Segment I: Happy Valley Connector

Connecting the North Bend Rail Trail (NBRT) into Parkersburg proper has been a priority for many local and state officials.

Previous routing relied on negotiations with CSX as the trail followed existing railbed, some of which is still in use further north. Balancing this relationship while leaving adequate room for trail users to feel safe alongside Rt.47 has proven difficult.

This proposed solution utilizes a bridge construction across the Little Kanawha River, connecting it directly into south side Parkersburg. This is nearby to the Erickson All-Sports Facility, many residential communities, and a high-traffic interstate bus stop.

Additionally, future expansion west along a powerline clearing would connect these resources with Pike St. commercial & schools.

Dean Scott Fields / Recreation With cooperation from a diverse network of property owners, city representatives, and county officials, connecting into downtown Parkersburg would only require an expansion of existing shoulders.

Camden Ave. could benefit from lighting and pedestrian improvements while acting as the segway from our proposed bridge to the pre-existing Little Kanawha Connector. This route is adjacent to many economic forces in the area, driving business while alleviating traffic on the roads. A dedicated divider or sufficiently wide shoulder encourages family and low-confidence riders to utilize the path where today they rely almost exclusively on motor vehicles.

Alternatively or additionally, the route could expand to the Juliana St. bridge and connect more directly into downtown Parkersburg. This requires more construction but avoids high-traffic areas.



Wal-Mart in Vienna The third phase of the Parkersburg-Ohio River Trail (PORT) is all that's needed to finalize our dedicated path into Vienna. This would represent a massive reconnection of Wood County communities split by the high-traffic Murdoch Ave. Employees and shoppers alike would be able to walk or bike alongside the peace of the Ohio River.

Current plans rely on a bridge adjacent to the railway, eventually routing into a culvert and finally onto the Grand Central Mall parking lot. While additional considerations may be necessary regarding rider dismount, irrigation, and rail security, the difficult work of PORT Phase II was recently completed; residents are eager to maintain momentum and get to the mall!

Alternatively, a direct route following the same proposed bridge runs parallel with the rail and crosses via an existing intersection north.



Map Overview

This project requires a great deal of additional information, outreach, and study to move forward.

Any individual segment would objectively improve community outcomes, but as a unit they represent a transformation of transportation in Wood County.

A continued investment in these projects opens the door to further expansion into Williamstown, Mineral Wells, and even out of state such as with the Athens-Belpre Rail Trial.

ORDER FROM HEARING HELD ON AUGUST 15, 2024

ON THIS 15th day of August, 2024, came the Petitioner, TONDA M. COTTRILL, in person and by counsel, William B. Summers, before the County Commission of Wood County, West Virginia, upon the Petitioner's Motion to Admit the Last Will and Testament of TIMOTHY M. ANTHONY to probate. Upon consideration of the arguments presented by counsel and the testimony of the parties, the Court does FIND and ORDER as follows:

- 1. That the Will of TIMOTHY M. ANTHONY, dated June 3, 2013, contains errors in page numbering and lacks other formalities required for probate admission.
- 2. That the County Commission FINDS there is a potential heir to the Estate, being the son of the decedent, currently imprisoned in North Carolina for homicide. The status of this individual as a legal heir is unclear due to information indicating he may have been adopted by another individual, but there is no clear evidence to the contrary.
- 3. For the reasons stated above in paragraph's 1 and 2, at this time, the County Commission DENIES the hereinbefore filed MOTION TO ADMIT WILL TO PROBATE and will DENY admission of the Will to probate due to the errors and formal deficiencies.
- 4. That the Petitioner, TONDA M. COTTRILL, is GRANTED leave to present additional evidence to address the issues with the Will, particularly regarding the potential heir's adoption status or any other relevant evidence, including any waivers or evidence that would justify the admission of the Will to probate.




