At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in regular session. They signed purchase orders, invoices and other correspondence.

AGENDA AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

At 9:30 A.M., the County Commission of Wood County met in session, sitting Ex-Officio as a Board of Canvassers. Said session is pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 7, Section 17 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and is for the purpose of canvassing and ascertaining the results of the General Election held on November 8, 2022. Those participating in the canvass were Robert K. Tebay, David Blair Couch and James E. Colombo, Commissioners; Mark Rhodes, Clerk of Wood County; Alicia Cross and Barbara Johnston from the County Clerk's Office; Pat Lefebure, Prosecuting Attorney; Chris Whittaker, IT Department and Angi Graham, Wood County Commission Office. Observing the canvass was Brett Dunlap, News and Sentinel; Mitch Blahut, from WTAP; Joe Gonzales, County Clerk Elect. In accordance with Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28 of the West Virginia Code, as amended, Precinct 10, 33 and 81 were chosen at random to be counted manually during the Canvass.

At 9:35 A.M., the County Commission met with Ken Long and Kevin Lyons from WTAP Television to discuss the electrical upgrades required for a transformer located on the site of the Wood County Resiliency Center that is currently under construction. The County Commission served them notice that they are terminating a lease for a right-of-way easement which will require WTAP to relocate their electrical connection. Both parties agreed to continue the discussion on Thursday, November 17, 2022 at 10:20 A.M. with representatives from Mon Power and ZMM Architects being invited to attend. (Order C/134)

At 11:16 P.M., Precinct 33 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count, held on election night, November 8, 2022 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said Precinct was counted by Norma Chaney – Republican, Shelia Brown – Republican, Brenda Blondin – No Party Affiliation and Darlene Cook-Thorn - Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by David Blair Couch, seconded by Robert K. Tebay, and made unanimous by James E. Colombo, accepted these results. At 12:33 P.M., Precinct 10 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count, held on election night, November 8, 2022 and meets all requirements as required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said Precinct was counted by Lewis Rexroad – Republican, Lindsay Coffey– Republican, Deanna West – Democrat and Donna Bowman – No Party Affiliation. The County Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, accepted these results. At 1:48 P.M., Precinct 81 was found to be free from error within the one percent (1%) difference of the tabulation count, held on election night, November 8, 2022 and meets all requirements as

required by West Virginia Code, Chapter 3, Article 4A, Section 28. Said Precinct was counted by Betty Carpenter – Republican, Carolyn Kesterson – Republican, Helen Reed – Democrat and Jane Whittington - Democrat. The County Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, accepted these results. The ballots, tally sheets, and certification of the various voting places were placed before the Board of Canvassers at 1:55 P.M. It appearing to this Board of Canvassers that the challenged ballots, in the various precincts, were properly made, the challenges either over-ruled or sustained, and other changes in the tabulation of voters were altered, the canvass is complete, as required by law, and the Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, do hereby DECLARE the election results with the Provisionals added in. At this time, the Commission, upon a motion made by Robert K. Tebay, seconded by James E. Colombo and passed, recessed as the Board of Canvassers until Monday, November 21, 2022 at 9:30 A.M., at which time they will Certify the results. Anyone requesting a recount will need to submit a three hundred dollar (\$300.00) bond. If no persons request a recount, after 48 hours, the election results will be considered certified. (Order A/first and final day canvass General 2022)


Having no further scheduled appointments or business to attend to, the County Commission adjourned at 1:55 P.M.







RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

The undersigned, COUNTY COMMISSION OF WOOD COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, hereinafter referred to as "Grantor", in consideration of \$1.00, and other good and valuable considerations paid by GRAY TELEVISION GROUP, INC., hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants and conveys to Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement with the right to erect, construct, install and lay and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace and remove an underground electrical cable which will extend from an Allegheny Power Company transformer over property owned by Grantor to property owned by Grantee. The property over which this easement extends is located in the City of Parkersburg, Wood County, West Virginia, and is shown on the City of Parkersburg Tax Map 95, Parcel 12.

The easement hereby granted shall be ten feet in width and the location of same is more particularly shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

This easement is conveyed with the right of ingress and egress over Grantor's adjacent land for the purposes for which the above mentioned rights are granted.

This easement is over and through a parking lot. After construction, the Grantee shall return the parking lot to its original condition. In the event that Grantor decides to construct a building upon the subject property, or otherwise decides to utilize the subject property for any legitimate public purpose, the Grantor may terminate this lease upon giving Grantee sixty days' notice thereof, in writing. Upon receipt of said notice to terminate this right of way easement, Grantee shall cause to be abandoned and/or relocated, at its sole expense, any underground electrical cable beneath Grantor's property, which abandonment and/or relocation shall occur and be completed prior to the date the Grantor begins construction upon the subject property or otherwise begins utilizing it for said public purpose.
