MINUTES OF A REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD OF THE MINERAL WELLS PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT HELD THURSDAY, APRIL 17, 2003, IN THE DISTRICT'S OFFICE LOCATED AT MINERAL WELLS, WEST VIRGINIA

Mr. Charles Stewart, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. He asked everyone present to sign the attendance roster. Charles Stewart; Roy L. Radabaugh, Treasurer; James R. Lett, Secretary; Margaret Batten, Office Manager; Shayne Brabham, Operations Manager; Nellie Radcliff, Office Clerk; William Byers, Operations Technician; Delbert and Sonya McWilliams, Delson, Inc., and Reginald Grimmett, Sky View Acres were present.

Mr. Delbert McWilliams was present to address the Board concerning the District's method of new customers signing up for water and sewer service in his trailer park (Mineral Park Estate). He presented the Board with a letter that he said was mailed to the District in the year of 1999. The District did not have a copy of the letter on file. He requested that the District have each new customer that signs for water in his trailer park show a copy of the signed lease. The District agreed that this would eliminate the problem of people sub-leasing the trailers. Mr. and Mrs. Mc Williams excused themselves from the rest of the meeting.

Mr. Grimmett, developer of Sky View Acres Mobile Home Park, was present to request that the District provide the meters for 24 trailers. He felt that since he had provided all the work and materials to develop the trailer park, the District should provide the meters at no cost to him. The Board informed him that the District could not do this. Following a brief discussion, Mr. Grimmett decided since he installed the taps at no cost to the District or tenant, he would have the tenants pay \$85.00 to him for the meters at the time they sign for water and sewer service. The District will not be responsible for collecting the meter cost from the customer. Mr. Grimmett excused himself from the rest of the meeting.

Mr. Lett made a motion that the Minutes of March 20, 2003, Board Meeting be approved as presented. Mr. Radabaugh seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Lett signed the Minutes.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the Financial Statements for All Finances, Water Revenue Fund Checking Account, Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account dated March 31, 2003 (copies attached) be approved as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion check numbers 27626 thru 27688 written between March 21, 2003, and April 17, 2003, on the Water Revenue Fund Checking Account and check numbers 29327 thru 29387 written on the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account (copy attached) be approved as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion check numbers 27689 thru 27702 written today, April 17, 2003, on the Water Revenue Fund Checking Account and check numbers 29388 thru 29404 written on the

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Payroll checks 1016 thru 1031 written between March 21, 2003, and April 17, 2003, on the Sewer Revenue Fund Checking Account (copy attached) be approved as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Batten presented the new budget for the Water Revenue to the Board for fiscal year 2004. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion approving the Water Revenue Budget as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Batten presented the new budget for the Sewer Revenue to the Board for fiscal year 2004. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion approving the Sewer Revenue Budget as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mrs. Batten discussed the following letters.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion authorizing Mr. Stewart to sign the proposed utility agreement dated April 9, 2003. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Stewart signed the agreement.

Cole, Project Administrator, Cerrone Associates, Inc., enclosing four copies of Addendum No. 2 to our Agreement for Engineering Services for the I-77 - S.R. #14 Interchange Water & Sewer Relocation Project to be voted on and signed if approved. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion to approve Addendum No. 2 as presented. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Stewart signed Addendum No. 2.

Mr. Radabaugh made a motion authorizing Mr. Stewart to sign the Executive Agreement for the Water and Sewer Extension between the District and Reginald Grimmett. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Stewart signed the agreement.

This concluded Mrs. Batten's report.

Mr. Brabham reported on the status of several projects that he has been working. He had Mr. Hardman, the District's Attorney, send a letter to Mr. Melrose reference to the I-77 Rest Area Sewer Extension regarding the easement that is needed for the project to move ahead. The letter stated that he had until April 28, 2003, to negotiate or we will have to condemn the property. Gary Scott, Department of Highways agreed to pay all costs associated with the condemnation.

Matt Sweeny, permit writer for DEP, said we would have to modify our permit, but we would not have to monitor the RV Dump Station.

There will be a pre-construction conference at the District's Office on May 1, 2003, at 10:30 a.m.

All utilities have been tied in to existing lines on the Rt. 14 Re-location Project.

Mr. Boice is still using delay tactics to stop the District from moving ahead with obtaining entry onto his property. He has told Dianne Wolfe, Executive Secretary, for Bowles Rice McDavid Graff & Love, PLLC., that he would not give the District the needed elevation for the tank on either side of the hill. Mr. Bradley, attorney for Mr. Boice, may file an injunction prohibiting the condemnation.

The District would like to purchase a Jetter Sewer Cleaning Machine, because of the cost of having Roto Rooter make service calls. Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that Mr. Brabham collect some quotes on Jetters. He is not to exceed \$20,000.00. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

All business having been discussed, Mr. Radabaugh made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr. Lett seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. Stewart adjourned the meeting at 7:00 p.m.
