ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO ESTABLISH ROAD MAINTENANCE FOR THE ENTIRETY OF MAPLE DRIVE AND THE NORTHERLY PORTION OF BECKWITH AVENUE

This day came the Petitioners before the Wood County Commission seeking to have the entirety of Maple Drive and the northerly portion of Beckwith Avenue property lot owners to be made subject to the provisions of the road maintenance in accordance with West Virginia Code Chapter 7 Article 12A and upon reviewing the Petition, the Exhibits submitted therewith, and upon hearing the comments or testimony of all parties present at a hearing before the Commission, the County Commission makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law.

- 1. The Petitioners have duly filed their petition and exhibits as required by the West Virginia Code.
- 2. The Wood County Commission duly set a hearing for the 5th day of October, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. and heard comments from numerous persons and decided to continue the hearing on the matter to the 4th day of December 2017 at 10:00 a.m.; at which time it reviewed further exhibits and heard comments.
- 3. Testimony or comments were given that the notice of hearing was duly posted as required by the Code, in two conspicuous places on the road in question.
- 4. Petitioners herein are the homeowners association who is currently doing road maintenance on the street in question and over 60% of the lot owners on the street have joined in the petition. There are 58 total lots on the streets with 44 participating through the homeowners association in road maintenance and 14 not participating. There are 36 owners of lots who have signed the petition.
- 5. The Petitioners have submitted proof of publication as required by the West Virginia Code §7-12A-1 et seq. The Petitioners represent a group in excess of 60% of the owners on the road to be made subject to the provisions of the West Virginia Code. Proof of certified mail notices was submitted by the Petitioners to the fourteen lots not now participating in the road maintenance.

- 7. The Petitioners have a viable and ongoing road maintenance association to adequately maintain the road or streets as recorded in the County Clerk's office in accordance with the West Virginia Code as well as a homeowners association which has previously seen to road maintenance.
- 8. The Petitioners have filed their Petition in good faith and the County Commission deems that it is in the best interest of all parties to the road or streets in question that all owners along the road including the fourteen owners who have not heretofore voluntarily joined be made subject to the provisions of the bylaws of the newly formed Mullenix Sub-division Section Two Road Maintenance Association and this Order.
- 9. The purpose of the West Virginia Code provisions in §7-12A-1 et seq. is to have all persons who use the orphan roads in question be made subject to the maintenance of said road. The Petitioners have met all the requirements of the West Virginia Code for entry of this Order.

Therefore, believing it proper so to do the Wood County Commission does,

ORDER that the fourteen owners named herein and their lots as well as all the other owners which border the streets in question be included in the newly formed Road Maintenance Association and be made subject to the provisions thereof. Henceforth it is further resolved that with the requested Wood County Commission's approval, 44 members of the Homeowners Association shall remain members of the association but should the County Commission so order those 44 members will also become members of the Road Maintenance Association as well as the 14 nonmembers; it being understood that these 14 nonmembers shall only become members of the Road Maintenance Association.

Be it further resolved that these 14 proposed new members are given a hearty welcome into the organizations who will be maintaining the roads.

Be it further resolved that the officers of the association shall be given authority to set up such accounts and books that will permit both associations to jointly maintain the streets including but not limited to having joint accounts for the road maintenance.

Be it further resolved that the association and its officers shall meet and conduct business at the same time and places as the road maintenance association with the election of officers and board members to be conducted at the same time and place.

By-Laws

Mullenix Sub-Division Section Two Road Maintenance Association, Inc.

Article I

Definitions

Section 1. "Association" shall mean and refer to the Mullenix Sub-Division Section Two Road Maintenance Association, Inc. a non-profit association organize and existing under the laws of the State of West Virginia, and specifically governed by the provisions of West Virginia Code, Chapter 7, Article 12A, and is intended to meet the definition of "Maintenance Association" as defined in said Article.

Section 2. "The Properties" shall mean and refer to the following described real estate situate in Union District, Wood County, West Virginia;

Being all of those certain lots or tracts of land owned by the members of the association bordering on the northern portion of Beckwith Avenue and the entirety of Maple Drive which are used in connection with enjoyment of said property, and property not being maintained by any state agency; to include any additional properties which may be added at a future date by merger or agreement to become part of the Association and abide by these By-Laws.

