AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission opened sealed bids for the demolition of properties in the Happy Valley Flood Mitigation Phase V Program. The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, awarded the bid to Empire Builders, INC. contingent upon review and approval of the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council. (Order M/3198)

At 9:32 A.M., the County Commission authorized the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council to submit a Drawdown for the Happy Valley Flood Mitigation Grant, Phase V in the amount of \$7,865.96. (Order M/3199)

At 9:35 A.M., the County Commission met with Karen Schimmel and Rachael Jarvis from Westbrook. They gave the Commissioners an update on the Amity Center.

At 9:42 A.M., the County Commission met with Bill Neal, owner of Woodridge and Ron Lynch, Lincolnshire resident and others to discuss a culvert at Woodridge Drive. They discussed the flooding and the possibility of a bridge or new culvert. Ed Hupp, Emergency Management Director and Fred Rader from the Mid-Ohio Valley Regional Council were also present.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, appointed Tim Roberts and Scott Elliott to the Wood County Alternative Transportation System Council. (Order A/1517)

The County Commission approved the hiring of Sherry Adams and Kaffie Waggoner at the Wood County Day Report Center.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, appointed Kim Marshall to the Wood County Fire Board. (Order A/1519)

The County Commission had a work session with Claywood Park Public Service District in regard to potential rate increases.

