

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 16th day of October 2014 by and between the Wood County Commission hereinafter referred to as the "COUNTY" and the Mid-Ohio Valley Area Development Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "ADMINISTRATOR", set forth as follows:

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has received a Hazard Mitigation Grant for the Wood County Happy Valley V Mitigation Project; and

WHEREAS, the ADMINISTRATOR has had extensive experience in the proper administration and operation of Hazard Mitigation Grant projects and adherence to the regulations required thereof.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the **COUNTY** and the ADMINISTRATOR do agree as follows:


