AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with representatives from Westbrook Health Services to discuss the services they provide. Handouts are attached and should be made a part thereof.

At 9:52 A.M., the County Commission discussed the possible formation of a Wood County Fire Board. Prosecuting Attorney, Jason Wharton and several firefighters representing the Wood County Firefighters' Association were in attendance. A discussion ensued relating to a fire fee versus a fire levy, as well as the requirements for the creation of the Fire Board. The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, authorized the commencement of the process of formation of the Wood County Fire Service Board. (Order M/2762)

At 10:24 A.M., the County Commission discussed the County Purchasing Policy. Prosecuting Attorney, Jason Wharton, acted as a spokesman for the elected officials. Commissioner Couch made a motion that all requisitions require two signatures before approval for a purchase been now and the end of the year. The motion died for the lack of a second.

At 10:44 A.M., the County Commission placed the name of Howard Baldwin in nomination to the Mineral Wells Public Service District. (Order A/1270)

At 10:48 A.M., the County Commission appointed Andrew Borkowski and Bill Ambrose to the Wood County Parks and Recreation Commission Public Utility Board. (Order A1271)

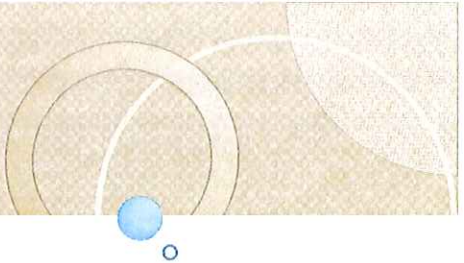

The TENANT shall provide at a minimum thirty-four (34) charity care bed treatments for inpatient treatment to Wood County residents on an annual basis during the term of this Lease. Priority shall be given inmates incarcerated on Wood County charges in consideration for placement in said bed space.

Justification to Support Continued Contract for Building Outside of the Charity Care Dollar Expectation

On January 1st, 2014, the Affordable Care Act was initiated. Many people previously considered “Charity Care” are now eligible for Medicaid reimbursement for services. This shifts the money to the federal Medicaid program from the state general revenue fund. Since January, there have been over 600 Westbrook clients who have switched their funding from Charity Care to Medicaid.