Article II

Location

Section 1. The principle office of the Association shall be located at Wood County, West Virginia, or at such place as shall from time to time be fixed by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Road maintenance for these streets was and before the creation of the association, being conducted by a homeowners association. That homeowners association has joined in the creation of this association to meet the requirements of the West Virginia Code so that all of the owners on the streets in question will be subject to these by-laws. The directors and officers of this association shall be given authority to set up such accounts and books that will permit both associations to maintain streets, including but not limited to, operating joint accounts for road maintenance.

Article III

Membership

Section 1. Every person or entity who is a record owner of property that fronts on either side of the streets as described in Section 2, Article I above, shall be a member of the Association, being 58 lots, more or less.

Article IV

Assessments and Collections of Fees

Section 1. The Association shall have the authority to impose reasonable fees and charges on persons or entities owning lots fronting any street within the property herein described for the purpose of construction or maintenance of improvement and facilities described in Article I hereof. The initial fees imposed by the Association upon the effective date of approval of the Maintenance Association by the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, shall be \$150.00 per year of property owned. The Association shall have the authority to increase or decrease fees and charges in the future with accordance with these By-laws.

Section 2. Any fee initially assessed or increased in accordance with this section, shall not be collectable unless notice of the proposed fee or increase is sent by certified mail in accordance with §7-12A-6 or as this section may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. All fees assessed hereunder are declared to be debts owing to the Association for which the Debtor shall be personally liable. The Association, or an individual designated to act for it, may enforce this liability by appropriate civil action in a Court of competent jurisdiction. After being reduced to a judgment and filed with the Clerk of the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, such liability shall be a lien upon property owned by the association member and any other real property owned by said Association member within Wood County, West Virginia.

Section 4. The Board of Directors of the Association shall at its discretion, require the assessments to be payable on a monthly, quarterly or annual basis.

Article V

Association Purposes and Powers

Section 1. The purpose of the Association is to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the persons and the general public located within the property herein described and shall include the establishment and maintenance of improvement within or upon the property described, including but not limited to those road projects authorized by §7-12A-2 as may be amended from time to time.

Article VI

Voting Rights

Section 1. The Association shall have one class of the voting membership. All owners of property in the subdivision shall be considered members of the Association and each owner will be entitled to one vote per property as provided in §7-12A-4(a)(4).

Article VII

Property Rights and Rights of Enjoyment of Common Property

Section 1. Each member shall be entitled to use and enjoyment of all streets herein designated. Insofar as each member has the power, they hereby dedicate all streets serving the properties as a public way.

Article VIII

Board of Directors

Section 1. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of four (4) Directors who shall serve a term of one year.

Section 2. Vacancies in the board of Directors will be filled by a member of the Association appointed by the Board of Directors.

Article IX

Election if Directors

Section 1. Election of the Board of Directors shall be by written secret ballot as hereinafter provided conducted at the regular annual meeting (Article XIII). At such election, the members or their proxies may cast in respect of each vacancy, as many votes as they are entitled to exercise under the provisions hereof. The name receiving the largest number of votes will be elected.

Section 2. Each member will receive as many ballots as he has votes. Notwithstanding that a member may be entitled to several votes, he shall exercise on any one ballot only one vote for each vacancy shown therein.

Article X

Powers and Duties of the Board of Directors

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall have the power:

- A. To call special meetings of the members whenever it deems necessary and call a meeting at any time upon written request of one third of the Association voting membership.
- B. To appoint and remove at pleasure all officers, agents, and employees of the Association, prescribe their duties, fix their compensation, and require of them a security or fidelity bond as it may be expedient. Nothing contained in these By-Laws shall be construed to prohibit the employment of any member, office or director of the Association in any capacity.
- C. To establish, levy and assess, and collect assessments or charges.
- To adopt and publish rules and regulations governing the use of common properties and facilities.
- E. To exercise for the Association all powers, duties and authority vested in or delegated to this Association or authorized pursuant to the provisions of the West Virginia Code Chapter 7, Article 12A.
- F. In the event that any member of the Board of Directors shall be absent from three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the Board of Directors, the Board may by action taken at the meeting during which said third absence occurs, declare the office of said absent director to be vacant.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Directors:

