#### 2. Summary

Wood County's newest park, Fort Boreman is the site of a Civil War Fort on a hilltop overlooking the scenic valley formed by the confluence of the Little Kanawha and Ohio rivers at Parkersburg. Built by Union troops to protect the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad terminal and the key commercial river facilities in the valley, Fort Boreman was named for West Virginia's first governor, Parkersburg citizen Arthur I. Boreman.

The fort site became a favorite overlook and picnic area in the late 19th and early 20th Centuries, but by the mid-1900s it had become overgrown and forgotten. Plans to create a park were initiated in 1997, and the Fort Boreman site was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2003. Open year-round.

The Fort Boreman Park sign project will provide new signage to help educate its many year-round visitors. It will begin with a 36x60 sign that will help guide visitors down a path of historical moments in time for the park and surrounding sites. There will also be a map of the new walking trail with its many views of downtown Parkersburg, WV.

#### 3. Description of Work

The Project will consist of developing 12 unique signs based on the park history outlined below. This will include the sign design, panel material and post/frame that embody the look and feel of the history and the current park theme.

Design/panel development includes: Scanning or capturing current sign data, design/layout of new copy, image/theme, 8.5x11 sign proofs, and production of DuraReader dHPL panels. Panels include 1 round of major changes and 3 rounds of minor changes. All image/manuscript will be provided by the Park Director or Wood County Commission.

The DuraReader is a Digital High Pressure Laminate (dHPL) phenolic interpretive sign panel – the Interpretive Sign specified most by the National Park Service. It's the toughest, most durable phenolic interpretive sign panel available anywhere. It combines the most advanced graphic imaging with the proven durability of Digital High Pressure Laminate. Using extreme heat & pressure, the final DuraReader dHPL interpretive sign panel is a permanent fusion of image and HPL that can never delaminate, separate, crack or peel.

NPS Style Exhibit Bases have a full metal backing, and are made from 10% post-industrial recycled aluminum, for use with our 1/8" EnviroReader interpretive signs and our 1/8" DuraReader interpretive signs. Standard finish is a black powder coat, but several custom finishes are available. Custom exhibit bases are also available. NPS Style Exhibit Bases are available in 30 and 45 degree angles, but 45 degree is our standard angle. Made in the USA.



#### **GRANT CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

#### BETWEEN THE

#### DIVISION OF JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

#### AND

# Wood County Commission 15-CC-09

This **AGREEMENT**, entered into this <u>22<sup>nd</sup> day of July, 2014</u> by the Director of the Division of Justice and Community Services, hereinafter referred to as "DJCS", for and on behalf of the State of West Virginia, and <u>Wood County Commission</u>, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee."

WHEREAS, DJCS is the recipient of Community Corrections Funds from the State of West Virginia, and

WHEREAS, the Grantee is an eligible applicant who is desirous of receiving funds for: These funds will be utilized for the continued operation of a community corrections program in Wood, Jackson, Roane, and Wirt Counties.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

- 1. The Grantee agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and rules, regulations and policies promulgated thereunder.
- 2. DJCS agrees to assist the Grantee to perform such tasks and functions as set forth in the application which is attached hereto and made part hereof, hereinafter referred to as Attachment A.
- 3. The Grantee shall do, perform, and carry out in a satisfactory and proper manner as determined by DJCS all duties, tasks and functions necessary to implement the application which is hereto attached as Attachment A.

- 4. The Grantee will commence its duties under the Agreement on <u>July 1, 2014</u> and shall continue those services/activities until <u>June 30, 2015</u>. The terms of this Agreement may only be extended or modified by the mutual written agreement of the parties hereto.
- 5. In consideration of the services rendered by the Grantee, the sum of up to \$476,000.00 shall be obligated by DJCS and said amount shall be deemed to be the maximum compensation to be received for this Agreement unless a written modification is entered into between the parties amending this Agreement.
- 6. It is the understanding of all parties to this Agreement that DJCS by joining in the Agreement does not pledge, or promise to pledge, the credit of the State of West Virginia, nor does it promise to pay all of the compensation hereunder from monies of the Treasury of the State of West Virginia.
- 7. To be eligible for any and all payments of the grant amount, the Grantee shall submit a Request for Funds no more frequently than once a month to DJCS. Upon receipt of said request, DJCS shall review the same for reasonableness and appropriateness; and if approved, will cause a warrant to be requested on that sum considered reasonable and appropriate. It is expressly understood that the total compensation shall not exceed the amount set forth in Paragraph Five hereinbefore cited and said compensation will be expended only as outlined in the budget sections of Attachment A, unless written approval of modification of the budget is signed by the parties hereto. Grantee shall submit a fiscal report detailing expenditures to DJCS by the twentieth (20th) day of each month.
- 8. Grantee hereby represents that it possesses the legal authority to contract for this Agreement and that attached hereto and made a part hereof as Attachment B is a certified copy of the resolution, motion or similar action which was clearly adopted or passed by the Grantee's governing body; and further, that it has directed and authorized an official representative to act in connection with this Agreement. If the Grantee is a State agency, the completed application signed by the agency head is sufficient.
- Grantee agrees to abide by the grant conditions, terms, assurances and certifications which are a part of Attachment A and such other special terms and conditions that DJCS has set forth in Attachment C which is incorporated herein and made part hereof, if said Special Conditions are appropriate to this Agreement.
- 10. If, through any cause, the Grantee shall fail to fulfill in a necessary and proper manner his obligations under this Agreement, the DJCS may withhold payments to the Grantee upon notice in writing, suspend, or cancel this Agreement and Attachments. The notice of withholding payments, suspension, or cancellation should set forth the DJCS reasons for taking said action.
- 11. DJCS and Grantee may from time to time require changes in the scope of services performed hereunder. Grantee agrees to submit a written request for modification prior to changing any budget line item. All such changes, including any increase or decrease in the amount of compensation here-under or work to be performed, which are mutually agreed upon between the parties shall be in writing.

- 12. If for any reason funds received by DJCS are suspended or terminated, in whole or in part, funding for this Agreement shall cease.
