2017 Parkersburg/Wood County HOME Consortium ONE – YEAR ACTION PLAN

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 budget for the Department of Housing and Urban Development has been enacted, thus the proposed Annual Action Plan for the FY2017 program has been prepared and updated to reflect final appropriation amounts.

The City of Parkersburg/Wood County HOME Consortium's One – Year Action Plan establishes the following priorities for HOME funds during the 2017 Program Year (July 1, 2017 – June 30, 2018). The programs listed, will be the investments and specific activities to be undertaken. All funds will benefit Low to Moderate Income Households throughout Wood County.

The HOME Consortium will receive \$242,510 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in HOME Program Funds. Program Income is anticipated to be \$120,000 with a total budget of \$362,510 for housing activities in the FY 2017.
