PETITION

Now come your Petitioners, THE CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, a Municipal Corporation, and the WEST VIRGINIA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, and in support of their Petition respectfully state as follows:

1. The City of Williamstown is a Municipal Corporation situate in the County of Wood and State of West Virginia, and files this Petition by virtue of the authority conferred by Chapter 8, Article 6, Section 5 of the Code of West Virginia, as amended.

2. The West Virginia Economic Development Authority desires to annex certain land to the City of Williamstown, the territory to be so annexed being situate in Williams District, Wood County, West Virginia, and no portion of which territory is within the corporate limits of any other Municipality.

3. The area sought to be annexed consists of a tracts of land containing a total of 11.8 acres identified upon the Tax Maps for Williams District, Wood County, West Virginia, as Map 50, Parcel C2 and Map 50, Parcel C3, respectively. A Plat of said tracts which appears on the Tax Maps of Williams District, Wood County, West Virginia, is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. The legal description of the property to be annexed is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit B.


5. The area sought to be annexed is contiguous to the corporate limits of the City of Williamstown.

6. In accordance with the requirements of West Virginia Code, Chapter 8, Article 6, Section 5, the Petitioners further state:

- a. There are presently no businesses located in or persons residing in the additional territory;
- b. The City of Williamstown will provide all applicable public services such as police and fire protection, solid waste collection, public water and sewer services and street maintenance services to the additional territory;
- c. The annexation of the additional territory will have no impact on fire protection, fire insurance rates, solid waste collection or upon the City's finances and other services; and
- d. The proposed annexation meets the requirements of West Virginia law.


WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that the Commission shall determine the proposed annexation to be a minor boundary adjustment; that the Commission fix a time for hearing upon this Petition; that Notice of the proposed annexation be published in accordance with the applicable statute; and that this Commission enter an Order changing the corporate limits of the City of Williamstown and annexing the territory herein described to the City of Williamstown.

SECTION 1

The Petitioner, CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, a municipal corporation within the County of Wood, State of West Virginia, hereby petitions the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, to annex certain property by minor boundary adjustment in accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code, Chapter 8, Article 6, Section 5.

SECTION 2

The territory proposed to be annexed is located in the Magisterial District of Williams District, Wood County, WV, more particularly described as follows:

Attached hereto as Exhibit A is an accurate map showing the metes and bounds of the territory proposed to be annexed and the manner in which the property is to be contiguous to the existing boundary of the municipality.

It is anticipated that the same manufacturing facility will be utilizing the annexed tract for expansion. Since the City of Williamstown already provides Police, Fire and other public services to the manufacturing facility within the City limits, it is in the interest of all citizens of the City of Williamstown and Wood County for such services to be applied to the same facility on the contiguous annexed tract, rather than have such services provided by more than one agency.




