PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Rachel Smith Perine was born in Doddridge County, West Virginia, on March 8, 1916; and

WHEREAS, Rachel Smith Perine was the daughter of Harvey Smith and Mary Virginia Elliott; and

WHEREAS, Rachel Smith Perine married Benjamin H. Perine in 1952, moving to Parkersburg, West Virginia and raising two children; and

WHEREAS, the father of Rachel Smith Perine, Harvey Smith, served in the Civil War from August 1862 to June 1865 as a Private in Co A, 14th West Virginia Infantry; and

WHEREAS, in 1864 while aiding his wounded cousin, Harvey Smith was captured at Cloyds Mountain, Virginia and imprisoned at Andersonville, Georgia for six months and fifteen days; and

WHEREAS, Harvey Smith was paroled in November 1864 and was subsequently hospitalized at Mower US Army Hospital in Chestnut Hill, Pennsylvania for the remainder of his enlistment; and

WHEREAS, Harvey Smith died on May 5, 1929 when Rachel Smith Perine was 13 years old; and


WHEREAS, Rachel Smith Perine is the last known surviving child of a West Virginia Civil War veteran; and


WHEREAS, Rachel Smith Perine will be turning 100 years old on March 8, 2016; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, that the County Commission of Wood County, in commemoration of the 100th birthday of the last known surviving child of a West Virginia Civil War veteran, does hereby PROCLAIM March 8, 2016 as "Rachel Perine Day" in Wood County.

A Doddridge County native turns 100 years old in a few weeks. That alone is noteworthy, but in this case it's even more special, because that Doddridge Countian happens to be the last surviving child of a West Virginia Civil War veteran.

Rachel Smith Perine was born in Doddridge County on March 8, 1916, a daughter of Harvey Smith and Mary Virginia Elliott. Her parents had married the previous year at ages 70 and 25, Harvey being widowed and already the father of twelve children by his first wife. Three more children followed Rachel, who fondly remembers her childhood growing up on Arnolds Creek. Rachel married Benjamin H. Perine, also from Arnolds Creek, and in 1952 they moved to Parkersburg. Benjamin died in 1980. One of their two children is also deceased, the other residing in Florida.

Harvey Smith's Civil War service was from Aug 1862 to Jun 1865, a Private in Co A, 14th W.Va. Infantry, which was comprised mostly of Doddridge Countians. On May 9 1864, while aiding his wounded cousin Thomas J. Fleming, Harvey Smith was captured by the Confederates at Cloyds Mountain, Virginia. He was imprisoned at Andersonville, Georgia for 6 months 20 days until paroled on Nov 25 1864. He was subsequently hospitalized at Mower U.S. Army Hospital in Chestnut Hill (Philadelphia), Pennsylvania, for the remainder of his enlistment.

Rachel, who is still quite mentally sharp, remembers her father talking about his Civil War service, including the foul smell of the creek that ran through Andersonville Prison. She also remembers taking his meals to him during his final illness. She was 13 when he died on May 5 1929. He is buried at Cabin Run Cemetery.

On the occasion of her 100th birthday, there are tentative plans to hold an open house at Rachel's home in Parkersburg, particulars to be announced. Congratulatory letters are expected to be received from Governor Tomlin and the Doddridge County Commission. The Wood County Commission and the Mayor of Parkersburg. But there is also a goal for Rachel to receive at least 100 birthday cards from ordinary citizens, and this where we ask for your help. If you would like to send her a card, address it to:

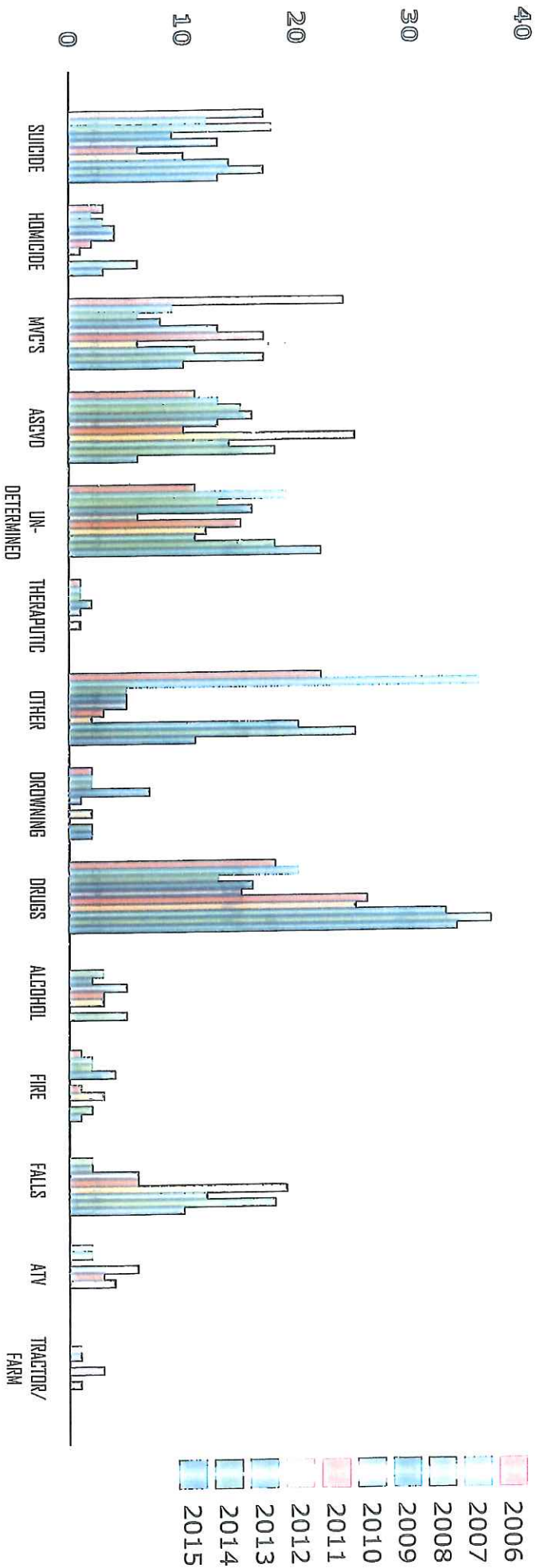
We will personally deliver them to her. She will then see the appreciation that we all have for her, for her father's service, and for her ties to Doddridge County history.