- A. To cause to be kept a complete record of all its actions and corporate affairs and to present a statement thereof to the members at the annual meeting of the Association members or at any special meeting when such is requested by one third of the Association voting membership.
- B. To supervise all officers, agents and employees of the Association, and see that their duties are properly performed.
- C. To fix the amount of assessment against each property for each assessment period for at least 30 days in advance of such date or period, and, at the same time; prepare a roster of the properties and assessments applicable thereto which shall be kept in the office of the Association and shall be open to inspection by any Association member, and at the same time; to send a written notice of each assessment thereon to every owner subject thereto.
- D. To issue or cause an appropriate officer to issue, upon demand by any person a certificate setting forth whether any assessment has been paid. Such certificate shall be conclusive evidence of any assessment therein stated to have been paid.

Article XI

Officers

- Section 1. The officers shall be President, Secretary and Treasurer. The President shall be a member of the Board of Directors.
 - Section 2. The officers shall be chosen by a majority vote of the Directors.
 - Section 3. All officers shall be elected at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors.

Section 4. The President shall preside over all meetings of the Board of Directors and shall see that the orders and resolution of the Board of Directors are carried out.

Section 5. The Secretary shall be ex officio the secretary of the Board of Directors and shall record the votes and keep the minutes of all proceedings in a book to be kept for that purpose. He/She shall record the votes and keep the records of the Association. He/She shall record in a book kept for that purpose the names of all the members of the association together with their addresses as registered by such members. He/She shall countersign all notes, leases, etc., in the absence of the President, Vice-President or Treasurer.

Section 6. The Treasurer shall receive and deposit in bank accounts all monies of the Association and shall disperse such funds as directed by resolution of the Board of Directors, provided, however, that a resolution of the Board of Directors shall not be necessary for the disbursements made in the ordinary course of business conducted within the limits of the budget adopted by the board.

Section 7. The Treasurer shall keep proper books of account and cause an annual audit of the Association Books to be made if deemed necessary by the Board of Directors, or by 2/3 of the Association members. He/She shall prepare an annual budget and balance sheet and an annual income statement. The annual budget, balance sheet, and income sheet shall be presented to the membership at its regular meeting.

Article XII

Meeting of Members and Directors

Section 1. All meetings of this association shall be at the same time and place as meeting of the homeowners association.

Article XIII

Proxies

Section 1. At all meetings of Association members, each member may vote in person, or by proxy.

Section 2. All proxies shall be in writing and filed with the Secretary. No proxy shall extend beyond the period of eleven months, and every proxy shall automatically cease upon sale by a member of his home or other interest in the property.

Article XIV

Books and Papers

Section 1. The books, records and papers of the Association shall be at all time, during reasonable business hours, be subjected to the inspection of any Association Member.

Article XV

Amendments

Section 1. These By-Laws may be amended, at a regular or special meeting of the Association Membership, and have a 2/3 vote of the members.

Section 2. In case of a conflict between the By-Laws and the Deed restrictions of this subdivision, the Deed Restrictions will control.

Article XVI

General Provisions

Section 1. Duration. The Covenants of these By-Laws shall run with and bind the real property described, and shall be for the benefit of and enforceable by the Association, or the owners of any land subject to this Declaration, their legal representatives, heirs, successors and assigns.

Section 2. Notices. Any notice required to be sent to any member or owner under the provision of the Declaration shall be deemed to have been properly sent postpaid, to the last known address of the person who appear as a member or owner on the records of the Association at the time of such mailing.

Section 3. Enforcement. Enforcement of these covenants shall be by any proceeding at law or in equity against any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any covenant or restrictions, either to restrain violation or to recover damages, and against the land to enforce any lien created by those covenants; and failure by the Association or by any owner to enforce any covenants or restriction herein contained shall in no event be deemed a waiver of the right to do so thereafter.

Section 4. Severability. Invalidation of any one of those covenants by judgment or court order shall in no way affect any other provision which shall remain in full force and effect.




