The County Commission asked this agenda item be tabled until Monday.

At 10:55 A.M., the County Commission approved the hiring of Katlyn Bowman and Ashley Garrett as part time employees in the Assessor's Office.

At 11:02 A.M., Joe Geiger, West Virginia State Archivist and Matt Arrowwood, Director of Circuit Clerk Services with the West Virginia Supreme Court met with the County Commission to discuss the record retention issue with the Circuit Clerk's Office.

At 11:26 A.M., Elizabeth Jones met with the Commission to request a variance for a video lotter located in Mineral Wells. The County Commission authorized a variance for EDJ Operations. (Order A/1766)





On June 15, 2017, the Wood County Commission, in an effort to properly maintain its park shelters and meeting rooms through an ongoing maintenance program, approved a new fee structure for county park shelter and meeting room reservations. - (g) Complete traffic circulation and parking plan; and
- (h) Location of landscaped areas – fences, walls and other screening with respect to premises; and
- (i) Signage plan; and
- (j) Sediment and Erosion Control Plan; and
- (k) Drainage plan for the Premises prepared by a registered professional engineer licensed to practice in the State of West Virginia; and
- (l) Certification of distances from adjacent properties.

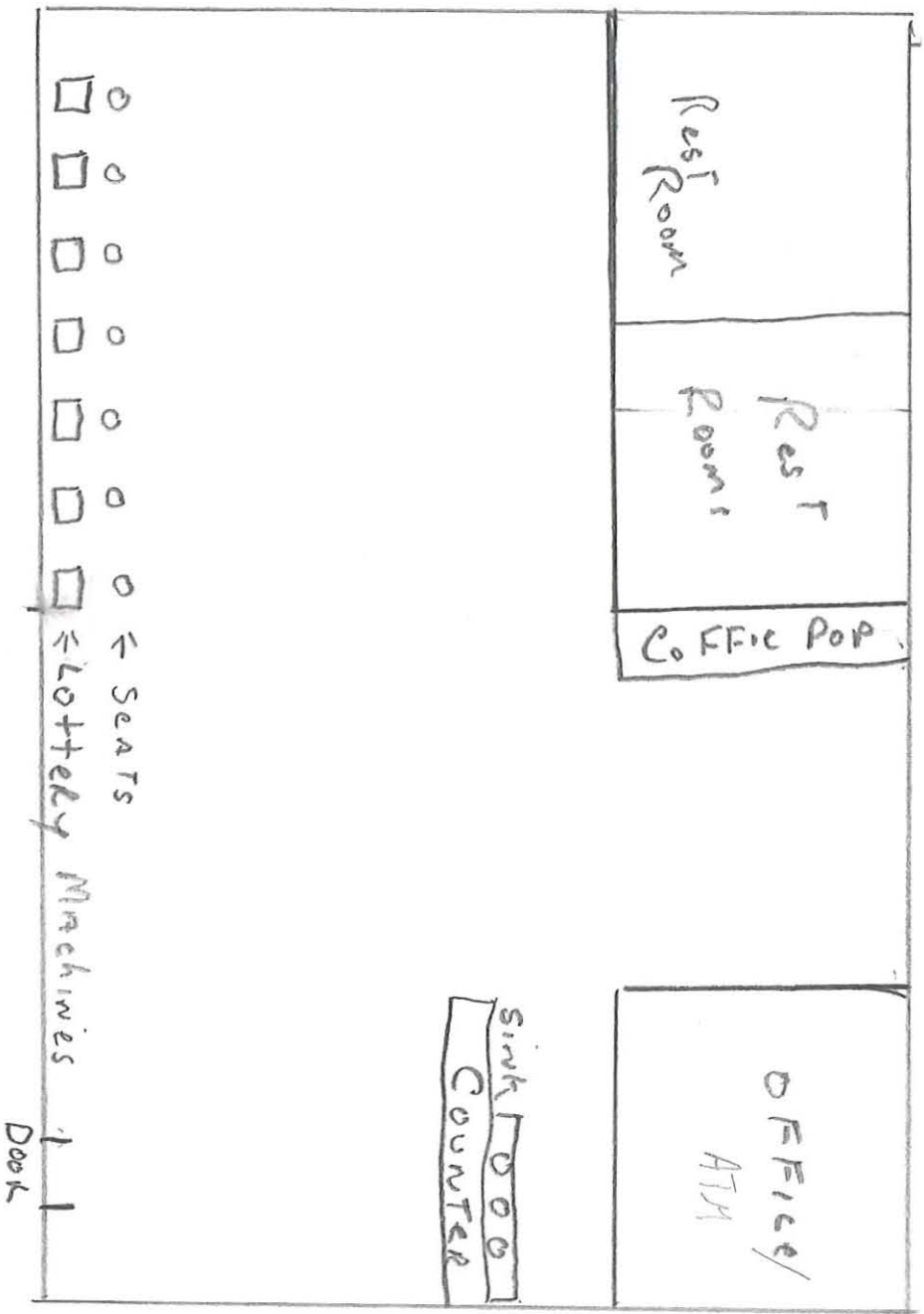

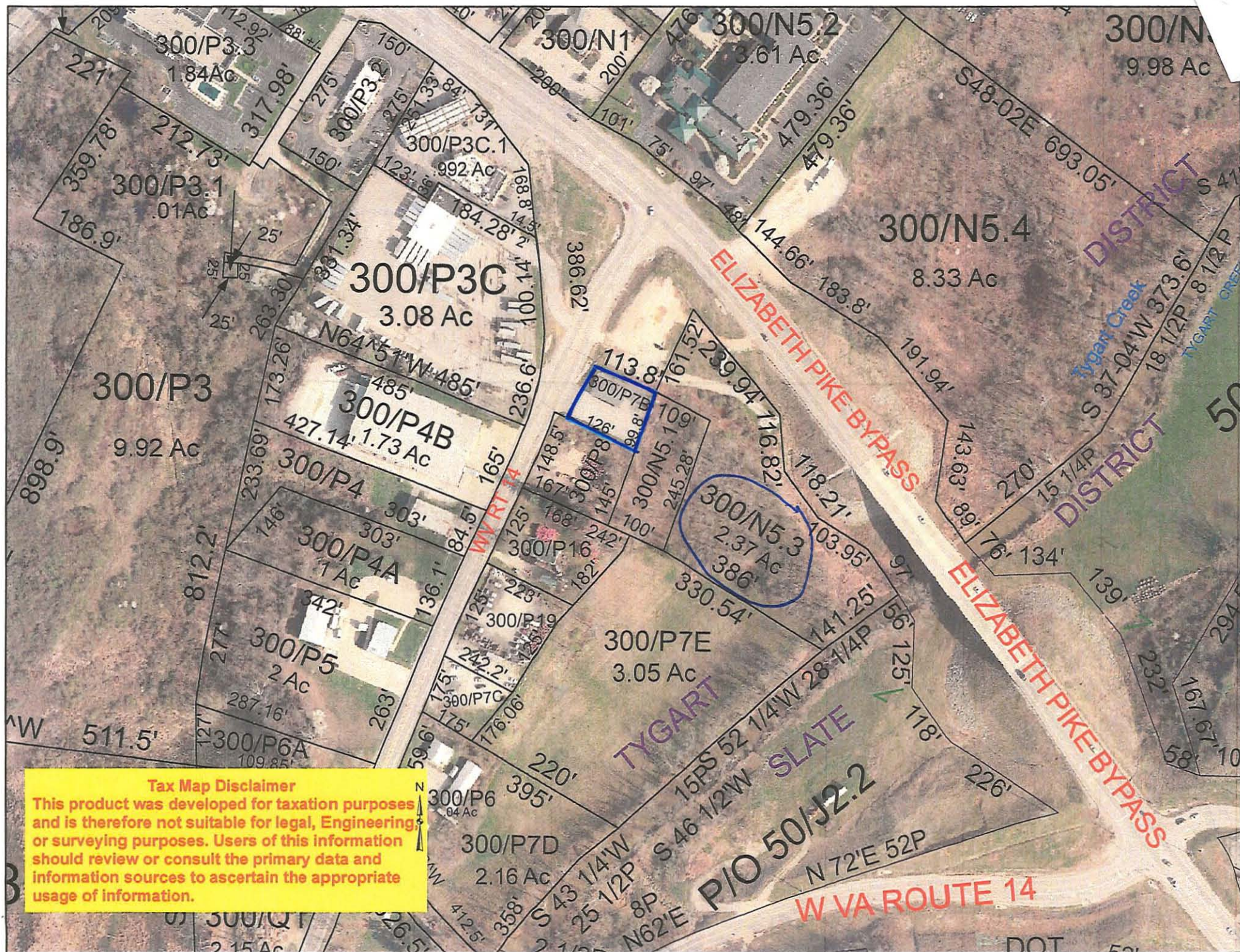
