At 9:00 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in Special Session sitting Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers. Said session is pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 7, Section 17 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and is for the purpose of canvassing and ascertaining the results of the Special Election held on October 7, 2017 being called for by the State of West Virginia for the "Road to Prosperity Amendment of 2017".

Those participating in the canvass were David Blair Couch, Robert K. Tebay and James E. Colombo, Commissioners; Mark Rhodes, Clerk of Wood County; Melody Ross, Tom Blondin, Brenda Blondin, Denise Schuck, Penny Givens and Diana Garrett for the County Clerk's Office.

Precincts 13, 57A and 62 were chosen at random to be counted manually during the Canvass. The precincts were found to be error free with the tabulation on Election Day and meets all requirements as required by the West Virginia code. The Joint Board of Canvassers do hereby CERTIFY that the hand count of the Special Election meets the requirements of less than one percent (1%) difference permitted by West Virginia Code. The hand count was completed by Tom Blondin (D), Denise Schuck (R), Brenda Blondin (D), and Penny Givens (R).

The Board of Canvassers received nineteen (19) absentee ballot postmarked prior to Election Day and ruled that it be added to Election Day totals.

The Board of Canvassers reviewed forty-four (42) Challenged ballot and overruled thirty-eight (38) and sustained four (4). Total ballot added to Election Day totals were sixty-one (61).


At 10:33 A.M., the Board of Canvassers ORDERED the results be DECLARED and started the forty-eight hour time frame for anyone wishing a recount and requiring a three-hundred (\$300.00) bond be posted for a recount request.

The Board of Canvassers ORDERED if no recount request is received, the results become Official upon the date and time set by the Secretary of State after the last County DECLARED. The Clerk of Wood County is to forward Certifications to the Secretary of State.

The Board of Canvassers adjourned at 10:33AM. (Order A/1846)


