.

We have addressed our concerns with the Wood County Commission on more than one occasion and they have attempted to resolve the problem with the owner of the gun range to no avail. It is our understanding that an earthen barrier is required as a backstop and the one that is in place is not adequate for the current use at the gun range. We were told that Commissioner Dunn recently tried to speak with the owner about this but the owner refused to talk with him about it.

As citizens and taxpayers of Wood County, we are asking your office for help in finding a solution to this problem that threatens our lives and the peace and quiet that everyone should be able to enjoy within their own neighborhood.

Please help us in doing what is right to protect the residents of Wildwood.