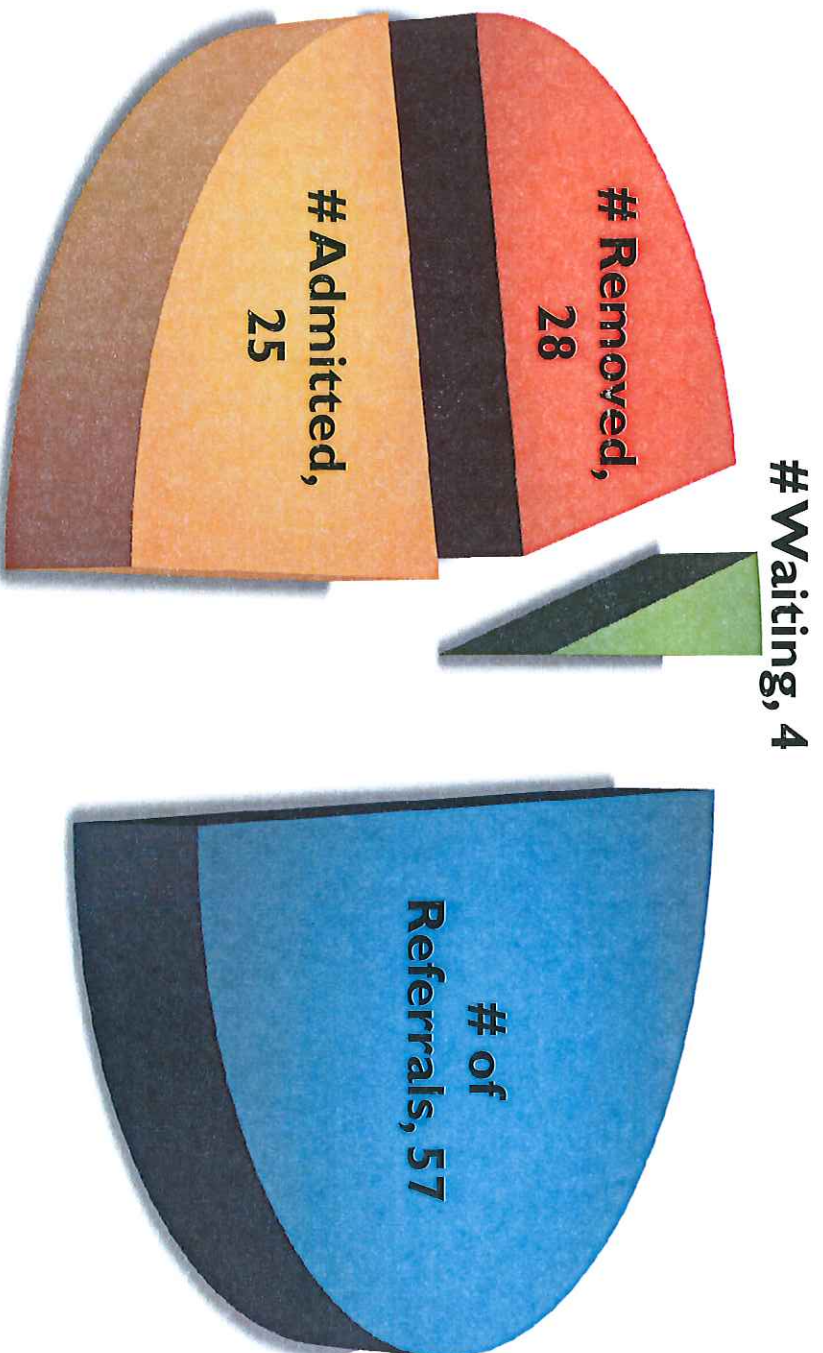

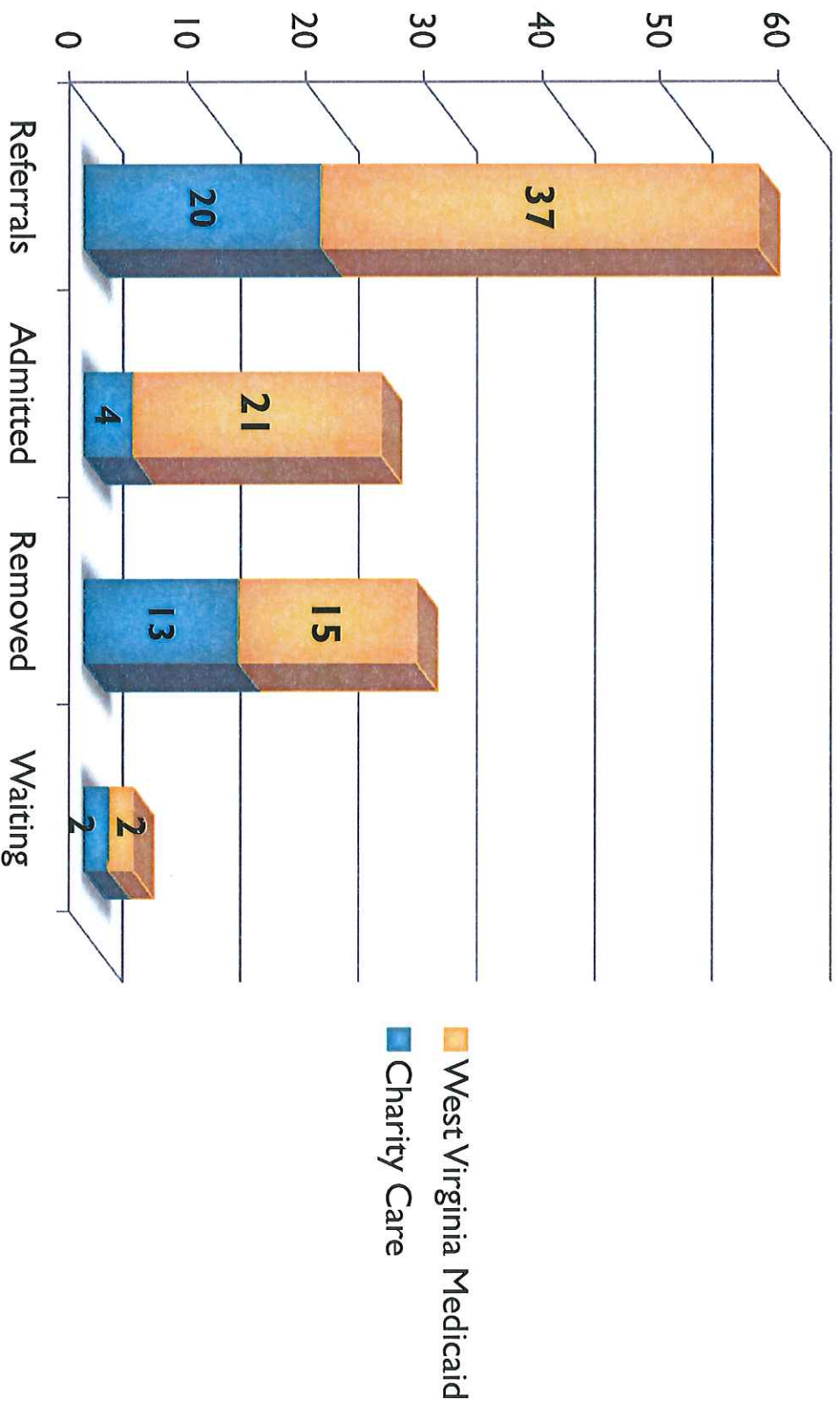
Data on Admissions and Funding for Amity Program