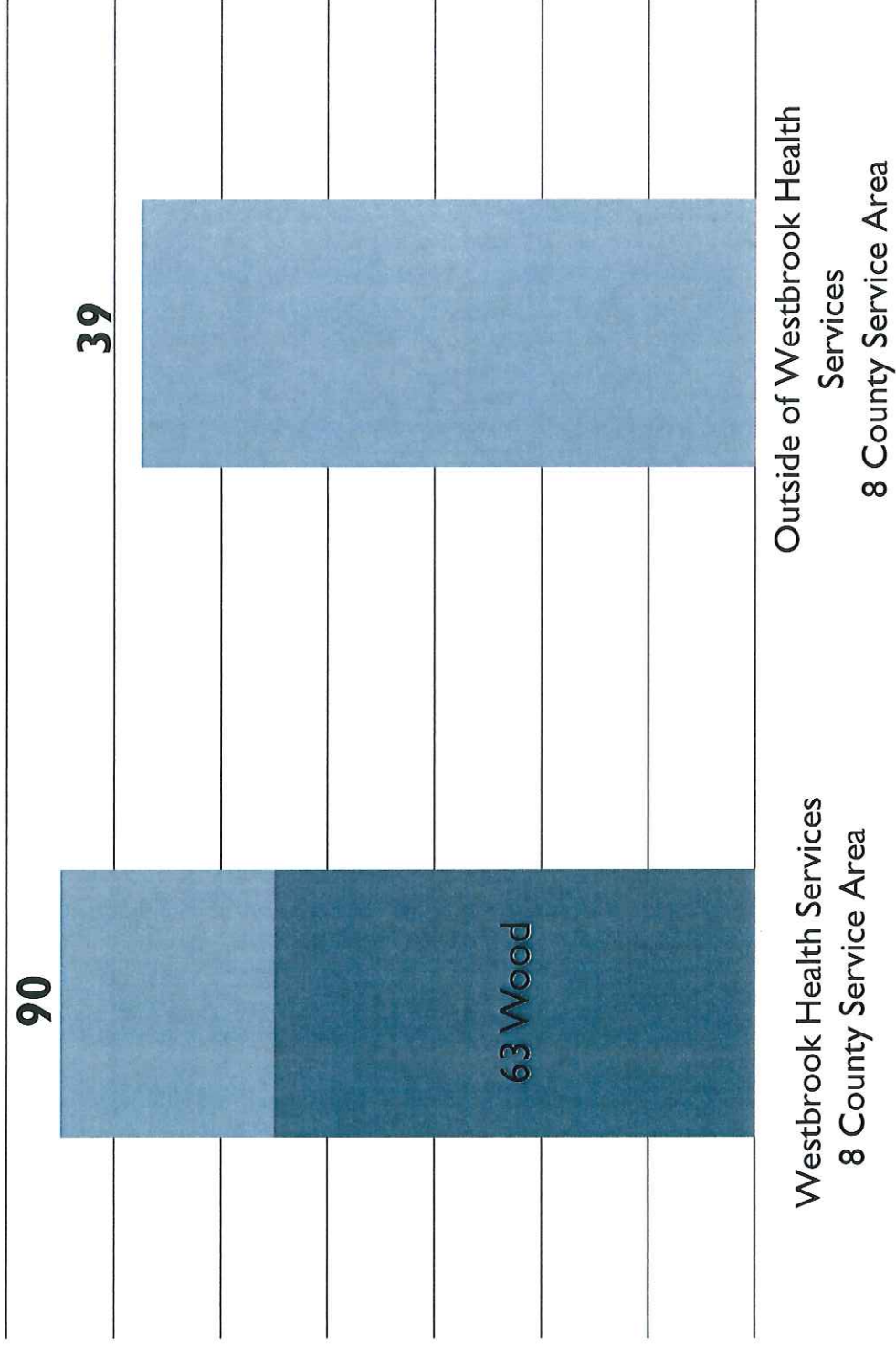

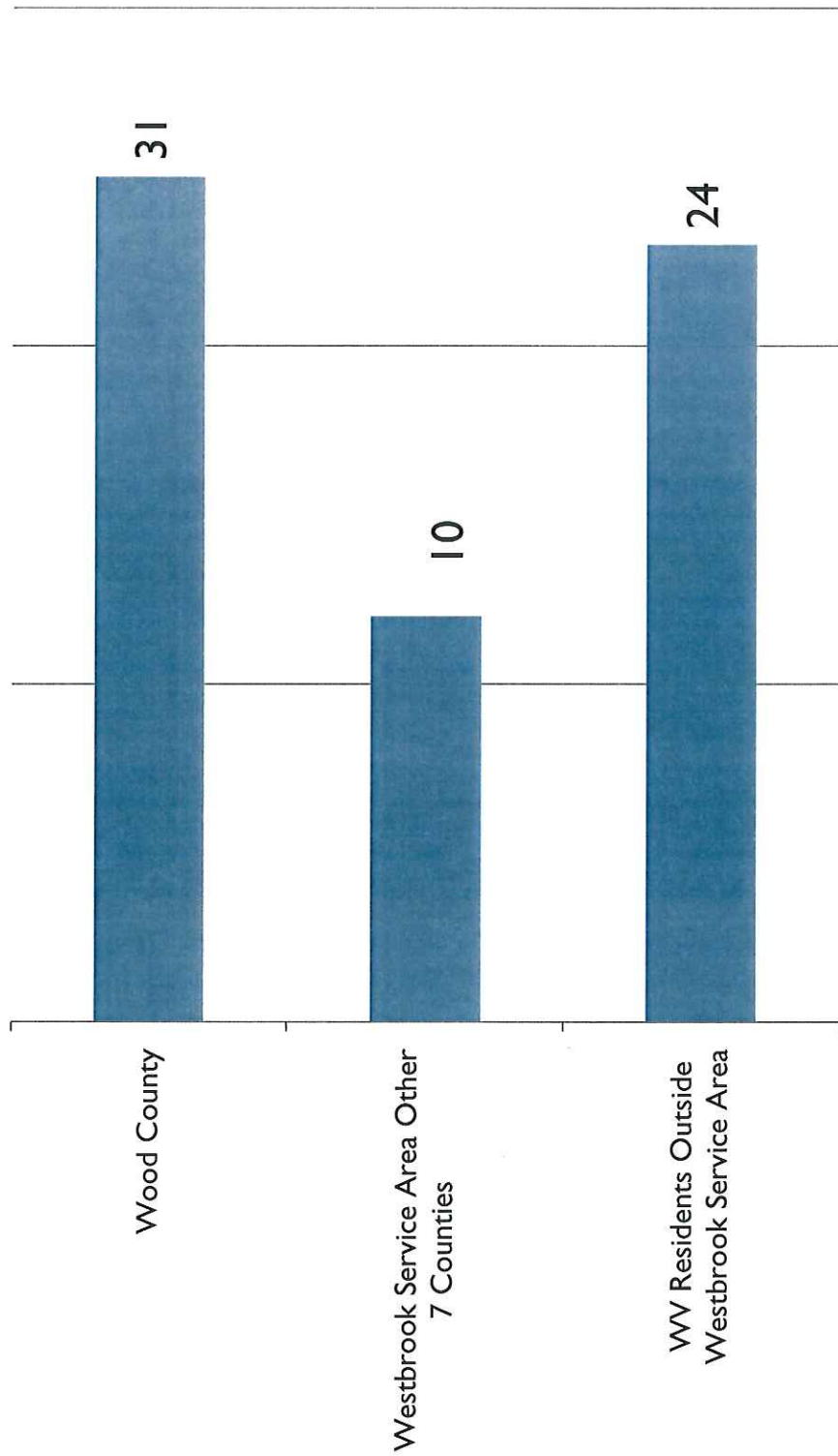

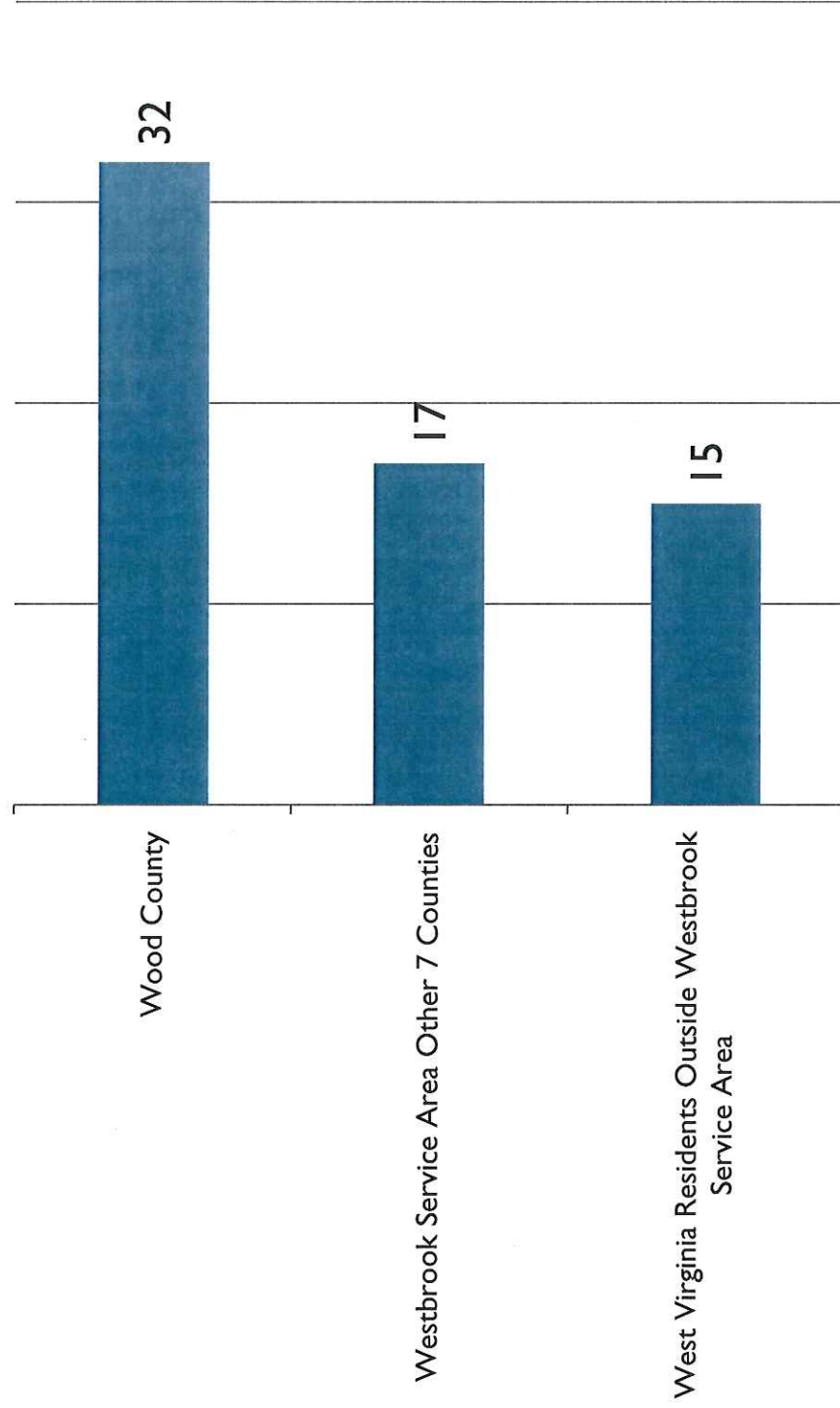

- Now when a client comes to Amity needing detox, they are transferred to the CSU for only the length of their detox, and then returned to Amity for the duration of their treatment.

RE: Washout of Woodridge Drive roadbed
by a freshet of the Little Tygart Creek

Dear Win:

As you requested, I have reviewed the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions applicable to the Woodridge Plantation Residents Association as well as the Association's Bylaws regarding its obligations following the recent washout of the roadbed where Woodridge Drive crosses over Little Tygart Creek and report to you as follows:

The Association's obligations regarding the streets within the subdivision are set out in Article V, Section 1 (v) of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions where it states that the Association "shall be responsible for all maintenance, repairs and snow removal of all streets within Woodridge Plantation until such time as said subdivision is incorporated within a municipal corporation." Article VI, Section 2, of the Declaration provides that the Association may use and employ Assessments for "paving, repaving, improvement, repair and maintenance of streets, alleys and common ways. . . ."

