RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE WOOD COUNTY COMMISSION'S POLICY REGARDING RETIREE PARTICIPATION IN THE WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES INSURANCE AGENCY HEALTH PLAN

WHEREAS, the Wood County Commission ("Commission") desires to make clear to all employees, both active and retired, the existing retiree health plan coverage policies of the Commission with respect to retiree participation in the West Virginia Public Employees' Insurance Agency health plan ("PEIA Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission is not a participating employer in the PEIA Plan for active employees and has not been a participating employer in the PEIA Plan since September 1991; and

WHEREAS, currently, certain former employees of the Commission are participating in the PEIA Plan as retirees ("Current Retirees"); and

WHEREAS, retiree eligibility for participation in the PEIA Plan is governed by West Virginia law and is not determined by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to reaffirm that it has never promised retiree health coverage under any plan to its employees and has never agreed to contribute toward the cost of premiums for retiree health coverage under the PEIA Plan, and the Commission does not intend to so contribute toward the cost of premiums for retiree health coverage under the PEIA Plan now or in the future, unless explicitly provided by law or herein; and

WHEREAS, the Commission's position, in accordance with West Virginia law, is that it is under no obligation, legal or otherwise, to contribute toward the cost of retiree health coverage for those Commission retirees whom PEIA permits to participate in the PEIA Plan, other than those currently active employees and Current Retirees of the Commission who participated in the PEIA Plan while active employees of the Commission for at least five years prior to the Commission's withdrawal from the PEIA Plan in September 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission does not and will not contribute toward the cost of premiums for retiree health coverage under the PEIA Plan unless explicitly required by law or in accordance with the following provisions:

1. With respect to Current Retirees (defined as those who: (i) qualify as retirees as of the date of this Resolution; and (ii) currently are enrolled in coverage under the PEIA Plan as retirees as of the date of this Resolution), the Commission will continue to contribute toward the cost of premiums for health coverage under the PEIA Plan for the Current Retirees, their dependents, or surviving dependents of deceased retirees who have elected coverage prior to the date of this Resolution, for as long as PEIA or West Virginia law determines such retirees to be eligible for coverage under the PEIA Plan.

- 2. With respect to those Current Retirees and currently active employees who participated in the PEIA Plan while an active employee of the Commission for at least five years prior to the Commission's withdrawal from the PEIA Plan in September 1991, the Commission will, in accordance with West Virginia Code Section 5-16-22, continue to contribute toward the cost of coverage for retirees who elect coverage under the PEIA Plan, their dependents, or surviving dependents of deceased retirees who elect coverage, for as long as PEIA or West Virginia law determines such retirees to be eligible for coverage under the PEIA Plan.
- 3. With respect to those currently active employees not subject to the provisions of paragraph 2 above who were hired by the Commission before July 1, 1998, and who have been continuously employed by the Commission since that date of hire and who continue to be employed by the Commission through the date of retirement, the Commission will contribute toward the cost of coverage for such future retirees who elect coverage under the PEIA Plan to the extent PEIA or West Virginia law determines such retirees to be eligible for coverage under the PEIA Plan and as further limited as follows: (a) the Commission will pay its share (as calculated by PEIA) of the cost of self-only coverage under the least expensive coverage option offered by PEIA to the retiree; (b) the Commission will not contribute toward the cost of coverage for dependents of retirees or surviving dependents of deceased retirees; (c) the Commission will no longer contribute toward the cost of retiree coverage once the retiree reaches the age of 65. Individual retirees shall be responsible for the cost of coverage exceeding the contributions made by the Commission as described in this paragraph.
- 4. With respect to those former and currently active employees hired by the Commission on or after July 1, 1998, and who are not subject to paragraphs 1 or 2 above, the Commission will not contribute toward the cost of premiums for retiree health coverage under the PEIA Plan under any circumstances, regardless of whether PEIA permits such persons to participate in the PEIA Plan as retirees.
- 5. The Commission will not contribute toward the cost of premiums for retiree health coverage under the PEIA Plan for any other past, current or future employee not explicitly described in paragraphs 1-3 above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission accepts no responsibility for eligibility determinations or premium calculations for retiree participation in the PEIA Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution serves as a reaffirmation of existing policies and in no way effects a change with respect to employee or retiree health benefits. Nothing in this Resolution should be construed to impact any other health benefits available to retirees of the Commission, if any. Active employees continue to be afforded the privilege of participation in the Commission's health plan as long as they are eligible pursuant to the terms of that plan, as the same may be modified, revised or terminated from time to time by the Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission, in its sole discretion and in compliance with any law applicable to retiree health benefits, reserves the right to modify, revise and/or rescind this Resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective August 1, 2017, and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.
