

TELECOMMUNICATIONS EASEMENT

- PARTIES. This Easement entered into this 20+10 day of August, 2018, is by and between THE CHEMOURS COMPANY FC, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, with an address of 1007 Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19899 ("CHEMOURS"), and THE COUNTY OF WOOD, WEST VIRGINIA with an address of 1 County Square, Parkersburg, West Virginia 26101 ("GRANTEE").
- 2. EASEMENT AREA. CHEMOURS does hereby convey unto GRANTEE, upon the covenants, terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, that certain portion of CHEMOURS' property being 100 by 100 feet with .23 Acres (the "Easement Area") situated in Wood County, State of West Virginia, being part of CHEMOURS's Washington Works site (hereinafter "Site"), as said parcel or tract of land is more particularly shown and described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, and more fully described in that certain drawing entitled "Proposed Antenna Installation" attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B". In no event, shall the height of Grantee's equipment and improvements exceed Three Hundred Forty feet (340') in total height. The parcel or tract is more particularly shown and described as the Dry Run Landfill property in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" and herein collectively described as the "Easement Area". Said conveyance of the Easement Area shall be subject to all matters or record and any state of facts that an accurate ALTA survey or inspection of the Easement Area would disclose.

EASEMENTS AND RESERVED RIGHTS.

- (a) CHEMOURS does hereby grant to GRANTEE those certain non exclusive Easements within the Site of which the Easement Area is a part of for purposes of ingress and egress along existing Site roads as reasonably designated by CHEMOURS, and for connection to public utilities, along those roads and right of ways being more particularly shown and described in Exhibit "C".
- (b) CHEMOURS reserves the right to enter upon all or any portion of the Easement Area to perform its obligations under this Easement and/or to perform or cause to be performed any and all activities that CHEMOURS shall be required to pursue or complete

pursuant to any voluntary action or order or requirement of any governmental authority having jurisdiction over any environmental contamination or condition at or on the Easement Area. In exercising such right, CHEMOURS shall to the extent reasonably practicable avoid any material interference or disturbance of GRANTEE's operation on the Easement Area.

 TERM. This Easement term of this Easement shall be perpetual and shall run with the land.

TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS.

- (a) GRANTEE shall reimburse CHEMOURS as additional rent those costs for all real estate taxes and any and all assessments, including special assessments, and any tax that may be levied, assessed or imposed by the State of West Virginia or by any political or taxing subdivision thereof, upon any of the improvements constructed by GRANTEE on the site or measured by the rents hereunder or the income arising therefrom in lieu of or as a substitute, in whole or in part, for any property tax upon the Easement Area.
- (b) GRANTEE shall furnish to CHEMOURS, within forty-five (45) days after the date when any tax, special assessment or other imposition is payable, or forty five (45) days after any such request from Chemours, copies of the official receipts, or other reasonable proof satisfactory to CHEMOURS evidencing payment thereof.

USE/CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS.

(a) GRANTEE shall use the Easement Area solely for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating a telecommunications facility for the Wood County emergency response teams of fire, police and emergence medical services. The telecommunications facility shall consist of one tower structure which shall not exceed Three Hundred Forty feet (340°) in total height as measured from the surface of the ground, and such height restriction includes all antenna support structures, cabinets, meter boards, buildings, antennas, cables, equipment and uses incidental thereto, as shown on Exhibit "B", for GRANTEE's use. All such uses (i) shall comply with all applicable laws, governmental statutes, rules, orders, ordinances or regulations applieable thereto; (ii) shall not in any manner violate any certificate of occupancy affecting the same; or (iii) which would constitute a public or private nuisance or waste. No changes, additions, or alterations to the telecommunications facilities shall be made without the prior written approval of CHEMOURS, and such consent can be

denied if such changes will result in a visual nuisance. GRANTEE agrees that the said improvements will be installed, operated, and maintained in accordance with the law and with the regulations and requirements of any and all governmental authorities, agencies, or departments, having jurisdiction thereof, without cost or expense to CHEMOURS. GRANTEE and its contractors shall not a lay down area beyond the Easement Area, barricade, block or obstruct access to the roadways or parking areas without prior written approval of CHEMOURS. GRANTEE shall also insure that any improvements constructed hereunder shall not materially interfere with CHEMOURS's use and enjoyment of the Site.

