At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices, orders and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of October 16 and 20, 2014.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:37 A.M., the County Commission awarded the Request for Proposal for the signage project at Fort Boreman Park to Stonewall Group. (Order M/2951)

At 9:40 A.M., the County Commission met with James E. Smith, who requested a hearing for the closing of Thomas Run Road in Belleville. (Order M/2952)

At 9:48 A.M., the County Commission, upon a motion made by Wayne Dunn, seconded by Stephen Gainer and made unanimous by David Blair Couch, reappointed Greg Arnott to the Union Williams Public Service District. (Order M/2954)

At 9:50 A.M., the County Commission approved the hiring of Brady Stephens as Court Security for the Wood County Sheriff's Office.

At 9:51 A.M., the County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Wayne Dunn and mad unanimous by Stephen Gainer, appointed, at the recommendation of the Community Corrections Board, Hernando Escandon as the Director and Amy Church as the Assistant Director. Said appointments are contingent upon the appropriate grant funding. (Order M/2956)

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission met with Jean Grapes and Brenda Brum, who requested funding for the Parkersburg Coalition for the Homeless. Following a conversation in which all three Commissioners took part, Wayne recused himself stating his wife services on the Board of the Coalition. Upon a motion made by Stephen Gainer, seconded by David Blair Couch and made unanimous with Wayne Dunn recusing himself, authorized a donation of \$2,500.00. They further authorized matching funds up to \$5,000.00 if the City of Parkersburg makes a donation as well. (Order M/2955)

At 10:20 A.M., Commissioner Dunn informed the County Administrator that the Commission needed a written plan on how the Commission Office will operate during the Administrator's upcoming need for a possible extended leave due to illness. The County Administrator stated he did not anticipate being off any longer than a normal vacation, but in his absence, the current office staff would cover the office. They would also have access to the Administrator via telephone throughout any possible absence. Commissioner Dunn stated that may not be acceptable and he needed a plan. Hearing no motion made and no other concern expressed from any other Commissioner, the Administrator excused himself from the meeting stating he did not feel his medical condition needed to be discussed in an open meeting of the Commission.


At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission adjourned to Fort Boreman Park for the opening of a trail.

Dear Commissioners Gainer and Couch:

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the *House to Home* shelter facility, I am writing to you about the services we provide to homeless people and others in need in our community.

House to Home is located at 413 Eighth Street in Parkersburg. *House to Home* has been in operation since 2004, and we now operate from our own building after relocating from Market Street in 2007. This shelter facility is open six days per week to provide a place for homeless persons to shower, wash clothes, find food and clothing and other assistance. While we do not provide sleeping facilities, we do offer a place during daytime hours when other shelters are typically closed. *House to Home* is the only facility in the area that provides a place for our clients to go during the daytime to take care of their daily needs. By providing a place for our clients, they are not forced to seek shelter in public places such as the library, the courthouse or local restaurants. These services not only are beneficial to our clients, but also to our community.

In August 2013, we hired a full-time Executive Director rather than continuing to rely upon volunteer assistance in the day-to-day operations of the shelter. This step allowed us to improve our services, and to provide stability for our program.

House to Home offers important and much needed services to this area's homeless. While our program operates on a very modest budget to assist those in need, we cannot do it alone. The Wood County Commission has a record of supporting community programs. We are writing to request a donation of \$5000 from the Commission to help defray our annual expenses and to keep our doors open. We are also asking for an informal commitment that this donation be continued from year to year as a permanent part of the budget of the Wood County Commission. ^{g.c.} \$2,500

West Virginia County Records Management and Preservation Board Grant Guidelines 2015-2016

The Records Management and Preservation Board awards grants to county commissions to assist office holders in the management and preservation of county records. Applications may be submitted in behalf of the office of the assessor, circuit clerk, county clerk, prosecuting attorney, sheriff and/or county commission. Grant applications must demonstrate the willingness of the applicant office and the county commission to comply with all grant reporting deadlines and budget, purchasing, and reporting requirements; and to provide internal staff support to ensure the success of the project and the improvement of the management and preservation of the records addressed in the grant. Grant recipients must provide at least a ten percent (10%) cash match for each dollar expended by the RMPB. Grant funds are awarded on a reimbursement basis, which requires submission of the official Request for Reimbursement or invoice form. Multiple projects (projects representing two or more specific county offices, such as the County Clerk and Circuit Clerk) should submit separate applications, with priority ranking clearly designated by the County Commission.

The application (pages 5-9) and required supporting documentation are to be typed and on letter-size paper. An ORIGINAL signed application and thirteen complete copies must be submitted. Please see Page 4 for a list of Supporting Materials necessary to complete the application.

