MINUTES OF A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF THE MINERAL WELLS PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT HELD ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 16, 1999, IN THE DISTRICT'S OFFICE LOCATED AT MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

Charles Stewart, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. Mr. Stewart; Roy L. Radabaugh, Treasurer; James R. Lett, Secretary; Jerald D. Spears, Operations Manager; Margaret Batten, Office Manager; Linda Church, Office Technician; Jim Mayles, P.E., Cerrone & Associates, Inc.; and Dominick Cerrone, Cerrone & Associates, Inc.; were in attendance.

Mr. Lett made a motion that the minutes of the November 18, 1999, regular Board Meeting be approved as written. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mrs. Batten presented Requisition No. 3 in the amount of \$311,321.72 for the Water System Improvement Project to be reviewed and approved for payment. Following a brief discussion, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Requisition No. 3 for the Water System Improvement Project be approved for payment as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mrs. Batten presented Requisition No. 3 in the amount of \$175,197.36 for the Rockport Water Line Construction Account to be reviewed and approved for payment. Following a brief discussion, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Requisition No. 3 for the Rockport Water Line Construction Project be approved for payment as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Spears told the Board of Commissioners that Dianne Wolfe, Legal Assistant, Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love, has completed the title search and prepared the deed and all other necessary documents for the purchase of the property on Route 21 from Cutlip-Warner Partnership for the District's new office building. He said that the closing on the property was scheduled for Friday, December 17, 1999, at 2 p.m. in the offices of Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love.

Mrs. Batten said that she and Mr. Spears both spoke by telephone with Gary Wilson, Utility Specialist, Rural Utilities Service, about purchasing the Cutlip-Warner property. She said that he told both of them that the District did not need written approval from Rural Utilities Service to spend the money from the bank account that was set up with the funds received from the State of West Virginia for the sale of the present office location. She said that he told them to proceed with the purchase of the property so the project can move forward and that he would take care of clearing the property purchase with the Rural Utilities Service Office in Morgantown.

Following Mrs. Batten's statement, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that check no. 101 in the amount of \$75,000.00 payable to Cutlip-Warner Partnership from the Mineral Wells Public Service District's Office Building Prime Rate Account be approved for the purchase of the property on Route 21 for the relocation of the District's Office Facilities. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the following items be approved as presented:

- 1) Financial Statement dated November 30, 1999, for All Finances of the District. (copy attached)
- 2) Financial Statement dated November 30, 1999, for the Water Revenue Fund Checking Account. (copy attached)
- 3) Financial Statement dated November 30, 1999, for the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account. (copy attached)
- 4) Financial Statement dated November 30, 1999, for the Water Improvement Construction Account. (copy attached)
- 5) Financial Statement dated November 30, 1999, for the Rockport Water Line Construction Account (copy attached)
- 6) List of checks numbered 24795 through 24832 written on the Water Revenue Fund Checking Account between November 19, 1999, and December 15, 1999. (copy attached)
- 7) List of checks numbered 24833 thru 24848 written on the Water Revenue Fund Checking Account on December 16, 1999. (Copy attached)
- 8) List of checks numbered 26739 through 26778 and a list of payroll checks numbered 348 through 362 written on the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account between November 19, 1999, and December 15, 1999 (copy attached).
- 9) List of checks numbered 26779 through 26804 written on the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account on November 18, 1999. (Copy attached)

Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mrs. Batten reviewed the list of correspondence received and mailed by the District Office between November 19, 1999, and December 16, 1999, with the Board of Commissioners (copy of list attached). Letters numbered 38, 44, 56, and 64 were discussed.

In her Office Manager's Report, Mrs. Batten told the Board of Commissioners that they needed to transfer some money from both the Reserve for Repair/Replacement Fund Savings Account at WesBanco Bank and the Repair and Replacement Fund-Prime Rate Account at WesBanco Bank. She recommended that the Repair/Replacement Fund Savings Account at WesBanco Bank be closed since it only has a balance of \$4,181.99 and that at least \$12,000.00 be transferred from the Repair and Replacement Fund-Prime Rate Account at WesBanco Bank which has a balance of \$17,006.93. She stated that these transfers need to be made before the District's monthly bills for the sewer department can be paid.

Following a brief discussion, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District clear both accounts and transfer the balances to the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account at WesBanco. Mr. Lett

seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Radabaugh asked Mrs. Batten if the Repair and Replacement Savings Account at WesBanco was a prime-rate account. She told him that it was not, and he asked her to transfer the entire balance of \$94,283.76 to a prime rate account.

Mr. Spears reported that the District's Water System Improvement Project and the Rockport Water Line Extension Project are both behind schedule and are only five percent and eleven percent complete respectively with nearly fifty percent of the time elapsed. He said that J. C. Bosley Construction Inc.'s crews have been working on Wolfe Run Road and Price Road with neither area being completed. He said that they are moving very slowly.

Mr. Spears also stated that Mid-Atlantic Storage Systems, Inc. are over fifty percent complete on both the Price Road and Wolfe Run Road tanks and completion is anticipated in a timely manner.

