

2. The Administratrix properly applied and exhausted all of the assets of the probate estate by payment of:

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Commission makes the following Conclusions of Law:

1. This estate is insolvent.

2. The Administratrix has exhausted the assets of the Probate Estate to payment of debts of the estate in their proper priority of payment as required by West Virginia Code Section 44-2-21.

3. The unpaid Proof of Claim of Phillips & Cohen Associates, Ltd., is of inferior priority to the debts of the estate which were paid. The estate is insolvent; said unpaid Proof of Claim should be abated subject to revivor in the event the estate acquires additional assets; and, this estate should be closed without payment or release of said filed Proof of Claim because there are no assets in the probate estate from which to pay said claim.

### ORDER

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Commission does hereby ORDER:

1. The Final Report of SHIRLEY A. HEFNER, Administratrix of the Estate of RONALD JAY BUCHANAN, Deceased, be approved;

2. The Class Seven claim listed in the Findings of Fact above, is abated, subject to revivor in the event the estate acquires additional assets;

3. The Estate of Ronald Jay Buchanan, Deceased, is closed; and,

4. The Administratrix is discharged and any bond she has posted as Administratrix is hereby released.
