At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

The County Commission, upon a motion made by James E. Colombo, seconded by Robert K. Tebay and made unanimous by David Blair Couch, approved minutes of October 14 and 18, 2021.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., representatives from Union Williams Public Service District met with the County Commission to request funding for a water loss project through the County's American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds. The Commission asked them to send a letter of request to them so they can forward it to their attorneys to see if the expense fits within the guidelines in the ARP funds.

At 9:45 A.M., Wood County Sheriff Steve Stephens met with the County Commission to discuss a personnel issue in his department. The Sheriff read a prepared statement he had. Commissioner Couch stated the Commission has an ethical duty to interview employees in the Sheriff's Department to discover if there is any validity behind the complaints. Commissioner

Couch stated the Commission has interviewed law firms to see if they would be interested in working with the County Commission on this issue.

At 10:00 A.M., the County Commission discussed the possible hiring of an outside legal firm to pursue a possible WV Code 6-6-7 hearing to possibly remove the Sheriff from office. The County Commission, upon motion of Robert K. Tebay, seconded by James E. Colombo, and made unanimous by David Blair Couch, upon prior adjournment of the regular session, convened in EXECUTIVE SESSION upon authority granted by the West Virginia Code, Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section 4, as amended: WHEREUPON, David Blair Couch, President of the Commission, Robert K. Tebay and James E. Colombo, met with Marty Seuffer, Wood County Administrator. All those present proceeded to discuss the matter for which the said EXECUTIVE SESSION was had, regarding investment of public funds. The Commission having concluded said discussion, the said EXECUTIVE SESSION adjourned at 10:10 o'clock A.M. (Order M/4337)

At 10:10 A.M., the County Commission, upon a motion made by James E. Colombo, seconded by Robert K. Tebay, and made unanimous by David Blair Couch, did hereby AUTHORIZE the hiring of the law firm of Goodwin & Goodwin, LLP, 300 Summers Street, Suite 1500, Charleston, West Virginia.