- CONSIDERATION. GRANTEE shall pay CHEMOURS the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for the grant of this Easement.
- 8. <u>LIENS</u>. If, at any time during the term of this Easement, any liens or claims of mechanics, laborers, or materialmen shall be filed against the Easement Area, or any part or parts thereof, for any work, labor, or materials furnished pursuant to the written agreement by GRANTEE, GRANTEE, within thirty (30) days after the date GRANTEE receives notice of the filing or recording of any such lien from CHEMOURS or any other party, or the filing or recording of any notice of intention to file a lien or claim of lien, shall cause the same to be discharged by payment, bond, or otherwise.
- 9. <u>CONDITION OF EASEMENT AREA</u>. CHEMOURS represents that the land of which the Easement Area form a part has been used by CHEMOURS for a non-hazardous landfill from a period of 1986 through 2006, and is part of a greater Site which has been used for the manufacture of various chemicals and residual contamination associated with the said manufacturing operations which may be present in the soils and groundwater at the Easement Area. GRANTEE takes the Easement Area in an "AS IS" condition.
- FENCING. At the option of CHEMOURS, GRANTEE, at its sole cost and expense shall install and maintain chain link fencing around the perimeter of the Easement Area in accordance with commercially reasonable specifications supplied by CHEMOURS.
- 11. <u>RELOCATION</u>. CHEMOURS shall have the right, exercisable at any time and from time to time, in the event it has need of the Easement Area or the Easement areas described in said Exhibit "A", to require GRANTEE to relocate the Easement Area, or any part thereof, to another suitable location or locations, provided CHEMOURS notifies GRANTEE thereof in

writing and in said writing designates the substituted location or locations, and thereupon GRANTEE shall, at CHEMOURS's expense, relocate the Easement Area, or any part thereof, to such substituted location or locations within One Hundred Eighty (180) days after the receipt of said notice. Upon any such relocation, the description herein contained shall be deemed amended so as to describe accurately the substituted location.

- 12. INDEMNIFICATION. In addition to the indemnity for hazardous materials contained in paragraph 13 herein, GRANTEE shall use and occupy the Easement Area at its own risk and shall indemnify and hold CHEMOURS safe and harmless from and against any and all loss, costs, damages, claims, actions or liability on account of the death of injury to any person or persons or the damage to or destruction of any property arising from or growing out of GRANTEE's use and occupancy of the Easement Area, unless such loss, costs, damages, claims, actions or liability is caused by the sole negligence of CHEMOURS.
- allowed on the Easement Area except for UPS battery system or small quantities of general cleaning supplies. Any use, production, storage, deposit or disposal of hazardous substances by GRANTEE on any portion of the Easement Area shall be performed or accomplished in accordance with all environmental laws, governmental statutes, rules, orders, ordinances or regulations applicable thereto. Unless otherwise agreed to by CHEMOURS, upon the expiration or earlier termination of this Easement (i) all such hazardous substances used, produced, stored, deposited or disposed of on-site by GRANTEE shall be promptly removed from the Easement Area and (ii) the Easement Area shall promptly be remediated to the condition in which they were provided to CHEMOURS hereunder at the commencement of the Easement.
- 14. REQUIREMENTS OF PUBLIC AUTHORITY. GRANTEE, at its expense, shall comply with all laws, rules, orders, ordinances, directions, regulations and requirements of federal, state, county and municipal authorities pertaining to GRANTEE's use of the Easement Area and all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations or ordinances pertaining to air and water quality, hazardous materials, waste disposal, air emissions and other environmental matters with respect to the use and occupancy of the Easement Area.