1st Quarter 2014

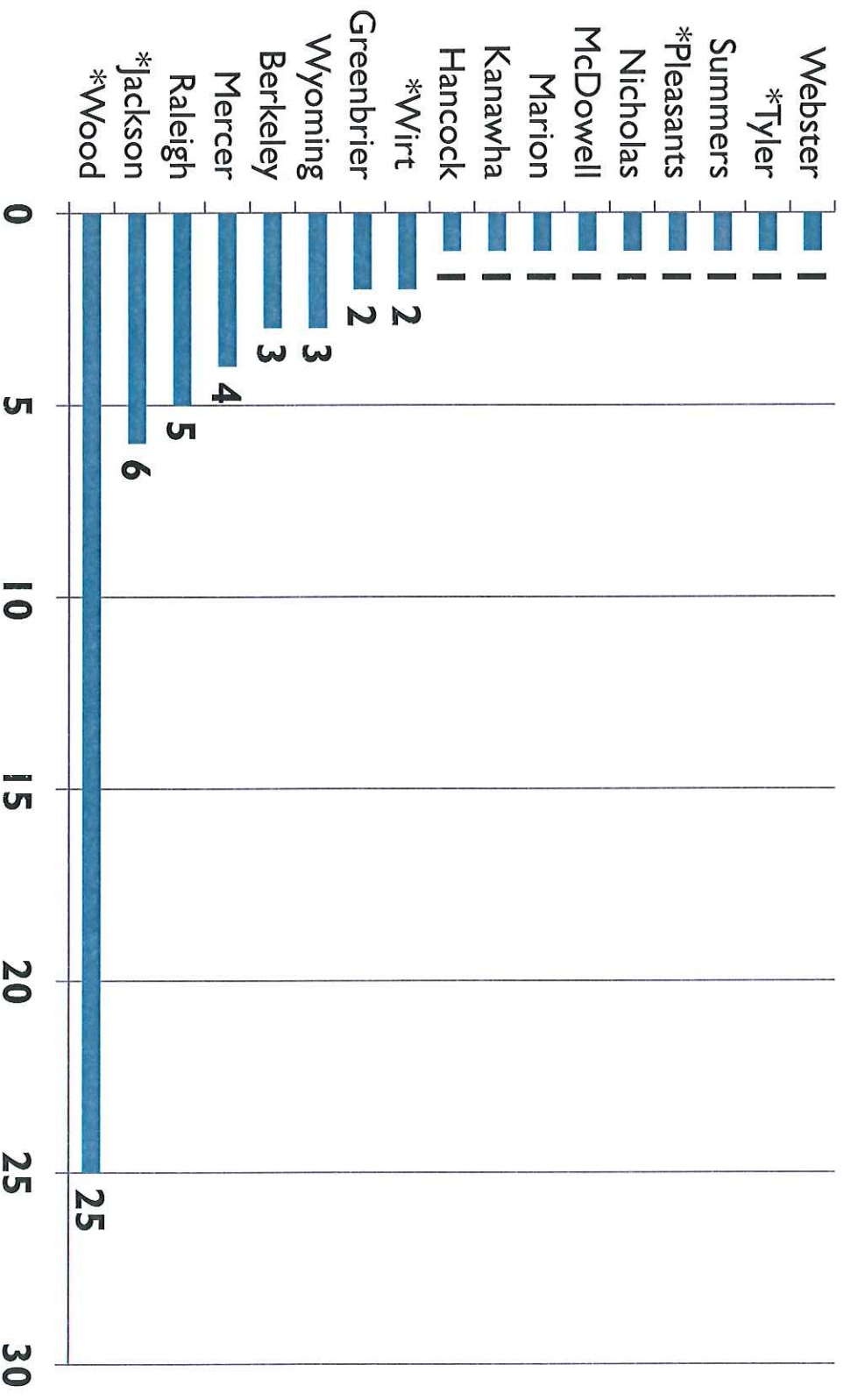


Amity Detox & Treatment Center Wood County Referrals 1st Quarter 2014 – Funding Source



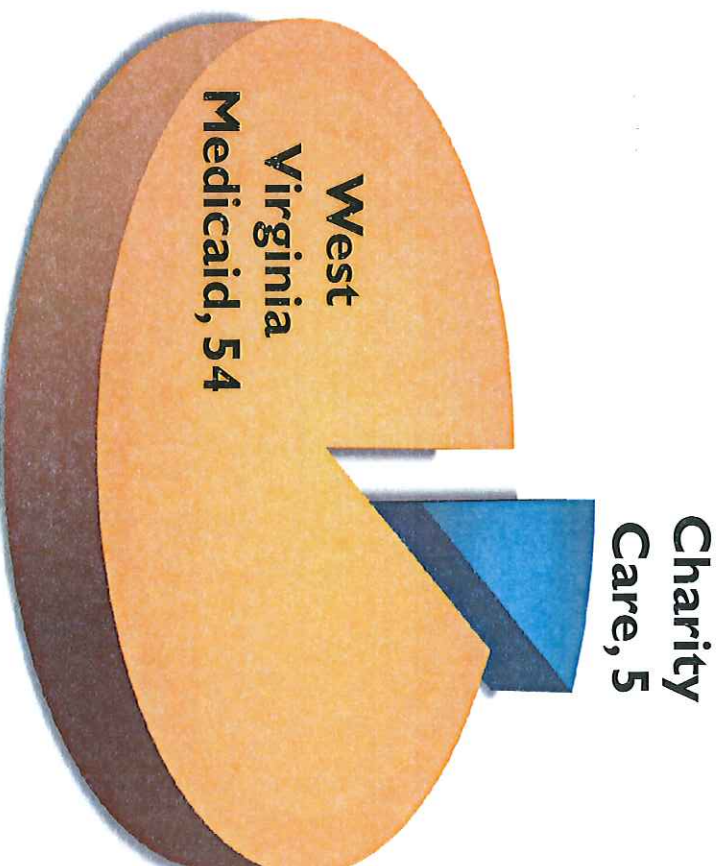
Amity Detox & Treatment Center 59 Total Admissions, by County

