At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

Ed Layton and Christopher Cullen were sworn in as Part-time Court Security and Transport Officers.

The County Commission approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to real and personal property. Copies are attached to these minutes and shall be made a part thereof.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of April 3 and 7, 2014.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Howard Baldwin to fill a vacancy on the Mineral Wells Public Service District Board.

At 9:39 A.M., the County Commission met Chief Deputy Shawn Graham and Tom Smith from the Wood County Sheriff's Department. They discussed questions that the Commission had about the purchase of uniforms. They signed the purchase orders in question. They also discussed the salary of Tom Smith for the upcoming fiscal year. Chief

Graham stated this position was created by the former Sheriff and is necessary even after Mr. Smith leaves and they are still not sure when he is leaving. They then discussed a locker request, approximately \$3,000.00 for the Holding Center. Employees currently have no place to put their belongings. The County Commission had no problem with this request.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Sam Deal Estate. Betty Deal spoke about a credit card. After discussion, the County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and made unanimous by Wayne Dunn, Ordered that the claim be disallowed. Information in regard to this estate is on file in the Probate Office. (Probate Order)

At 10:06 A.M., the County Commission met with Jason Wharton, Prosecuting Attorney and Mark Rhodes to discuss the election procedure related to the withdrawal of Robert Tebay. President Dunn recused himself and Commissioner Gainer took over the meeting. After discuss about the different options, the County Commission asked Mr. Wharton to get an opinion from the Attorney General.

At 10:34 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Ronald Thompson Estate. Berkley Simmons, Attorney, was present representing Marjorie Mays, beneficiary. He asked that the Sheriff be removed as Administrator CTA. After discussion and statements from Morna Knotts (Evans), the County Commission continued said hearing generally. Information in regard to this estate if on file in the Probate Office. (Probate Order)

At 10:50 A.M., Jim Viers from the American Legion stopped in to ask the Commission to sponsor a few boys for the American Legion Mountaineer Boys State Program. The Commission asked that it be placed on the agenda for April 21, 2014.
