At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission met John Reed, Wood County Solid Waste Director. Mr. Reed requested they sign a letter to the West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection requesting the County still be allowed to have three countywide tire cleanups. The County Commission executed the letter in support.

At 9:37 A.M., the County Commission met with representatives from the Mid-Ohio Valley Work Camp. They requested funding for their annual even in the summer of 2017. The County Commission agreed to take the request for funds under consideration when they are constructing their budget in March.

At 9:49 A.M., Commissioner Tebay stated he has been meeting with local banks to explore the possibility of refinancing the bonds for the Wood County Justice Center. It was decided to put this item on the next agenda.

At 9:53 A.M., the County Commission discussed a proposal for counties to combine to fund a position at the West Virginia State Police Drug Lab. Russ Skogstad, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, informed the Commissioners that he has been exploring the possibility. No decision was made at this time.

At 10:11 A.M., the County Commission, sitting as the Board of Review and Equalization, met with John Addis to discuss his property located at 319 Woodridge Drive, Mineral Wells.

At 10:30 A.M., the County Commission moved the meeting to the Buckley Conference Room in the Courthouse to meet with the other County elected officials.

At 11:00 A.M., the County Commission opened sealed bids for the upcoming second phase of the Courthouse sidewalk project. The County Commission took the bids under advisement. (Order M/3589-A)

At 11:48 A.M., the County Commission met with David Zide. Mr. Zide updated the Commission on the drug treatment center the company he is employed with is locating in Mountwood Park.





We would like to request your assistance in allowing Wood County to continue the tire collections programs we have been providing to our community over the past several years. In an effort to increase the amount of tires we collect from the public at sanctioned collection events, we have been conducting 3 events each year. The first event is held in the spring in the northern part of the county at Williamstown and cosponsored by the Lions Club. In the summer we hold an event in the middle of the County in Parkersburg and in the fall we hold our last event in the southern part of the county in Belleville, cosponsored by the 4H Club.

These events have played an instrumental part in reducing the amount of tire dumps we clean up along our roadsides each year. We began an extensive program to attack the unlawful tire disposal problem in 2009, and in that year alone we collected over 43,000 tires! We reduced that amount every year since it's inception, but still collect between 6000 – 9000 tires per year. The great majority of these are captured through our collection events, reducing the amount of open tire dumps to around a dozen per year. Wood County is noticeably cleaner because of the efforts and assistance you have provided in the past.

We hope that you will continue the working relationship we have established with you and as always, we look forward to working with you in the future.