1st Quarter 2014**

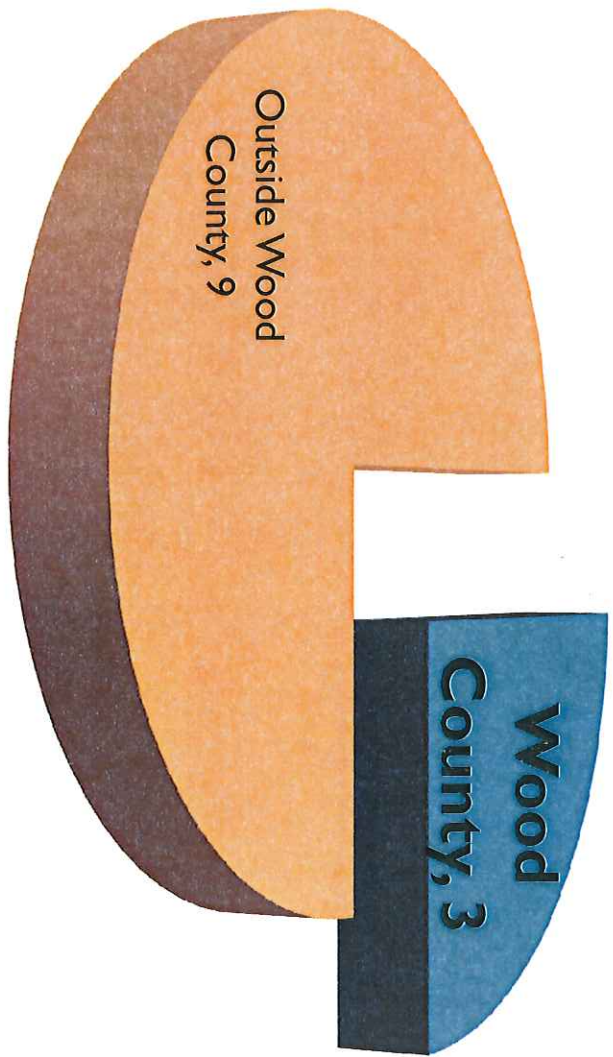

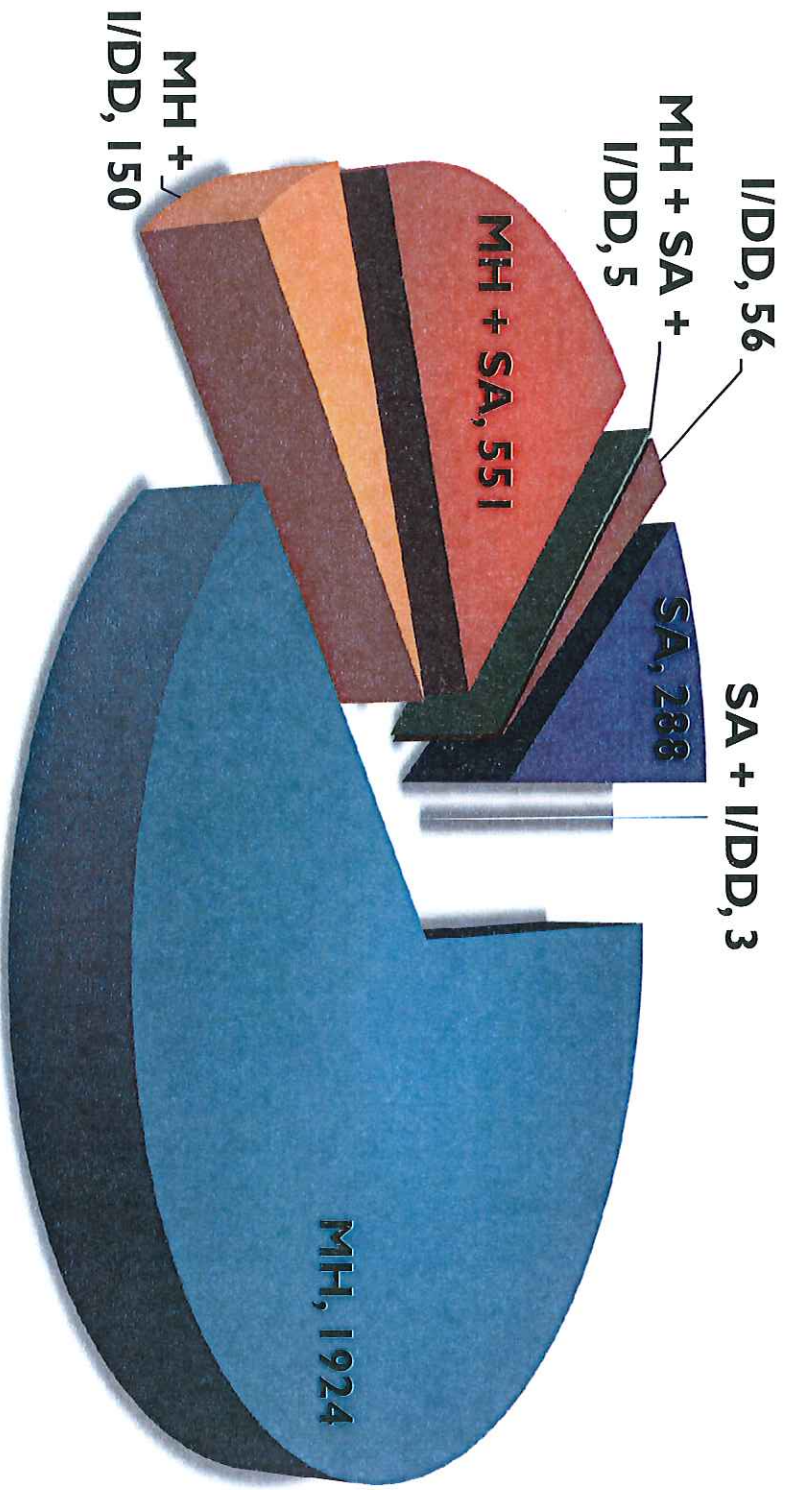

