At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of April 23, 25 and 28, 2014.

Howard Baldwin was sworn in as a member of the Mineral Wells Public Service District Board.

The County Commission approved Erroneous Assessment Applications in regard to personal and real property. Copies are attached to these minutes and shall be made a part thereof.

The County Commission denied an Erroneous Assessment Application in the name of JD's Restoration and Collision. (Order A/1275)

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission viewed a presentation about Fort Boreman Park made by eighth grade students.

At 9:43 A.M., the County Commission viewed a presentation about the State of West Virginia made by the students.

At 9:56 A.M., the County Commission met with Rick Woodyard, E-911 Director. Mr Woodyard informed them of a need to replace equipment on the emergency towers. He stated he has a limited time to purchase six repeater units off the GSA bid sheet before they go up in price. He also stated they will need two repeaters for the EMS side. The total cost would be \$47,800.00. The County Commission authorized the purchase. (Order M/2781)

At 10:03 A.M., the County Commission discussed the county purchasing guidelines. Commissioner Dunn suggested moving the preapproved purchasing limit to \$2,000.00. Commissioner Couch asked this be moved to next Monday's agenda when Jason Wharton is available. The Commission voted to table this discuss to May 19, 2014. (Order M/2779)

At 10:05 A.M., the County Commission approved the hiring of Kirk Auvil as an intern in the Prosecuting Attorney's Office.

At 10:06 A.M., the County Commission approved Wesley R. Thomas as a new Deputy Sheriff. Wesley R. Thomas was sworn in as a Deputy Sheriff with the Wood County Sheriff's Department.

At 10:10 A.M., the County Commission tabled a discussion relating to the form required by the West Virginia State Auditor's Office regarding the affordability of the County to provide the Elected Officials pay increases. This will be placed on the May 15, 2014 agenda. (Order M/2778)

At 10:15 A.M., the County Commission met with Bob Enoch from the Wood County Historical Society and discussed the Society. Mr. Enoch requested a transfer of the

hotel/motel tax from the Historical Society general fund towards the purchase of the Tavenner House. Said request was approved.

At 10:25 A.M., the County Commission toured the former Wood County Sheriff's Offices.