Newblakor, Inc. was the original developer of Woodridge Plantation Subdivision and the golf course located therein. The developer built all the streets located in the subdivision and as provided by the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions (Article IV, Section 2), the developer was to convey the common properties to the Association, not later than January 15, 1998. No such conveyance exists of record and as a result the streets are not owned by the Association. This is important because Article IV, Section 3 of the Declaration announces the right of the developer and the Association to borrow money for the purpose of improving the common properties and that said properties could be mortgaged to aid in such event. Since the Association doesn't own the common properties (including streets), they can't be used as collateral to borrow money to improve said properties.

The issue presented is whether the washout with a potential cost of \$500,000.00 to rebuild is something that the Association must remedy. Arguably "maintenance, repair and snow removal of streets," contemplates expected wear, tear and deterioration over time with attendant maintenance and repair costs manageable in amount and duration. Here you have

experienced an unprecedented flood with damage never imagined. Any possibility to borrow funds to remedy the flash flood destruction and spread the costs over an extended period of time is not available to the Association as originally provided. In addition, with the main entryway available for entry to or exit from the majority of the subdivision lots and separate, ample access to the lots on the Lincolnshire side of Little Tygart Creek, it appears that subdivision lot owners would only be subjected to occasional minor inconveniences if the street, roadbed and other structures needed to cross over the creek could not or would not be rebuilt. Any consensus of the members regarding rebuilding or abandoning any such project would be important.

Under the circumstances, I feel it to be highly unlikely that a court would order the Association to rebuild the destroyed costly passage over Little Tygart Creek, but would require the placement of proper barriers and warnings on the street at both sides of the creek.