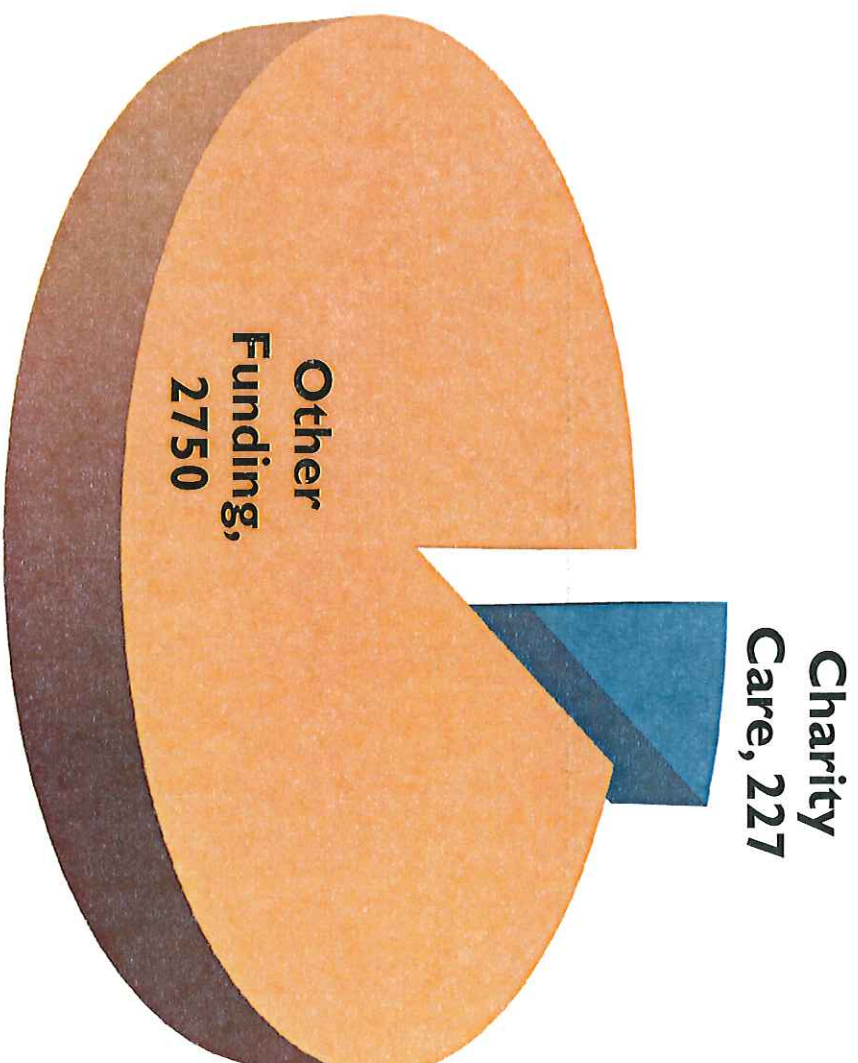

1st Quarter 2014



