Commissioner Couch presented the Oaths of Office for Blaine Auville, Kenny Harris, Randy Lowe, John Rockhold, Chief Steve Scholl, Steve Simonton, Todd Wines and Chief George Young who were sworn in on June 11, 2014 to the Wood County Local Emergency Planning Committee.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of May 29, 2014 and June 2, 2014.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Mark Schwendeman and Angie Lawrence from Schwendeman Insurance to discuss the health insurance for the County employees. The Commission asked this to be moved to the agenda on Thursday.

At 11:20 A.M., the County Commission adjourned to visit the County cemetery.



