At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of January 13, 16 and 23, 2014.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:33 A.M., the County Commission approved the hiring of Jason L. Enoch as a part-time dispatcher at the E-911 Center.

At 9:34 A.M., the County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and made unanimous by Wayne Dunn, approved the Application of the Prosecuting Attorney for the extradition of Jessica D. Smith. (Order M/extradition Smith)

At 9:37 A.M., the County Commission held a discussion related to the closing at then end of December of the Public Intoxication Center at Westbrook Greg Smith from the Latrobe Street Mission was in attendance and stated they stand ready to take over the service, but reminded the Commission they will need \$60,000.00 to provide the service to the County for the remainder of calendar year 2014. He stated they intend to apply for grant funding to carry the program after that. Steve Stephens, Wood County Holding Center Director, was in attendance and provided a three month look back at the number of people being placed into the Center for public intoxication. The numbers were low and Jason Wharton, Wood County Prosecuting Attorney, advised the Commission the

financial liability to the County was far less than the \$60,000.00 being requested by the Latrobe Street Mission. At that time Greg Smith stated that regardless of whether they run the Center in 2014 or not, they will need to make changes in their lease arrangement as well as construction changes to the building to accommodate the Center after this fiscal year. The Commissioners agreed to visit the Center in one week and then take a look at the potential funds needed for the Center.

At 10:06 A.M., Commissioner Couch announced that the County Administrator, Marty Seufer, had received the resignation of Dennie Huggins, Director of the Wood County Day Report Center, effective February 28, 2014. (Copy attached to these minutes.)

At 10:08 A.M., the County Commission accepted a proposed amendment to the Wood County Land Use Regulations regarding road construction. Wood County Compliance Officer, John Reed, Presented to the Commission. (Order M/2679)

The three scheduled Board of Review and Equalization hearings were cancelled due to the weather by the individuals wishing to appear before the Commission.





Following the affirmative vote by the Wood County Planning Commission to amend the current Land Use Regulations, following is the suggested change:

Replace Section 6.14.g. with the following:

The subdivider shall be responsible for utilizing concrete in the pouring of any street or sidewalk that meets the West Virginia Department of Transportation Concrete Mix Design Standards. A certification of standards shall be supplied to the subdivider by the company supplying the concrete, and shall be maintained in the subdividers records indefinitely. Furthermore, the subdivider shall supply a copy of the report to the Planning Director.

Add Section 6.14.h.

The County Compliance Officer shall be notified at least seventy two (72) hours prior to the pouring of any concrete street or sidewalk, so that inspection may be made as to compliance with Section 6 of this ordinance. The concrete pour may be applied only after the County Compliance Officer grants final approval of the base construction.

4. That this request is made in good faith and not for the purpose of collecting a debt or for any private purpose whatever, and if the requisition now applied for be granted, criminal proceedings shall not be used for any of said objects.

5. That no former application for a requisition for said accused, growing out of the same transaction, has been made.

I annex hereto a certified copy of the warrant against her with affidavit to the facts thereof by a person having actual knowledge thereof.

I respectfully recommend the Parkersburg Police Department, or their duly authorized agents, as a proper person to be appointed as agent to bring said accused to this State, and certify said proposed agent has no private interest in the arrest and bringing to this State said accused.