Applications must be completed and sent via certified mail with a postmark on or before November 1, 2014, or hand delivered by this date to: RMPB, c/o Denise Ferguson, West Virginia Archives and History, 1900 Kanawha Boulevard East, Building 9, Charleston, WV 25305-0300. Faxed or other electronic submissions will NOT be accepted. All grant applications submitted by the deadline will be reviewed for completeness and applicants contacted no later than November 15, 2014 if there are any omissions or irregularities in the submitted application. The RMPB will review all qualified grant applications, and may request applicants to present details of their proposed project.

The Records Management and Preservation Board may approve total, partial, or no funding. Applicants approved for partial funding or not approved for funding will be informed in writing by February 1, 2015 and may submit within fifteen (15) days a written appeal documenting why the RMPB's denial of application should be reconsidered. Successful applicants are to perform and complete project work during Fiscal Year 2015-16 (July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016).

Applicants are encouraged to contact Denise Ferguson, county records archivist, or Joe Geiger, director of Archives and History, at (304) 558-0230, to discuss potential projects, the general requirements of the grant, or review draft proposals in advance of the November 1 deadline for submission.

Eligible Projects:

Personnel Costs (\$10,000 maximum)

- To conduct inventory of records and remove non-records, duplicates and accumulations of records that have reached or exceeded required retention periods.
- To scan and index records using the county's existing records management software.
- To transcribe original permanent documents that are too faded to legibly scan or copy (please submit an example of the document).

Current employees may be used for hours in excess of regular work hours if devoted totally to work approved in the proposal.

Records Storage and Shelving

To provide for proper and improved physical storage units and systems for records, such as manually operated mobile track shelving systems, steel shelving, map cabinets and/or Mylar map sleeves, and standard archives records boxes (10"x12"x15").

Reformatting (\$10,000 maximum)

To improve access and preservation of records through digitization. Counties are required to verify that all digital images are exact duplicates of the original records and are to provide copies of all images in JPEG or TIFF format on external hard drives to the state archives.

Equipment (\$10,000 maximum)

To purchase public access computer terminals for the records room and/or scanners for county government employees to use for digitizing long term and/or permanent records. The scanner must be compatible with the county's existing records management software. Funding for these projects is contingent on the county's commitment to provide installation, technology support, upgrades and maintenance necessary to network the computer(s) and scanner(s) to existing database or software programs. Eligible equipment purchases may also include shredders for destruction of confidential records that have met their retention requirement.

Conservation (\$5,000 maximum)

To restore, mend, encapsulate, rebind or recover original permanent records, record books or original maps.

Ineligible Projects:

Software programs or printers

Personnel costs for new permanent positions

Personnel costs to refund or supplement salaries of staff for regular work hours

Funds for improved climate control projects such as dehumidifiers, heating/cooling and fire suppression systems

I am applying for grant funding to continue Wood County's project to index and image all deed records. All deeds are indexing and imaged from August 1985 (Book 823) to present date. We started with the assistance of a Records Management and Preservation Board Grant with Deed Book 1 and are working our way forward. The indexing and imaging of the records will permit Wood County to secure the original books to preserve them. If a person needs to look at the original from the book, it will be with the assistance of the staff. This protects the records as many books are deteriorating with pages crumbling.

There are five internal staff members who are presently working on indexing the deed records. They work on these throughout the day during work hours when time allows, and also work overtime after hours. This is a time consuming process, therefore it is slow, but the benefits are undeniably valuable.

With our indexing system, researchers will be able to look up information by name and review the document without having to open the original book. Also, our deed records are available via our website, www.woodcountywv.com/webapps/webinquiry.

Records are deteriorating with each book used. Oil and Gas researchers use the old deed records. With each copy made from the books, binders are falling apart and pages are crumbling, thus losing valuable documentation.

Being able to access this information from our website and in-house computers allows the office staff and researchers to view and print documents, saving time and preserving these valuable books and their contents. Local attorneys that have a monthly billing account set up with our office are able to print these documents from their office, which is quite advantageous for them.

Provide statement about past and future activities to protect records.

We have sent books out for repairs, including new bindings and lamination, over the years. The project began July 1, 2014 with the oldest deeds, and will continue for approximately three years. This has been a slow tedious process, but the deed records have better written property descriptions as the years go on. For example, instead of a deed saying 5,000 acres on the North Fork of the Hughes River, they will say Lot 24 of Wells Addition, which gives a section of land and the district the property lays within. With each book, they are becoming more written to today's standards, and the property being described is easier to identify.

These deed records were microfilmed many years ago before we had an image scanning system. Unfortunately, the microfilm has deteriorated, and the records do not have the clarity when printed as today's scanned images do.

Looking to the future, when all deed records have been indexed and imaged so that they can be looked up and printed from the computer, we plan to secure these books in the shelves under lock and key. If a customer needs to look at the original for some reason, they may only do so with the assistance of a staff member.


