Letter 116 - Letter dated September 17, 2001, to Charles Stewart from Virginia McDonald, Rural Utilities Service, stating that the District's request of September 12, 2001, to purchase and equip a service vehicle from the remaining Rockport water project funds has been approved. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District place an "Advertisement for Bid" for a service truck in the two news papers. It should be for a 2002 Pickup and should cost no more than \$21,280.00. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Letter 119 - Letter dated September 17, 2001, to Charles Stewart from Dominick P. Cerrone, Cerrone Associates, Inc., recommending that the District have the remaining work on the office and maintenance building done and subtract the cost of such from the remaining money owed to Lou Morgan Builders.

Letter 133 - Fax dated September 19, 2001, to Charles Stewart from Steven R. Hardman, Attorney-at - Law, Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love, stating that the District is free to pursue having the unfinished items for the office and maintenance buildings done with any funds that are still owed to Lou Morgan Builders since he has refused to complete the work under the June 5, 2001, contract.

Letter 134 - Fax dated September 20, 2001, to Shayne Brabham from Manning Frymier, P. E., Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing a copy of a letter dated September 20, 2001, to Mr. Brabham from Mr. Frymier relative to a detention time study at the sewage treatment plant and a copy of a letter dated September 20, 2001, to Mr. Brabham from Mr. Frymier relative to the sewage treatment plant dechlorination, a copy of a fax dated September 18, 2001, from Trojan Technologies, Inc., relative to the effluent analysis of the waste-water treatment plant and a copy of another fax from Trojan Technologies, Inc., about a collimated beam test. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Mr. Brabham, Operations Manager, be authorized to request an extension of time for the completion of dechlorination. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that all employees receive a pay-raise of \$0.35 per hour, effective September 17, 2001. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mrs. Batten reported that she had nothing further to discuss.

Mr. Brabham reported that Linda McClung, a customer in the District, has a big oak tree that needs removed by the District. When the contractor for the Water Improvement Project installed the water line across her property, the tree roots became damaged. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion for Mr. Brabham to receive estimates for the removal of the tree and stump. Mr. Lett seconded the motion.

Mr. Brabham discussed the following items with the Board.

- 2. Smoke Testing will begin in Pettyville area September 23, 2001.
- 3. 215 Dover core drilling has been completed, but a pressure test needs to be done before a final decision is made. There is a break that needs repaired before a pressure test can be done in this area.

This concluded Mr. Brabham's report.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Lett made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
