Mrs. Batten reported that the Public Service Commission hearing for the customers who want a

second water meter will be held, November 7, 2001, at 10:00 a.m., in the Municipal Building, Parkersburg, West Virginia.

Mrs. Batten had received in the District's office a service maintenance contract for the copier. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the contract be renewed. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Brabham discussed the following items with the Commissioners.

- 1. The District has been smoke-testing in the Pettyville area. There have been no major problems found. Maintenance Dept. will continue smoke-testing next week. Manholes need to be raised because the streets have been paved.
- 2. Pressure testing was completed on 215 Dover Drive. No problem was found. The engineering firm is still trying to determine where the water is coming from that is causing the ground to give away.
- 3. The District received three bids for the removal of a tree that the contractors for the District caused to die when the water line was installed through Linda McClung's property. Black's Tree Service presented a bid for \$840.00, Quality Tree Service, \$600.00, and Kidder's Tree Service \$885.00. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the bid be awarded to Quality Tree Service for the amount of \$600.00. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Brabham was instructed to contact Quality Tree Service and have them remove the tree.
- 4. Mr. Brabham reported the new Leak Detector and Line Locator had been received.
- 5. Flushing of the District's hydrants and water lines was started October 15, 2001, and will continue thru November 2, 2001.
- 6. Met with Department of Highways concerning a slip on Paddle Run that has our water line exposed to the elements. We are waiting for the core drilling results to know how deep to punch new line. Will do a directional bore, approximately 250' at \$8.00 per foot.
- 7. Submitted a cost estimate to Dominick Cerrone, Cerrone Associates, Inc., of uncompleted items on punch list. Will have to submit change orders

separately to RUS directly.

8. Virginia McDonald, Rural Utilities, will be in the District's Office to certify users on the new project. We have 306 signed users and 98 declinations.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:30 p.m.