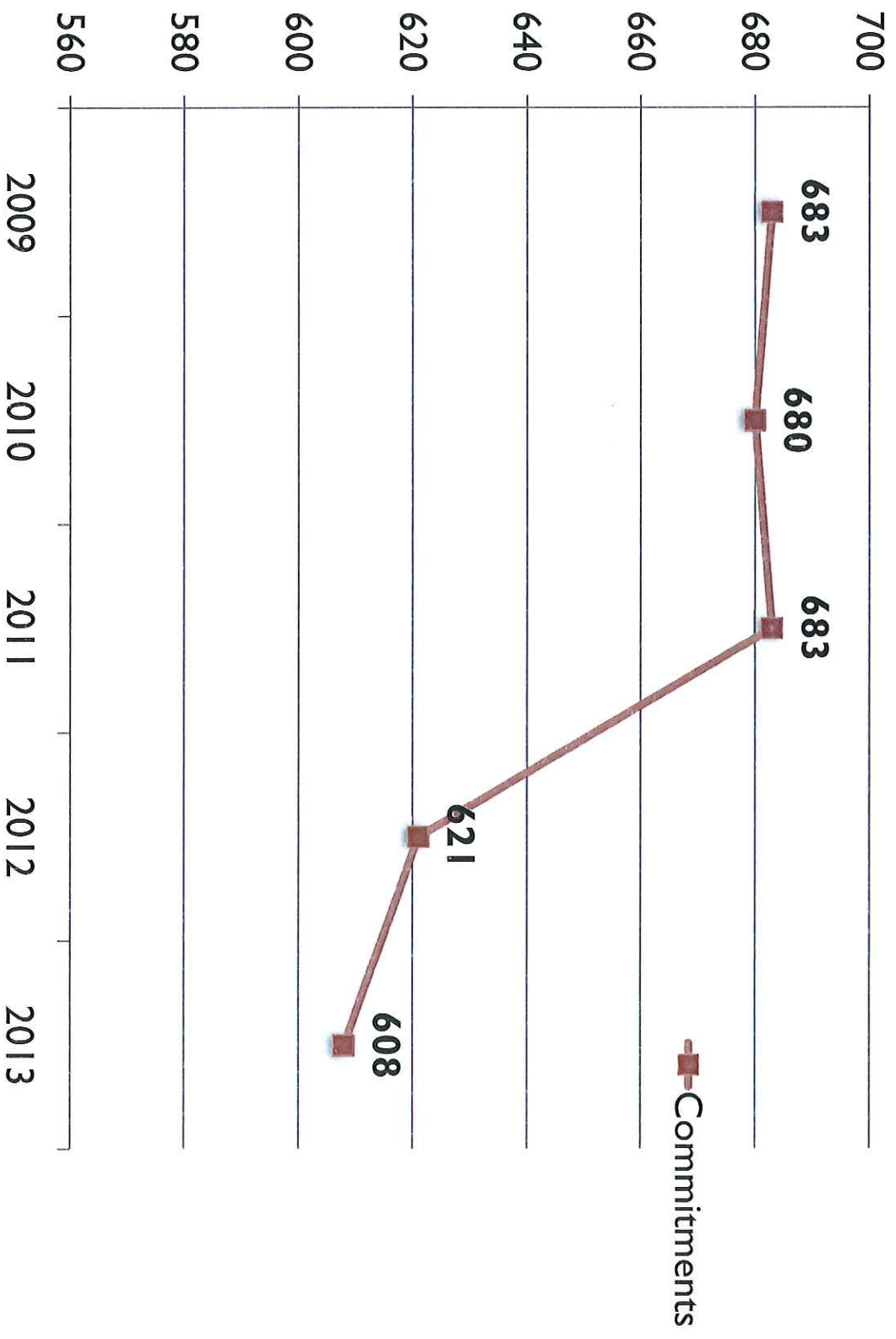

- Trend lines show a decrease in commitments which results in cost