A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION BY HINO MOTORS MANUFACTURING, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$280,000 (\$200,000 IN UNMATCHED FUNDS AND \$80,000 IN MATCHED FUNDS WITH \$40,000 COMING FROM HINO MOTORS MANUFACTURING AND \$40,000 COMING FROM DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS) IN INDUSTRIAL ACCESS ROAD FUNDING THROUGH THE WEST VIRGINIA DEVELOPMENT OFFICE AND THE WEST VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Wood County Commission (the Commission) accepts the ultimate responsibility for economic development activities in Wood County, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is aware of the need to support Hino Motors Manufacturing to install a stoplight as an Industrial Access Road project in Wood County, West Virginia; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission does hereby support the development and submission of an Industrial Access Road (IAR) grant application in an amount not to exceed \$280,000 through the West Virginia Development Office and the West Virginia Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the funding, if awarded, be used to assist in the construction of a stoplight at the entrance road into the new plant.


