At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission met in Special Session as the Board of Canvassers for the purpose of continuing the canvass of the Primary Election held on May 10, 2016.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion duly made, seconded and passed, approved minutes of May 2, 5, 9 and an addendum to March 28, 2016.

Chris Frey took his oath of office as an IT Department Intern.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:31 A.M., the County Commission directed the County Administrator to forward the proposed lease for Westbrook Health Services to the Prosecuting Attorney for review.

At 9:33 A.M., the County Commission signed the annual contract agreement for the Mid-Ohio Valley Health Department. (Order A/1621)

At 9:34 A.M., the County Commission approved the hiring of Amy Leach into the Circuit Clerk's Office.

At 9:37 A.M., the County Commission discussed the proposed fire fee for the Wood County Fire Service. Representatives from the Wood County Fire Board were in attendance. Discussion centered around the charge to churches, charges to seniors and the use of a flat fee. North Hills Mayor, Bill Summers, stated that putting the issue on the ballot as requested by Williamstown Mayor, Jean Ford, is nothing more than a stall tactic. He also stated he felt a lot of the people in the public hearing were uninformed. He further stated that the one individual who stated he was on a fixed income and could not afford the fee, owns a house that is 4,000 square feet. K.D. Linder stated it is difficult for volunteer firemen to commit the time to recruit new members due to them having jobs and are only volunteers. He stated the firemen spend approximately 50% of their time dedicated to fundraising. Terry Hefner stated that this area is fortunate to have a program at WVU-P to train firemen and have them certified upon graduation. Commissioner Couch stated a tour of the different fire departments is something the Commission needs to do. Mr. Hefner stated the Commission has had a year to tour the departments and hasn't done so. Mayor Summers said he understands the concern surrounding the churches but stated some kind of fee needs to be put on them. He said they need to pay something because they need to be protected. Steve Scholl stated churches should not be exempt. Mayor Summers stated that they do have some feeling regarding the churches, but do believe they should pay something. Commissioner Couch made a motion to change the ordinance to reflect a change for homestead exemption and churches.

The 10:15 A.M., the hearing for the Ruby A. Jones Estate was cancelled.

At 10:15 A.M., the County Commission held a hearing in regard to the Jack Dale Bennett estate. Kathy L. Bennett, Administratrix, asked that a claim be disallowed. After review, the County Commission ruled that it be disallowed. Information in regard to this hearing is in the Probate Office. (Probate Order)

RE: Notification of Intent to Pursue a General Water Rate Increase and a Water Extension Project in the Bellville Area to Increase Water Rates and Charges

In accordance with the requirements of W. VA. CODE §§ 16-13A-9 and 24-2-11, please be advised that Lubeck Water Public Service District (the "District") intends to pursue a water system extension project that is not in the ordinary course of business and also an increase to rates in the normal course of business. The project consists of extending service to approximately 200 customers in the Bellville area.

In order to pay the costs associated with increases related to general operation and maintenance, the District intends to pursue an increase in its current rates and charges for water service. The average monthly bill for the various classes of customers will change as follows:


