AMENDED LIMITED EXEMPTION FROM PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES AGREEMENT

This is an Agreement for Limited Exemption from Personal Property Taxes, made and entered into on this the 5th day of August, 2016, by and among WINCORE WINDOW COMPANY, LLC, ("Wincore") a West Virginia limited liability company; the COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, a public body (the "Commission"); RICH SHAFFER, in his official capacity as WOOD COUNTY ASSESSOR ("Assessor"); the Commission, and the Assessor acting on behalf of WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA (the "County").

WHEREAS, Wincore has entered into an Equipment Lease Agreement (the "Lease"), dated August 15, 2016, whereby Wincore will lease from the Wood County Development Authority ("WCDA") certain equipment for its manufacturing facility situate at 250 Staunton Turnpike, Parkersburg, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, WCDA is not required to pay personal property taxes on equipment;

WHEREAS, Wincore has agreed that the Equipment Lease will generate 50 new jobs or their equivalency in Wood County, West Virginia, and the WCDA is willing to enter into the Equipment Lease for the purpose of supporting the growth of Wincore and the creation of jobs in Wood County, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the parties to exempt Wincore from personal property taxes for the five-year lease term and so long as Wincore employees 343 full-time employees in their organization;

WHEREAS, the original Limited Exemption from Personal Property Taxes Agreement was not appropriately signed by the President of the Commission, Stephen Gainer, and the parties have agreed to amend the agreement to correct the signature line.

NOW, THEREFORE, WITNESSETH: That for valuable considerations, the receipt of all of which are hereby acknowledged, it is hereby agreed as follows:

- 1. <u>Property Comprising the Project Exempt from Property Taxes</u>. During the term of the Lease, the freehold interest of WCDA in the personal property, which is the subject of the Equipment Loan, shall not be subject to any personal property taxes, the same being exempt by operation of law.
- 2. <u>Leasehold Interest Assessed and Taxed at Nominal Value</u>. The leasehold interest of Wincore created by the Lease is not freely assignable and therefore has no separate taxable value. Nevertheless, under this Agreement the leasehold shall be subject to assessment and shall be entered accordingly on the property books of the County provided however, that the assessed value of the leasehold shall be at the nominal value of One Dollar (\$1.00) only for such Lease.

3. Exemption from Personal Property Taxes.

A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING IN THIS AGREEMENT TO THE CONTRARY, WINCORE SHALL HAVE NO OBLIGATION TO PAY PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES ON THE EQUIPMENT, SUBJECT TO THE EQUIPMENT LEASE FROM THE WCDA TO WINCORE UNLESS ITS FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES, OR THEIR EQUIVALENTS, NUMBER LESS THAN 343.

B. Failure to Employ 343 Full-Time Employees or Their Equivalent:

- (1) In the event Wincore falls below 343 full-time employees or their equivalent for any year, the WCDA shall request the Assessor to provide a tax assessment for the equipment which shall be charged to Wincore under the terms of the Lease, and upon receipt from Wincore paid to the Sheriff of Wood County by the WCDA
- (2) The amount due in accordance with Section 3.B.(1) above shall be reduced by an amount equal to any tax payable as, determined by the West Virginia State Tax Commissioner, or by the Assessor, with respect to Wincore's leasehold interest in and to the Project or the Lease, without regard to the reason for, or basis of, such determination.
- (3) For purposes of this Section 3, the term "Project" shall be defined to include any expansions thereto, while titled in the name of the WCDA whether or not described or subject to any lease other than the Lease or subject to payment in lieu of personal property taxes under the terms of an agreement other than this Agreement.
- C. Comparable discounts, penalties and interest apply. With respect to the payments to be made hereunder, Wincore shall be entitled to discounts comparable to those available by operation of law for early payment of personal property taxes, including, but not limited to, any available statutory early payment discount. Likewise, Wincore shall be responsible for the payment of any penalties and/or interest comparable to those payable by operation of law for delinquent personal property taxes in connection with any late payment of its obligations hereunder.
- 4. <u>Credit for Payments Made</u>. In the event that any amounts are paid by Wincore as personal property taxes levied by the County on its leasehold interest in the Project, such amount shall be fully credited against and reduce the payments in lieu of taxes otherwise due pursuant to Section 3 herein, likewise Wincore shall be entitled to a refund of the same from the County by virtue of any overpayment thereof resulting from such credit and reduction.
- 5. <u>Term.</u> This Agreement shall continue until such time as Wincore exercises its right to purchase the Project from the WCDA or a period of five (5) years from August 15, 2016, whichever event occurs first.
- 6. <u>Construction</u>. It is the intention of the parties in entering into this Agreement to provide for certainty in the assessment of personal property taxes payable by Wincore, to provide an inducement for Wincore to invest in the Project in the County, to clarify ambiguities as to the appropriate assessment of Wincore's leasehold interest in the personal property to be leased by WCDA to Wincore, and to provide for payments in lieu of taxes to the

Sheriff for educational purposes as an inducement to enter into this Agreement. It is the intention of the parties that this Agreement be construed liberally in order to effect the aforesaid intent of the parties.

- 7. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. Neither this Agreement nor any provision hereof may be amended, modified, waived, discharged or terminated orally, except by an instrument in writing signed by the parties hereto. The provisions of this Agreement shall be binding upon the successors and assigns of each of the parties. The captions in this Agreement are for the convenience of reference only and shall not define or limit the provisions hereof.
- 8. <u>Governing Law.</u> This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of West Virginia.
- 9. <u>Condition to Agreement Becoming Effective</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, this Agreement shall not become effective unless and until title and ownership in and to the Project is transferred to and held by the WCDA. In the event that ownership of the Project is not held by the WCDA, it is expressly acknowledged that this Limited Exemption from Personal Property Taxes Agreement executed by the parties hereto, shall be null and void.
- 10. <u>Severability</u>. The parties hereby agree that in the event one or more portions of this Agreement shall be declared invalid by appropriate authority, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect, provided however, that should the aggregate personal property taxes paid by Wincore to the County, with respect to the Project and the leasehold interest of Wincore in the Lease, in any one year after the tax year 2017, exceed the payments in lieu of taxes provided for in section 3 herein (prior to adjustment as provided in section 4 herein), then, at the election of Wincore, in its sole discretion, this Agreement may be canceled and rendered void and of no further force and effect from and after the date on which such taxes are paid.
- 11. <u>Rights of Wincore to Challenge Assessments</u>. Nothing herein shall be deemed to prohibit Wincore from challenging any assessments made against it by the County before the Commission sitting as a Board of Equalization and Review, or as otherwise provided by law, the rights of Wincore herein being deemed to be cumulative and not in lieu of said rights of appeal and other legal rights.

Said session is pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 7, Section 17 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and is for the purpose of canvassing and ascertaining the results of the General Election held on November 8, 2016.

Those participating in the canvass were Stephen Gainer, David Blair Couch and Robert K. Tebay, Commissioners; Mark Rhodes, Clerk of Wood County; Melody Ross, Denise Shuck, Sandy Day, Martha DeVore and Tom Blondin from the County Clerk's Office; Chris Whittaker, IT Department and Angi Graham, Wood County Commission Office. Observing the canvass was Brett Dunlap, News and Sentinel.

In accordance with Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28 of the West Virginia Code, as amended, Precinct 48, Precinct 61 and Precinct 81 were chosen at random to be counted manually during the Canvass.

At 3:57 P.M., Precinct 81 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count held on election night, November 8, 2016 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said Precinct was counted by Martha DeVore – Republican, Tiffany Smith – Republican, Jane Whittington –

Democrat and Stacy McLaughin – Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by Stephen Gainer, accepted these results.

At 4:43 P.M., Precinct 48 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count held on election night, November 8, 2016 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said Precinct was counted by Shelia Brown – Republican; Lorrie Bond – Republican; Deanna Eaton - Democrat and Jeanie Dotson – Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and passed, accepted these results.

At 4:51 P.M., ½ of Precinct 61 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count held on election night, November 8, 2016 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said half was counted by Denise Schuck – Republican, Sara Morgan – Republican, Andrea Weaver – Democrat and Alberta Hoff – Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and passed, accepted these results.

At 5:35 P.M., the second half of Precinct 61 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count held on election night, November 8, 2016 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said half was counted by Carolyn Kesterson – Republican, Sandy Day – Republican, Helen Reed – Democrat and Cheryl Baxter – Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and passed, accepted these results.

The ballots, tally sheets, and certification of the various voting places were placed before the Board of Canvassers at 5:39 P.M. It appearing to this Board of Canvassers that the challenged

ballots, in the various precincts, were properly made, the challenges either over-ruled or sustained, and other changes in the tabulation of voters were altered, the canvass is complete, as required by law, and the Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and passed, do hereby DECLARE the election results with the Provisionals added in.

At this time, the Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Stephen Gainer and passed, recessed as the Board of Canvassers until Thursday, November 17, 2014 at 9:30 A.M., at which time they will approve the results. Anyone requesting a recount will need to submit a three hundred dollar (\$300.00) bond. If no persons request a recount, after 48 hours, the election results will be considered certified.