As President of WPRA, I represent the homeowners on Plantation, Woodridge and Dover Drives. I have some points of interest I'd like to share with the board:

1-The ownership of the bridge. Our association hired an attorney to research the ownership of the streets and the bridge. His findings was that the ownership was never passed to the association by the developer, Newblakor. They were to pass ownership of said properties by Jan 15, 1998 but no such action was recorded. We are obligated with the snow removal, paving, repaving, improvement, repair and general maintenance of streets. In his opinion, this wash-out of the bridge with a potential cost of \$500,000 to clean up and rebuild is beyond the snow removal, repair and general maintenance of the streets to our Association. Since there is no ownership by the association of the streets, we can't use them as collateral to borrow money to improve such properties. He goes on to say that the main entryway is available to the majority of the subdivision and with separate, ample access to the lots on the Lincolnshire side of Little Tygart Creek, that lot owners would only be subjected to occasional inconveniences if the street, roadbed, and others structures needed to cross over the creek could not or would not be rebuilt. He also says any consensus of the members regarding rebuilding or abandoning any such project would be important. Finally, he states that, under the circumstances, that it would be highly unlikely that a court would order the Association to rebuild the destroyed costly passage over Little Tygart Creek, but would require the placement of proper barriers and warnings on the street at both sides of the creek.

2-All this being said, we are concerned citizens and I have contacted every local, state and federal agency to evaluate and request assistance. When contacting these agencies from the Governor's office to our local representative in the state Legislators office, ^{with the Nat Guard} we were not only representing Woodridge Plantation, but everyone of the area that was affected by the flood.

At this point, although all these offices were compassionate, they were not willing to become actively involved at this time. Most were wanting to see FEMA's involvement.

3. As concerned citizens, we are very interested with the clean-up of the area of the creek where the bridge was. The watershed agency of the Conservation Department has been here twice and are attempting to get federal monies to help: 1-remove the collapsed culvert 2-stop erosion on the creek bank.

I have talked many times to Ed Hupp, Wood Co Emergency Services Director, who has in turn kept me abreast of FEMA's involvement and the State Conservation Dept. He says even though we are non profit, we may not qualify for all the funds necessary to replace a bridge.

So, in response to the question "Is Woodridge making plans to replace the bridge?", the answer is "No", for 2 reasons:

of the property shall be permitted only by permission of the Residents' Association.

(u) Yard and garage sales shall be permitted only after receiving authorization permits from the Residents' Association.

(v) The Woodridge Plantation Residents' Association shall be responsible for all maintenance, repairs and snow removal of all streets within Woodridge Plantation Subdivision until such time as said subdivision is incorporated within a municipal corporation.

(w) The landscaping plan for the areas of any lot or block of future lots within thirty (30) feet of the boundary of the lot or block line adjacent to golf fairway property shall be in general conformity with the overall landscaping pattern for the golf course fairway area established by the golf course architect, and all individual lot or block landscaping plans must be approved by the Woodridge Plantation Golf Course, its agents, successors and assigns before implementation.

(x) There is reserved to Woodridge Plantation Golf Course, its agents, successors or assigns, a "Golf Course Maintenance Easement Area" on each lot adjacent to the fairways or greens of the Woodridge Plantation Golf Course. This reserved easement shall permit the Woodridge Plantation Golf Course, its agents, successors and assigns, at its election, to go on to any fairway lot at any reasonable hour and maintain or landscape the Golf Course Maintenance Easement Area. Such maintenance and landscaping shall include regular removal of underbrush, trees less than six (6) inches in diameter, stumps, trash or debris, planting of grass, watering, application of fertilizer, and mowing the Easement Area. This Golf Course Maintenance Easement Area shall be limited to the portion of such lots within thirty (30) feet of the lot line bordering the fairway, or such lesser area as may be shown as a "Golf Course Maintenance Area" on the recorded plat of such lot; provided, however, that the above described maintenance and landscaping rights shall apply to the entire lot until there has been filed with the Woodridge Plantation Golf Course a landscaping plan for such lot by the owner thereof, or alternatively, a residence constructed on the lot.

(y) Until such time as a residence is constructed on a lot, Woodridge Plantation Golf Course, its agents, successors or assigns, reserves an easement to permit and authorize registered golf course players and their caddies to enter upon a lot to recover a ball or play a ball, subject to the official rules of the course, without such entering and playing being deemed a trespass. After a residence is constructed, such easement shall be limited to that portion of the lot included in the Golf Course Maintenance Easement Area.