savings for the Wood County Commission.

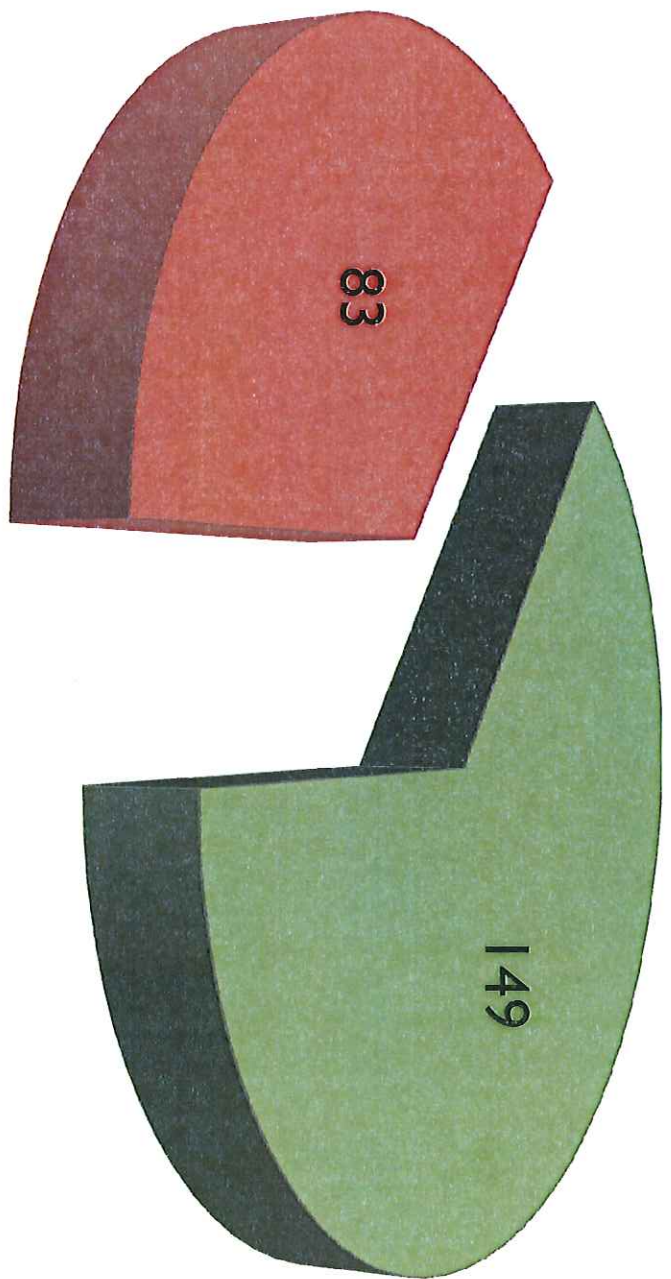


Gentlemen:
