MINUTES OF A REGULAR MONTHLY BOARD MEETING OF THE MINERAL WELLS PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT HELD THURSDAY, MAY 17, 2001, IN THE DISTRICT'S OFFICE AT MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

Mr. Charles Stewart, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. Charles Stewart; Roy L. Radabaugh, Treasurer; James R. Lett, Secretary; Jerald D. Spears, Operations Manager; Shayne Brabham, Operations Manager Trainee; Margaret Batten, Office Manager; Nellie Radcliff, Office Technician; Todd Anderson, Resident of Mineral Wells; and James Aucremanne, Public Service Commission was present.

First order of business was the presentation of Change Order No. 10 - Contract No. 2 for \$1,442.34. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Change Order No. 10 - Contract No. 2 be approved as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Stewart signed Change Order No. 10 - Contract No. 2.

Mr. James Aucremanne, Public Service Commission, was present to discuss the Janis Ryan problem with the Board. Mrs. Ryan is to send a copy of her deed and plot to Mr. Aucremanne so that he can check with his legal department to see if she can get her water line installed on a utility right-of-way. He will get back to the Board with the results.

Mr. Lett made a motion that the Minutes of the April 19, 2001, Board meeting and the Special Board Meeting of May 2, 2001, be approved as presented. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Lett signed the Minutes.

Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried. All items were approved as presented.

Other business discussed was the hiring of Todd Anderson as a maintenance employee. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Mr. Anderson be hired effective May 21, 2001. Starting wages will be \$8.00 per hour for 90 days, after which the rate will be increased to \$9.00 per hour. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Radabaugh reported that Harold Hoffman is interested in conveying an easement for a Right-Of - Way to the Bonnevale Lift Station.

The District received an estimate from J. C. Bosley Construction Company in an amount of \$4,500.00 for tearing down and restoring the site known as No. 2 Pump Station. The Board felt that this was too much money to pay out for such a small project. Jay Parsons with Pettyville, Mineral Wells, Bonnivale and Slate Volunteer Fire Department said that the Fire Department would tear it down and sew grass back on the site for free, so that they would have a better view when exiting their drive-way. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that PMBS demolish and remove all debris of the No. 2 Pump Station. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mrs. Batten presented the following letters to be discussed.

Letter 17 - Letter dated April 23, 2001, to Robert K. Tebay, Rick Modesitt, and K. D. Merritt, County Commission of Wood County, from Charles Stewart, Roy L. Radabaugh, and James R. Lett, Board of Commissioners, Mineral Wells Public Service District, responding to the Wood County Commission's earlier correspondence supporting the use of a second water meter for the purpose of yard maintenance.

Letter 38 - Fax dated April 26, 2001, to Gary Wilson, Rural Utility Services, from Manning Frymier, P. E., Cerrone Associates, Inc., containing the latest budget update for the Water Systems Improvements and the Rockport Water Extension Projects.

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Letter 59 - Letter dated May 1, 2001, to the Commissioners from Harman Thompson Mallory & Ice stating that they will perform the District's annual audit and prepare the required Public Service Commission Reports for both water and sewer and the FmHA Report for a sum not to exceed \$6,600.00. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to authorize Mr. Stewart to sign the contract. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Stewart signed the contract.

Letter 92 - Letter dated May 14, 2001, to Charles Stewart from Randall M. Cole, Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing for review and approval five copies of Change Order No. 10 to Bosley Construction for Contract No. 2 for the Water System Improvements Project and the Rockport Water Extension Project.

Shayne Brabham, Operations Trainee, gave his report on the following items.

- 1. The cost of a carport from Fastners Supply is \$3,535.00 for a 24' x 28' x 8'. The District can buy the material out of project funds, but Lou Morgan Builders will have to be the contractor to do the installation, or sub it out to another contractor. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion for the District to purchase a carport cover for the pipe storage building. He hopes the Change Order that covers the paving of the back parking lot will include pouring the floor of the storage building. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- 2. Green Valley Project is still on hold until the middle of June 2001.
- 3. Affolter Extension is completed. All the residents have water service.
- 4. DOH has agreed to remove the grinder pumps and water lines at the vacant houses they have purchased at their expense.
- 5. Smoke Testing has been completed in Mineral Acres, Oakbrook, Carder Addition, Windsor, and Mt. Pleasant Estates. There were nine violations. Three of the nine have taken care of the problems that were found.
- 6. Jesse Shepherd with DOH reports that the 4-lane highway will be in progress this fall and that the Districts' lines will have to be relocated.
- 7. DOH has authorized the District to move ahead on the I-77 Rest Area Project. Mr. Frymier is working on this project.
