Mr. Charles Stewart, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. Charles Stewart; Roy L. Radabaugh, Treasurer; James R. Lett, Secretary; R. Shayne Brabham, Operations Manager; William Byers, Operations Technician; Margaret Batten, Office Manager; Nellie Radcliff, Office Technician; Manning Frymier, P. E., Cerrone Associates, Inc.; Delbert Stephens, Resident of Stephens Fork Road; and Jerald D. Spears, visitor, were in attendance.

Mr. Frymier presented to the Board, the final Requisition 19 - for the Rockport Water Extension Project for J. C. Bosley, Contractor. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Requisition 19 be accepted as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart signed Requisition 19.

Final Requisition 20 - Water System Improvements Project for J. C. Bosley, Contractor, was presented to the Board for approval. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Requisition 20 be approved as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart signed Requisition 20.

Mr. Frymier discussed the following items with the Board:

- 1. There are three (3) dates that can be chosen from to visit a Dechlorination Facility. He recommends Ultraviolet Sampling.
- 2. Ackenheil Engineers Geologist completed the core drilling at 215 Dover Drive. The firm core drilled four (4) holes. All holes revealed sand and water. The firm is going to do further testing before the final decision is rendered.
- 3. Field Crew has completed their work on the Sycamore, Stephens Fork, Limestone Ridge project. User Agreements have been filled out and the Security Deposits and Tap fees have been collected. As of this date the only hold-up is the definite location for the tank and booster station.
- 4. The vent on the Bonnivale Lift Station needs to be moved per Jesse Shepherd, DOH.
- 5. Mr. Frymier informed Mr. Byers and Mr. Brabham that part of the Telemetry problems could be eliminated by changing the steel pipe that is being used

and installing a transducer. Werner Knight, with Miller Communications, has the solution to correct the problem.