He also reported that there is a problem with the sanitary sewer lines at the Patriot Center Shopping Plaza. He said that the West Virginia Department of Highways lowered the elevation of the roadway after the sewer mains were installed which resulted in the contractor having to lower the elevation of the entranceway into the shopping plaza. After the elevation of the entranceway was lowered, the sewer main was left with approximately twelve inches of cover which is not adequate to prevent breakage from the constant flow of traffic over it or to prevent freezing in extremely cold weather. He said that the Department of Highways has refused to pay for correcting this problem since it is not on their right-of-way and that the contractor has to dated refused to pay for it. He said that he told them that the District did not cause the problem and will not pay to fix the problem nor will the District accept the sewer mains or permit sewer service to begin until the problem is corrected.

A discussion followed Mr. Spears' report after which the Board of Commissioners stated that they were in complete agreement with his assessment of the problem and agreed that sewer service will not be provided until the problem is corrected by either the contractor or the State of West Virginia.

Mr. Mayles said that he was in attendance to address the Board of Commissioners about the Water System Improvement Project, the Rockport Water Line Extension Project, and the WalMart sanitary sewer mains. He said that he agreed with Mr. Spears' progress report on the Water System Improvement Project and the Rockport Water Line Extension Project. He also stated that Mr. Bosley is already asking for a time extension based on the fact that it took several weeks to obtain the pipe for the projects. Following a brief discussion it was the consensus of the Board of Commissioners that Mr. Mayles call Mr. Bosley to discuss the necessity of finishing this project in a timely fashion.

Mr. Mayles also discussed the sewer problems at the WalMart Plaza in Pettyville and gave the Board of Commissioners a letter dated December 16, 1999, from Manning Frymier, President, Cerrone & Associates, Inc., outlining the problems. (copy attached) He said that he is also in agreement with Mr. Spears assessment of the problems. Some possible solutions were discussed and Mr. Spears agreed to talk with the contractor on the project and Jim Cochrane, RCDI, the developer of the complex, to tell them their options.

Mr. Radabaugh told Mr. Mayles that Denese Carney, co-owner of a development on Price Road, has requested that a fire hydrant be installed near the property. Mr. Mayles suggested that the flush hydrant scheduled to be installed at the junction of the new line and the existing line on Price Road be changed to a fire hydrant and that another fire hydrant be installed on the Carney property at the end of the project if money is available. Following a rather lengthy discussion, the Board of Commissioners agreed with Mr. Mayles suggestion.

Mr. Radabaugh also stated that Jay Parson, Assistant Fire Chief, PMBS Volunteer Fire Department, has requested that the fire hydrant located at the intersection of Route 21 and Sugar Camp Run Road be moved across the road from its present location to make it easier for the pumper trucks to fill their tanks at this hydrant. Mr. Radabaugh said that he has also asked that additional fire hydrants be installed on Sugar Camp Run Road. Mr. Mayles agreed to move the fire hydrant as requested but said that the hydraulies will not allow the installation of additional hydrants.

Mr. Radabaugh said that Mr. Parsons would like to have the water line that is planned to be installed in front of his property on the WV Department of Highways' right-of-way moved back behind the rail fence into his yard so his fence does not have to be disturbed. He said that Mr. Parsons has agreed to give the District a right-of way easement for this line. Mr. Mayles agreed that the line can be moved and stated that he would inform the contractor of the change.

Following Mr. Mayles' report, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that each employee receive an hourly pay increase of forty cents (\$.40) effective January 1, 2000. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Cerrone submitted his plans for the District's new office building and maintenance building. He explained the size and features of each room in both buildings and asked several questions about furnishings for the office building and storage cabinets/racks for the maintenance building. The plans were discussed at length after which Mr. Cerrone stated that he would like to have the District's approval of the plans before the Christmas Holiday so he could proceed with submitting them to the Rural Utilities Service for approval.

Mr. Radabaugh said that he would like some additional time for the Commissioners and employees to study the plans before the Board gives its final approval. Mr. Stewart and Mr. Lett were in agreement with him. Therefore, he made a motion that the plans be reviewed by the District's Board

and Staff and be submitted to the District's Architect, Mr. Cerrone, by December 30, 1999. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

All business having been completed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried after which Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:40 p.m.

RE: Pettyville WalMart Development

Dear Mr. Stewart:

We have been asked to investigate the sewer problems at the WalMart Plaza in Pettyville and offer our recommended solutions.

Based upon a filed investigation by Jim Ruckman, P.S., of our staff, three (3) problems exist:

- 1. Less than 1 foot of cover on the 8 inch sanitary sewer line as it crosses the main entrance
- 2. Burger King has erected a permanent building over the sanitary sewer line
- 3. The sanitary sewer crosses above a City of Parkersburg water line. This is a direct conflict of WV Bureau of Public health regulations.

We have developed a plan to correct the above deficiencies. A copy of a map illustrating the necessary corrective actions is enclosed. Also enclosed is our cost estimate for this work. We would recommend that the developer be advised to make these corrections before the system is turned over to the District for operation.

This information has been submitted to Jesse Sheppard of DOH; however, he indicated that the DOH will not be able to provide funding for the corrective work.
