Dear Commissioners Gainer, Couch and Tebay:

On behalf of the Board of Directors of the *House to Home* shelter facility, I am writing to you about the services we provide to homeless people and others in need in our community.

House to Home is located at 413 Eighth Street in Parkersburg. House to Home has been in operation since 2004, and we now operate from our own building after relocating from Market Street in 2007. This shelter facility is open six days per week to provide a place for homeless persons to shower, wash clothes, find food and clothing and other assistance. While we do not provide sleeping facilities, we do offer a place during daytime hours when other shelters are typically closed. House to Home is the only facility in the area that provides a place for our clients to go during the daytime to take care of their daily needs. By providing a place for our clients, they are not forced to seek shelter in public places such as the library, the courthouse or local restaurants. These services not only are beneficial to our clients, but also to our community.

In August 2013, we hired a full-time Executive Director rather than continuing to rely upon volunteer assistance in the day-to-day operations of the shelter. This step allowed us to improve our services, and to provide stability for our program.

House to Home offers important and much needed services to this area's homeless. While our program operates on a very modest budget to assist those in need, we cannot do it alone. The Wood County Commission has a record of supporting community programs. You were instrumental last year in helping us to convince the City of Parkersburg to match the county's donation of \$5000 for our program. We are again requesting a donation of \$5000 from the Commission to help defray our annual expenses and to keep our doors open.

We would be happy to present this request to the Commission at the appropriate time and place and to answer any questions about our program. "We take food, warm blankets, warm clothes, winter wear like warm socks, hats, gloves, boots," she said as touched each finger of a hand as she named her list. "Stuff people take for granted is not taken for granted here. Nothing has to be new.

"It can be, but the people here don't really care if it's used. All they really care about is it usable. We've unfortunately found ourselves at times, a dumping ground for left over yard sale items," she said.
