At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met with Toni Tiano, Gant Cnsultant and Ed Hupp, Emergency Management Director. Ms. Tiano and Mr. Hupp requested approval of an EMPG Grant Application. Said Application is in the amount of \$102,548.00. (Order M/3292)

At 9:35 A.M., Mark Rhodes, County Clerk and Diana Garrett, Deputy Clerk requested approval of the ballot commissioners and emergency ballot commissioners for the upcoming election. Kay Williams and Patty Jo Thompson were appointed Emergency Absentee Voting Commissioners for the Primary Election to be held May 10, 2016. (Order M/3293)

The County Commission approved Doug Ankrom and Jim Leach to serve as Ballot Commissioners for Wood County. (Order M/3294)

At 9:39 A.M., Commissioner Couch stated he invited Doug Hess to attend the Commission meeting as a representative of the Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home. Mr. Hess stated he intended to ask the Commission to provide a bridge loan for a grant they are currently utilizing. He also asked the County Commission to sign a Resolution declaring this week as Drug and Alcohol Facts Week, which they did. A copy of the Resolution is attached to these minutes and shall be made a part thereof.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission discussed the proposed rate increase by the Claywood Park Public Service District. The County Commission authorized the rate increase. Commissioner Tebay then made a motion to waive the forty-five (45) day time frame for the rates to go in effect. The motion died for the lack of a second. (Order A/1588)

PROCLAMATION

Official Proclamation: National Drug & Alcohol Facts Week

The number of drug deaths nationwide, as well as in West Virginia and the local Parkersburg area, has increased significantly, especially heroin use. About 570,000 people die annually due to drug use. Broken down, 85,000 due to alcohol, 20,000 due to illicit (illegal) drugs, and 20,000 due to prescription drug abuse. In 2007, it was reported that the number of national heroin overdose deaths were roughly 2,000. In 2014, that number rose to just over 10,000.

The Mid-Ohio Valley Fellowship Home has been serving the Parkersburg area for 45 years, providing 12 to 18 months for people to live during their recovery. Drug use is most common among young adults who are 18 to 25 years old. Rates of current use of illicit drugs in 2007 were higher for young adults aged 18 to 25 than for youths aged 12 to 17, and adults aged 26 or older. It is estimated that roughly 8% of youth ages 12 – 17 are in need of treatment for drug addiction. The most commonly abused illegal drug is marijuana.

Illicit drug use in the United States has been increasing. In 2013, an estimated 24.6 million Americans aged 12 or older—9.4 percent of the population—had used an illicit drug in the past month. This number is up from 8.3 percent in 2002. The increase mostly reflects a recent rise in use of marijuana, the most commonly used illicit drug.

Therefore, the Wood County Commission joins the MOV Fellowship Home and the National Institute on Drug Abuse in proclaiming January 25th through 30th National Drug & Alcohol Facts Week in Wood County and encouraging people to learn all they can about drugs and alcohol and their abuse which has taken many lives and affected many families in our county, state and nation.

House trailers, either mobile or immobile, located on sites other than a park or court shall be billed in the same manner as any other family or business unit.

TAP FEE

The following charges are to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant.

A tap fee of \$100.00 will be charged to any customer applying for service before construction is completed adjacent to the customer's premises in connection with a capital project. This preconstruction tap fee will be invalid after the completion of construction adjacent to an applicant's premises that is associated with the capital project.

A tap fee of \$400.00 will be charged to all customers who apply for service outside of a capital project for each new tap to the system.

CHARGE FOR RECONNECTION

Whenever the supply of water is turned off for violation of the rules, and regulations, nonpayment of bills, or fraudulent use of water, the District shall make a charge of \$30.00 for reestablishing service.

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above tariff is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

ADMINISTRATIVE FEE

In the event the District collects payment in full of a delinquent water bill at the customer's premises in lieu of a discontinuance of service for nonpayment, an administrative fee of \$25.00 shall also be collected in addition to the delinquent water bill.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the water utility up to a maximum of \$25.00 will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

LEAK ADJUSTMENT RATE

\$ 0.86 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when a bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all consumption above the customer's historical average usage.

If the meter is not found to be more than two percent (2%) in error, the utility shall retain the amount advanced by the customer for the test. The customer or their representative may be present during the testing.
