Mr. Bradley was in attendance to represent Mr. Richard Boice, his client, whom the District is interested in obtaining a tank site for the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork and Limestone Ridge Water Extension Project. Since the Board was not going to discuss the tank site, Mr. Bradley excused himself from the meeting.

Mr. Lett made a motion that the Minutes of the June 20, 2002, Board Meeting be approved as presented. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Lett signed the Minutes.

Letter 23 - Letter dated June 27, 2002, to Shayne Brabham from Vincent J.D. Shaw, Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing two copies of the License Agreement between the Public Land Corporation and the District for the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, and Limestone Ridge Water Project. This license Agreement needs to be approved by the Board and signed by Mr. Stewart. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve the License Agreement as presented and authorized Mr. Stewart authority to sign the agreement. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart signed the License Agreement.

Letter 56 - Copy of letter dated July 16, 2002, from Shayne Brabham relative to the District holding two meetings at the Mt. Hope Church located on Windy Ridge on Monday, July 22 and 23, 2002, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for land owners in the area to stop in and sign their rights-of-way easements for the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, and Limestone Ridge Water Extension Project.

Letter 58 - Letter dated July 16, 2002, to the District from Harold B. Holbert, a resident of Lee Creek, requesting that the District return the one hundred dollar tap fee and the fifty dollar security deposit that he paid on May 1, 2002, for a water tap on the Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, and Limestone Ridge Water Project.

Letter 61- District's WV National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Discharge Monitoring Report (WRD 2A-82) and a copy of its WV Summary of Waste Water Treatment Plant Operators (ES59) for the month of June 2002.

Letter 65 - Fax dated July 17, 2002, to Shayne Brabham from Robbie Evans, Evans Construction Co., containing an estimate in the amount of \$2,265.00 to repair the road in Meadowland Estates as requested by Richard Morris, (copy attached). The Board felt that this was too costly.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to authorize Mr. Stewart to sign Form No. 4 - Application for Certificate of Convenience & Necessity for Sycamore Run, Stephens Fork, and Limestone Ridge Water Extension Project. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart signed the Application.

Mrs. Batten presented a list of accounts that the District has been unable to collect. For accounting purposes the accounts need to be charged off for the auditors. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District charge off \$886.27 in water accounts and \$277.33 in sewer accounts. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. See list attached.

Mr. Brabham reported that he had been in contact with Dianne Wolfe, Executive Secretary, Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love, concerning the boundary extension between Wood and Jackson counties. Ms. Wolfe is going to arrange a three-way conference call between Amy Swan, PSC, Frank Murray, Commissioner for Silverton Public Service District and herself. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District is to pay all the advertising expenses concerning the extension of the boundaries for the District into Jackson county. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mr. Brabham reported that because the District's Handheld will not be able to be repaired after the first of August, he talked with Bob Fetters concerning a new meter reading system. Mr. Fetters informed the District that if we would continue paying the maintenance agreement in an amount of \$2,150.00 per year, for five years, he would let the District have the new system for this cost. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the District enter an agreement with Mr. Fetters for the new handheld meter reading system. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

The District had received a quote from Pavement Maintenance & Excavating in an amount of \$1,775.50 to repair a street in Meadowland Estates as requested by Mr. Morris (copy attached). The Board feels that this estimate is not feasible. They would like another estimate.

This concluded Mr. Brabham's report.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that all employees receive a \$.35 per hour raise, beginning July 16, 2002. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous vote. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 6:10 p.m.