INSURANCE.

- (a) GRANTEE shall provide at its expense and keep in force during the term of this Easement, commercial general liability insurance (including premises operation, bodily injury, personal injury, death, independent contractors, broad form property damage coverage) and naming CHEMOURS as an additional insured, in a combined single limit amount of not less than Three Million and 00/100 (\$3,000,000) Dollars, in a good and solvent insurance company or companies licensed to do business in the State of West Virginia, covering all of its liabilities hereunder. Copies of such insurance policies shall be delivered to CHEMOURS evidencing compliance with this paragraph. Said policies are to provide for at least ten (10) days' prior written notice to CHEMOURS by the insurer of any termination or modification thereof.
- (b) All insurance policies carried by GRANTEE covering the Easement Area, including, but not limited to, contents, fire and casualty insurance, shall expressly waive any right on the part of the insurer against CHEMOURS. GRANTEE agrees that its policy will include such waiver clause or endorsement, and hereby waives any claims against DUPONT for perils to be insured against by such insurance policies.
- 14. <u>CONDEMNATION</u>. If the whole or any part of Easement Area shall be taken by a public authority under the power of eminent domain or any similar authority of law, or conveyed in lieu thereof, GRANTEE at its option may either terminate this Easement or continue in possession of any portion of the Easement Area remaining untaken under the terms and conditions of this Easement. GRANTEE shall have the right to seek from the condemning authority an award for any improvements so taken, but shall not have a right to an award for the real property or for the value of the Easement Area.
- 15. <u>ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING</u>. This Easement and or any rights to the tower shall not be assigned nor shall any portion of the Easement Area be sublet. The use of this Easement is only being granted for emergency services as contained in paragraph 6 herein.
- 16. NOTICES. All notices and other communications hereunder shall be in writing and shall become effective, if sent by first class certified or registered mail with postage prepaid and return receipt requested, three (3) days after deposit in the mails, or sent by nationally recognized overnight courier service when received (whichever is earlier), and shall be directed to the addressee at the address stated opposite its name below, or at the most recent address specified by written notice given to the other party in the manner provided in this paragraph:

To GRANTEE

- 17. SURRENDER. If GRANTEE ceases using this Easement for a period of ninety (90) days, then this Easement shall terminate, and GRANTEE agrees to deliver up Easement Area to CHEMOURS in good order and condition. Any improvements constructed by GRANTEE on the Easement Area shall be removed by GRANTEE within One Hundred Twenty (120) days following the termination of this Easement. If GRANTEE fails to so remove, CHEMOURS shall have the right to remove the same at GRANTEE's expense.
- GOVERNING LAW. This Easement and the performance thereof shall be governed, interpreted, construed and regulated by the laws of the State of West Virginia.





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into this 20 day of August, 2018, by and between the City of Parkersburg, hereinafter referred to as the City and the County Commission of Wood, hereinafter referred to as the County, both of Wood County, State of West Virginia, witnessed:

WHEREAS, this MOU is made under the authority of Chapter 7-1-3 and Chapter 8-1-7 of the West Virginia State Code; and

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this MOU is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this MOU; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to provide the County \$12,119 from the JAG award for the Wood County Sheriff's Department and the CITY will receive \$21,454 from the JAG award for the Parkersburg Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City and County believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

Section 1.

City agrees to pay County a total of \$12,119 of JAG funds.

Section 2.

County agrees to use \$12,119 for the Wood County Sherriff Department by September 30, 2020. Sheriff's Department will purchase items listed in its application submitted to the Bureau of Justice Assistance.

Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against County other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the West Virginia Tort Claims Act.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program assists local governments to enhance law enforcement capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the JAG Program helps to fund a variety of efforts to ensure that local communities have the tools and equipment necessary to build safer communities; and


