

Proposal Title: Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) - Camden Clark Medical Center

Brief Project Description: Describe what you plan on accomplishing in this project. Include a connection to THIRA or After-Action Reports. Does this project build on previous projects? Please also include the names of all agencies benefiting from this award.

A Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) is one of the most important pieces of equipment that is needed by a Haz-Mat Team. This apparatus is used when extremely toxic chemicals are present, in an oxygen-deficient atmosphere, or when the contaminant or concentration is unknown, and in emergency situations. SCBAs are used by many different agencies, including hospitals and health care providers, as they provide one of the highest levels of protection. The SCBAs work to protect the human respiratory system which is both the biggest system and the easiest to compromise in a person's body. One quick breath can make the difference between life and death as what a person inhales affects the entire body. Unfortunately, contaminants are not always seen nor is the type always known. Therefore, it is important for those on a Haz-Mat Team to always wear SCBAs whenever there is any kind of environment for which there is unknown or has had unknown contaminants, when there is any oxygen deficient atmosphere, or in emergency situations.

In 1986 Camden Clark established its Haz-Mat Team, and in 1995 the Hospital purchased used SCBA equipment for these first responders. The Hospital has been using this equipment for over 20 years, and like with any equipment that is of this age, it is in constant need of repair. This type of equipment Camden Clark has is no longer in production, and the Hospital can not get this equipment flow tested. It is at the end of its useful life.

The 20 member Camden Clark Haz-Mat Team responds to many different emergency responder situations, and during a given year, it is estimated that there has been as many as 20 emergency situations they have had to respond to. However, it should be stated that even if there was only one call out, it is still important these responders have the proper equipment to perform their job and to save their lives. The Hospital currently works with all surrounding law enforcement agencies (both in West Virginia and southeastern Ohio as well as West Virginia Department of Natural Resources) Emergency Services, and all surrounding chemical plants to conduct emergency Haz-Mat decontamination of employees and members of the community who seek medical treatment at the Hospital. Camden Clark's Team is the only hospital based Haz-Mat decontamination team located in the Parkersburg area.

Unfortunately there are a lot of potential Haz-Mat incidents which could occur within the Parkersburg area. Some of these include chemical releases from the chemical plants, train derailments, radiological releases, and hazardous materials releases. In addition, there could be possibly be an airplane crash, tractor trailer crash, biological attack, or cyber incident which would cause the Haz-Mat Team to have to respond to treat those involved. The possibility of any one of these types of incidents occurring is of major concern to not only the Hospital but the community as well. Hospital personnel will be able to better provide the treatment and decontamination that is needed to anyone who may be affected by one of these incidents if the members of the Hospital's Haz-Mat Team has the proper equipment. Nothing could be more important than making sure this Haz-Mat Team members have their own supply of breathable air.

This project will benefit not only Camden Clark Hospital but also any agency or individual who encounters a Haz-Mat incident. This project has been analyzed using the Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA), and the conclusion is that new SCBA equipment is essential for not only the safety of Camden Clark's Haz-Mat Team members but also the entire service area of Camden Clark Hospital. If these workers are not safe and able to breathe their own breathable air, they will not be able to provide the necessary services and treatment to others.
